FINISHED RUNNER SIZE 22 ½" × 75 ½"

Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The table runner and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

(1) P16987-PANEL Letters to Cupid Pillow Panel

Fat ¼ of Each:

C16981-CREAM Love Birds

C16982-RED Cupids

C16983-CREAM XOXO

C16983-PINK XOXO

C16984-RED Ditsy Floral

C16985-PINK Stripes

C16986-PINK Crisscross

Additional Fabrics:

⅜ yard C120-LECREME Confetti Cotton™ Solid

⅝ yard C16985-RED Stripes (includes binding)



OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

⅞ yard WB640-FROSTING Dapple Dot (wide back backing)

Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

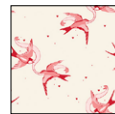
When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Letters to Cupid Pillow Panel

Fussy cut (4) 14 ½" × 15 ½" Panel rectangles, centered over the motifs.*

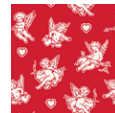
**Note: If the panel motifs do not reach the edges of the required cuts, add coping strips first and then trim to the required sizes.*



Cream Love Birds

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 18 ½" rectangles. Label as A.

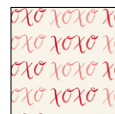
Cut (2) 1 ½" × 17 ½" rectangles. Label as B.



Red Cupids

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 16 ½" rectangles. Label as C.

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 15 ½" rectangles. Label as D.



Cream XOXO

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 18 ½" rectangles. Label as E.

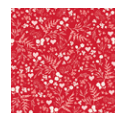
Cut (2) 1 ½" × 17 ½" rectangles. Label as F.



Pink XOXO

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 16 ½" rectangles. Label as G.

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 15 ½" rectangles. Label as H.

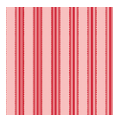


Red Ditsy Floral

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 18 ½" rectangles. Label as I.

Cut (2) 1 ½" × 17 ½" rectangles. Label as J.

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Pink Stripes

Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $16\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as K.

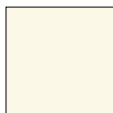
Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $15\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as L.



Pink Crisscross

Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $18\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as M.

Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $17\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as N.

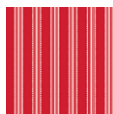


Le Creme Confetti Cotton™ Solid

Cut (5) 2" $\times$ WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 2" $\times$ $72\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as O.

(2) 2" $\times$ $22\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as P.



Red Stripes

Cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut:

(2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $16\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as Q.

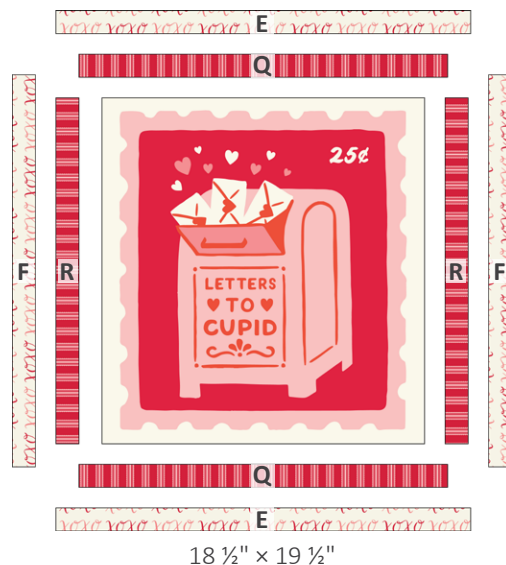
(2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $15\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as R.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

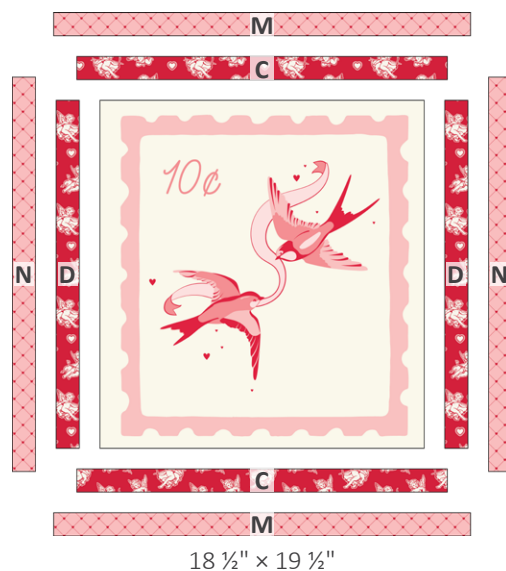
Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Table Runner Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **R**-rectangle to each side of (1) "Letters to Cupid" Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **Q**-rectangle to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **F**-rectangles to the sides and **E**-rectangles to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 1.



2. Sew (1) **D**-rectangle to each side of (1) "Love Birds" Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **C**-rectangle to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **N**-rectangles to the sides and **M**-rectangles to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 2.



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- Sew (1) **L**-rectangle to each side of (1) "Heart Floral" Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **K**-rectangle to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **B**-rectangles to the sides and **A**-rectangles to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 3.



- Sew (1) **H**-rectangle to each side of (1) "Cupid" Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **G**-rectangle to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **J**-rectangles to the sides and **I**-rectangles to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 4.

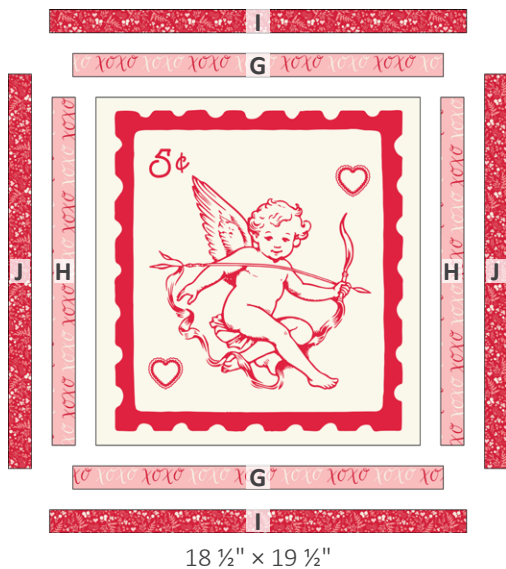


TABLE RUNNER ASSEMBLY

- Sew Blocks 1-4 together as shown below to make the table runner center.



19 1/2" x 72 1/2"

- Sew (1) **O**-strip to the top and bottom of the table runner center as shown below. Next, sew (1) **P**-strip to each side to complete the table runner top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

- Layer the table runner top, batting, and backing. Baste the table runner layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Red Stripes binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished table runner using your favorite binding method.
