Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the 8 Nights, 8 Lights collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) P16424-PANEL Happy Hanukkah Panel

¼ Yard of Each:

C16420-WHITE Main

C16421-NAVY Leaves

⅜ Yard of Each:

C16420-NAVY Main

C16421-WHITE Leaves

Additional Fabrics:

⅓ yard C790-150 WHITE Swiss Dot

½ yard C120-RILEYNAVY Confetti Cotton™ (binding)



OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

1 ⅜ yards WB200-NIGHTTIME Shade (wide back backing)

Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Happy Hanukkah Panel

Fussy cut (1) 35" × 42 ½" Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.*

*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.



White Main

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 4 ½" × 20 ¼" rectangle. Label as A.

(1) 4 ½" × 16 ½" rectangle. Label as B.



Navy Leaves

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 4 ½" × 21 ½" rectangle. Label as C.

(1) 4 ½" × 19 ½" rectangle. Label as D.



Navy Main

Cut (2) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(1) 4 ½" × 16" rectangle. Label as E.

(1) 4 ½" × 13 ¾" rectangle. Label as F.

(1) 4 ½" × 10 ½" rectangle. Label as G.

(1) 4 ½" × 8" rectangle. Label as H.



White Leaves

Cut (2) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(1) 4 ½" × 23 ½" rectangle. Label as I.

(1) 4 ½" × 17 ¾" rectangle. Label as J.

(1) 4 ½" × 16 ¼" rectangle. Label as K.

(1) 4 ½" × 8" rectangle. Label as L.

White Swiss Dot Tone-on-Tone

Cut (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips. Label as M.

(2) 2 1/2" x 39" strips. Label as N.



Riley Navy Confetti Cotton™

Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

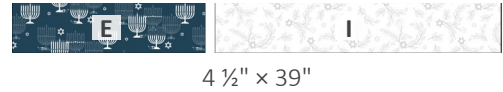
Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **M**-strip to each side of (1) Panel rectangle. Next, sew (1) **N**-strip to the top and bottom to make the quilt center.



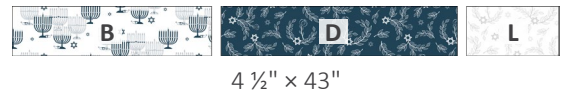
2. Sew (1) **E**-rectangle and (1) **I**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Border 1 Unit.



3. Sew (1) **K**-rectangle, (1) **H**-rectangle, (1) **J**-rectangle, and (1) **G**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Border 2 Unit.



4. Sew (1) **B**-rectangle, (1) **D**-rectangle, and (1) **L**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Border 3 Unit.



5. Sew (1) **F**-rectangle, (1) **A**-rectangle, and (1) **C**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Border 4 Unit.



6. Sew (1) Border 1 Unit to the bottom of the quilt center as shown in the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4. Next, sew (1) Border 2 Unit to the left side of the quilt center. In the same manner, sew (1) Border 3 Unit to the top and (1) Border 4 Unit to the right side to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

7. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Riley Navy Confetti Cotton™ binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
