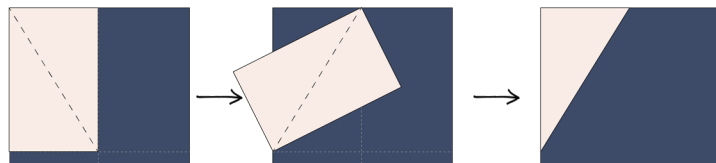
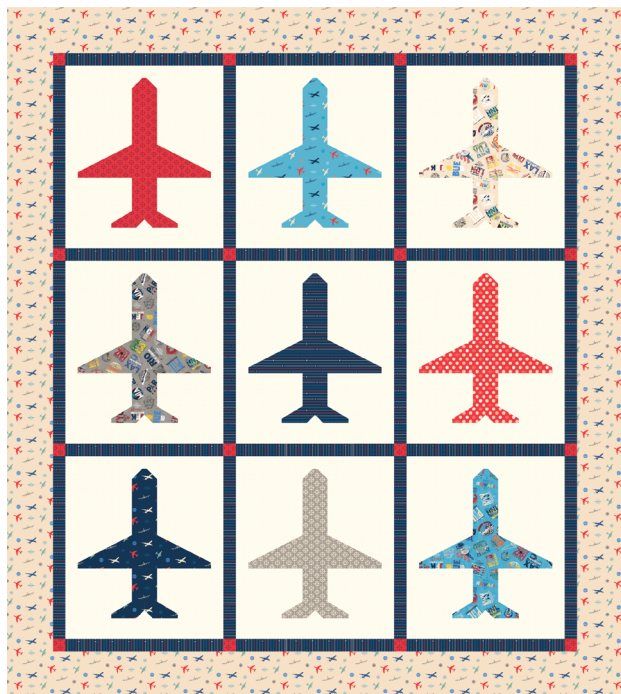

P. 4 Airplane Blocks

Should read:

1. Use the **SNF** or **HSR** techniques to add **BK** fabric to corners. Follow the instructions in the **Stitch 'N Flip** and **Half Square Rectangle** sections and refer to **Block Diagram** for correct placement.

SNF: Front fuselage + **BK F** and Tail + **BK H**

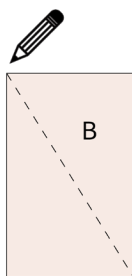
HSF: Wing + **BK B** and Tail + **BK E**

P. 3 Half Square Rectangle (HSR)

Should read:

Take the HSR rectangle and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side. Note the direction.



Place the rectangle over the corner that is to be “replaced” as shown. Mark the edges of the rectangle where it aligns with the larger piece, this will help align the rectangle when rotated. Rotate the rectangle $\frac{1}{4}$ turn until the edge of the drawn lines on the HSR rectangle match where you marked. Note the diagonal line should appear to be going in the wrong direction. Pin and sew in place. Sew along the drawn line and continue as with the stitch and flip method of HSTs. When you fold the HSR back it will fill in the rectangle like magic. Trim as needed.
