This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Firecracker collection.

(1) P17207-PANEL Firecracker Banner Panel

Additional Fabric:

1 ½ yards C17201-WHITE Fireworks (banner backing)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

Batting

Pinking Shears

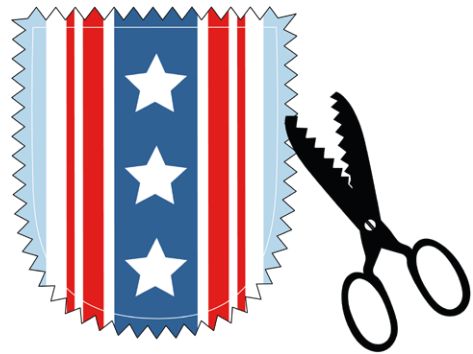
½" Double Fold Bias Tape

BANNER ASSEMBLY

1. Cut the banner backing fabric and batting approximately 2" larger on all sides than the panel.
2. Lay banner backing fabric right side down. Next, lay the batting on top, then finish with the panel right side up. Quilt as desired.

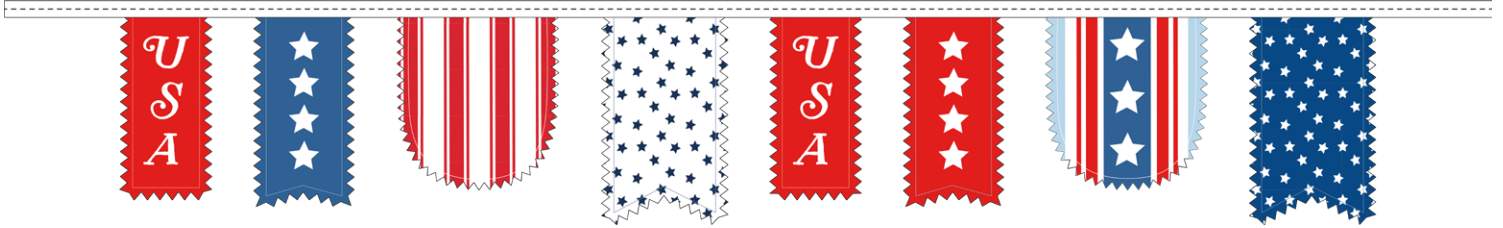


3. Carefully cut out each quilted banner shape approximately ¼" outside of the printed line within each motif using a pinking shears.

4. Cut ½" double fold bias tape the length desired for your banner, leaving extra on the ends for tying a bow or knots (or make your own bias tape using a strip of fabric and a bias tape maker).
5. Arrange the quilted banner shapes as desired within the fold of the bias tape, spacing the shapes evenly. Pin the shapes in place. Sew along the open edge of the bias tape to secure the shapes in place and close the bias tape strip.
