Halloween Night

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 53" x 53"

Finished Center Panel Size 33" x 33"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

3/4 yard main (C2530 Black)

1/3 yard damask (C2534 Orange)

1/2 yard damask (C2534 Purple)

1/3 yard stars (C2535 Black)

1 trick or treat panel (C2538 Multi)

5/8 yard clean white solid (C100-01 Clean White)

Binding 1/2 yard

Backing 3 1/2 yards

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Panel

Cut 1 square 33 1/2" x 33 1/2" from trick or treat panel (C2538 Multi)

Border 1

Cut 4 strips 1 1/2" x WOF from purple damask (C2534 Purple)

Border 2

Cut 4 strips 1 7/8" x WOF from orange damask (C2534 Orange)

Cut 4 strips 1 7/8" x WOF from black stars (C2535 Black)

Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" x WOF from orange damask (C2534 Orange)

Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" x WOF from black stars (C2535 Black)

Cut 16 squares 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" from clean white (C100-01 Clean White). Cut squares twice diagonally to make 64 large triangles.

Cut 8 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" from clean white (C100-01 Clean White). Cut squares once diagonally to make 16 small triangles.

Border 3

Cut 5 strips 1 1/2" x WOF from purple damask (C2534 Purple)

Border 4

Cut 5 strips 4 1/2" x WOF from black main (C2530 Black)

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of panel and borders.

Border 2

Sew an orange damask 1 7/8" strip to a black stars 1 7/8" strip. Repeat with the remaining orange damask and black stars 1 7/8" strips. Cut the strips into 1 7/8" segments. Sew the segments together to create 36 of Unit A.



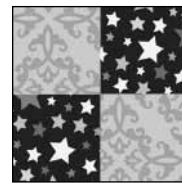
Unit A

Sew an orange damask 2 1/2" strip to a black stars 2 1/2" strip. Cut the strips into 2 1/2" segments. Sew the segments together to create 4 Corner Posts.

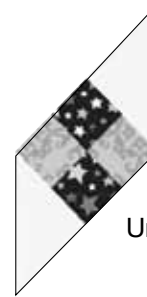
Referring to diagram, sew a large clean white triangle to each side of Unit A to create Unit B. Repeat to make 28 Unit Bs.

Sew 1 large clean white triangle and 2 small clean white triangles Unit A to create Unit C. Repeat to make 8 Unit Cs.

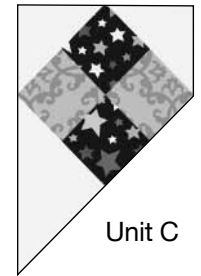
Sew 7 Unit Bs together with a Unit C on each end to create a border. Repeat to make 4 borders. Referring to quilt photo for placement, sew a Corner Post to each end of 2 of the borders to create the top and bottom borders.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Sew 1 1/2" strips together end to end. Side borders should be 33 1/2". Top and bottom borders should be 35 1/2".

Border 2

Sew sides to quilt center first. (These are the rows without the corner posts.) Sew the 2 remaining rows with the corner posts to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Border 3

Sew 1 1/2" strips together end to end. Side borders should be 43 1/2". Top and bottom borders should be 45 1/2".

Border 4

Sew 4 1/2" strips together end to end. Side borders should be 45 1/2". Top and bottom borders should be 53 1/2".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Trick or Treat Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
