P. 1 Cutting Instructions

Should read:



Off White Hey Bootiful Dots
Cut (1) strip 5 ¼" x WOF; sub-cut:
(8) 5 ¼" squares (B)
Cut (1) strip 5 ⅓" x WOF; sub-cut:
(4) 5 ⅓" squares (F)
Cut (2) strips 2 3/4" x WOF; sub-cut:
(16) 2 3/4" squares (H)



Off White Hey Bootiful Jack-o'-Lanterns
Cut (1) strip 4 %" x WOF; sub-cut:
(4) 4 %" squares (G)
Cut (1) strip 10" x WOF; sub-cut:
(1) 10" square (E)



Persimmon Hey Bootiful Words
Cut (2) strips 3 1/8" x WOF; sub-cut:
(20) 3 1/8" squares (D)



Charcoal Hey Bootiful Dots

Cut (1) strip 10" x WOF; sub-cut: (4) 10" squares (E)

Cut (1) strip 5 %" x WOF; sub-cut:

(1) 5 %" square (F)

(4) 2 3/4" squares (H)

Cut (2) strips 4 %" x WOF; sub-cut:

(16) 4 %" squares (G)

Cut (7) strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding

P. 2 Small Flying Geese

Should read:

 Make (16) Off White Hey Bootiful Dots with Persimmon Hey Bootiful Words and (4) Charcoal Hey Bootiful Dots with Persimmon Hey Bootiful Words.

P. 2 Large Flying Geese

Should read:

8. Select (4) B squares with the same print and (1) E square to make a set of 4 large flying geese by repeating the steps for making small flying geese (#2 above), making a total of (20) large flying geese. For fabric layout, refer to the quilt image.



9. Make (8) Off White Hey Bootiful Dots with Charcoal Hey Bootiful Dots, (8) Off White Hey Bootiful Plaid with Charcoal Hey Bootiful Dots, and (4) Orange Hey Bootiful Witch Icons with Off White Hey Bootiful Jack-o-Lanterns. Large flying geese should measure 9 ¼" x 4 ½".

P. 2 Star Blocks

Should read:

12. Repeat to make (5) Star Blocks. For fabric layout, follow the cover image.

P. 2 Quilt Center Assembly

Should read:


13. Sew a Star Block between (2) panel squares. Press the seam allowances toward the panel square to make Row 1. Repeat to make Row 3.







14. Sew (3) Star Blocks for Row 2.



P. 3 Border 2

Should read:

18. Side borders should be 55". Sew the side borders to the quilt center and press seams outward. Top/bottom borders should be 64". Sew the top/bottom borders to the quilt center and press seams outward. Finished quilt size is 64" x 64".
