FINDING SHEEP

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 70" x 82"

Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

130's Minis Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4520-24) 1½ yards (1.4 m) pink garden (C4527 Pink) 3½ yards (3.25 m) clean white solid (C100-01 Clean White) ½ yard (15 cm) skin solid (C100-06 Skin) Binding ¾ yard (60 cm) Backing 5 yards (3.7 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 4 squares 3½" x 3½" from each of the following prints: green main, purple main, purple floral, red floral, green petals, purple petals, yellow dots, yellow squares, purple leaves, pink garden, purple garden

Cut 8 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " from each of the following prints: blue petals, green garden

Cut the applique pieces (except feet and arms) for Little Bo Peep from the remaining fat quarter pieces using the templates provided. There are 5 right-facing and 10 left-facing Little Bo Peeps. Remember to reverse or add ¼" seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

Pink Garden

Cut 7 strips 51/2" x WOF for Border 1.

Clean White Solid

Cut 5 strips 13" x WOF. Cut the strips into 15 squares 13" x 13". Cut 6 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 60 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut 5 strips $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 30 squares $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Skin Solid

Cut the applique pieces for Little Bo Peep's feet and arms using the templates provided. There are 5 right-facing and 10 left-facing Little Bo Peeps. Remember to reverse or add ¼" seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

Little Bo Peep Block

Use your favorite method of applique. Refer to quilt photo for fabric placement and Little Bo Peep Diagram for piece placement. Applique pieces on a clean white solid 13" x 13" square. The staff is embroidered using 2 strands of black embroidery floss. When finished with the applique, square up the block to 12½" x 12½". Make 15 Little Bo Peep Blocks (5 right-facing and 10 left-facing).


Chain Block

Refer to the quilt photo for piece placement as each block is a different combination of fabrics. Sew 2 assorted print 3½" squares and 2 clean white solid 3½" squares together to create a Four-Patch Unit. Repeat to create 30 Four-Patch Units.



Four-Patch Unit

Sew together 2 Four-Patch Units and 2 clean white solid 6½" x 6½" squares to create the Chain Block. Repeat to make 15 Chain Blocks.

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Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for Chain Block and Little Bo Peep Block placement. Lay out blocks in 6 rows of 5 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $72\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $70\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the 30's Minis Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
