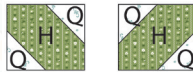


Prairie Flower no. 2 CORRECTION

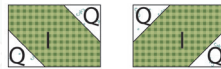
13. For the top leaf unit, gather (1) H-rectangle and (2) Q-squares. Using the SNF method, sew each Q-square on opposite corners of the H-rectangle as shown. The unit should measure 3" x 3½". Repeat on a second H-rectangle noting the SNF of the Q-squares will be in opposite corners.



14. Sew (2) P-rectangles to the outside of each top leaf unit as shown. The units should measure 3" x 5". Make (2) units.



15. Repeat step 13 with (1) I-rectangle and (2) Q-squares to make a middle leaf unit as shown. The unit should measure 3" x 4½". Repeat on a second I-rectangle noting the SNF of the Q-squares will be in opposite corners.



16. Sew (2) R-rectangles to the outside of each middle leaf unit as shown. The units should measure 3" x 5". Make (2) units.



17. Repeat the SNF method to make the bottom leaf units using (1) J-rectangle and (2) Q-squares as shown. The unit should measure 3" x 5". Repeat on a second J-rectangle noting the SNF of the Q-squares will be in opposite corners.
