

## SQUARE DANCE

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 40½" $\times 48$ "
Finished Block Size 7½ x 7½"
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) white main (C6690 White)
$2 / 3$ yard ( 65 cm ) green main (C6690 Green)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) blue sheep dream (C6691 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) red happy harvester (C6692 Red)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) yellow happy harvester (C6692 Yellow)
$1 / 4$ yard $(25 \mathrm{~cm})$ green hog wash (C6693 Green)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) blue plaid (C6694 Blue)
$1 / 4 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) blue hay (C6695 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) red hay (C6695 Red)
$1 / 4$ yard $(25 \mathrm{~cm})$ yellow hay (C6695 Yellow)
1 yard ( 95 cm ) Riley white solid (C120 Riley White)
Binding $1 / 2$ yard $(50 \mathrm{~cm})$

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

## White Main

Cut 5 squares $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$.

## Green Main

Cut 4 strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Border 2.

## Blue Sheep Dream

Cut 5 squares 5" $\times 5$ ".

## Red Happy Harvester

Cut 3 squares 5" x 5".

## Yellow Happy Harvester

Cut 2 squares 5" x 5".

## Green Hog Wash

Cut 5 squares 5" $\times 5$ ".

## Blue Plaid

Cut 4 strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF for Border 1 .

## Blue Hay

Cut 1 strip $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strip into 14 squares $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Cut 2 strips 2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 27 squares 2" x 2".

## Red Hay

Cut 1 strip $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strip into 14 squares $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
Cut 2 strips 2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 27 squares 2" $\times 2$ 2".

## Yellow Hay

Cut 1 strip $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strip into 13 squares $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Cut 2 strips 2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 26 squares 2" x 2".

## Riley White Solid

Cut 3 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strip into 41 squares $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
Cut 10 strips $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strip into 80 rectangles $2 " \times 5 "$.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for placement of fabrics as each block is different.

## Square Dance Block

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the Riley white solid $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. With right sides together, place a Riley white solid $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on top of a printed fabric $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of the line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 82 Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to 2". There will be 28 blue, 28 red, and 26 yellow ( 2 will not be used).

## SQUARE DANCE

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side the printed fabric 2 " squares. With wrong sides together, place the printed 2 " square on the right hand side of a Riley white solid $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ beyond seam. Press. This will create Unit A. Repeat to make 80 Unit As. There will be 27 blue, 27 red, and 26 yellow.


Unit A
These instructions are to make 1 Square Dance Block. Sew a Unit A to the right and left sides of a printed fabric 5" square to create Unit B. Press.


Unit B
Sew a Half Square Triangle to the right and left sides of Unit A to create Unit C. Repeat to make 2 Unit Cs.


Unit C
Sew a Unit C to the top and bottom of Unit B to complete the Square Dance Block. Repeat to create 20 assorted Square Dance Blocks.


Square Dance Block

Quilt Center Assembly
Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for block placement.
Lay out the blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew blocks together to make rows. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be 38". Top and bottom borders should be 3212".

## Border 2

Side borders should be 40". Top and bottom borders should be 4012".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Harmony Farm Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
