JANUARY QUILT CORRECTIONS

Page 3

CUTTING

Cornflower Confetti Cotton Solid

Replace first cutting with:

Cut 1 strip 5 ¼" x WOF

sub-cut 1 square 5 ¼" x 5 ¼", cut twice diagonally for a total of 4 triangles

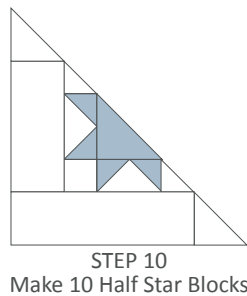
Replace second cutting with:

Cut 1 strip 4 ⅞" x WOF

sub-cut 5 squares 4 ⅞" x 4 ⅞", each cut once diagonally for a total of 10 triangles

9. Arrange 2 flying geese units, 2 Off White 2 ⅞" triangles, 1 Off White 2 ½" x 2 ½" square, and 1 Cornflower 4 ⅞" triangle as shown. Sew the units in each row together, keeping square corners aligned. Press. Join the rows to complete the half-star unit. Press. Trim any dog ears as necessary. Repeat to make a total of 10 half star units.

11. Arrange 1 flying geese unit, 2 Off White 2 ⅞" triangles, and 1 Cornflower 5 ¼" triangle as shown. Sew the Cornflower triangle, centered, to the matching side of the flying geese unit. Press. Add the smaller triangles. Trim any dog ears as necessary. Repeat to make a total of 4 quarter star units.

CUTTING

Pumpkin Confetti Cotton Solid

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF for strip sets

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF for strip sets (Duplicate DO NOT NEED)

Page 59

10. Sew 1 each Le Crème and Pumpkin 3¾" triangles together along short sides as shown to make a pieced triangle unit. Handle carefully so as not to distort the long bias edges. Press. Make 14 triangle units and 14 reversed triangle units.
