## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 60" x 67 ½"

Measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 A Nostalgic Christmas Santa by the Fireplace Panel (PD13670-SANTA)
½ yard Bee Plaids Clover Scarecrow (C12020-CLOVER)
²/8 yard Bee Plaids Cozy Cayenne (C12022-CAYENNE)
1 yard Bee Plaids Cider Barn Red (C12031-BARNRED)*
$5 / 8$ yard Dapple Dot on White Barn Red (C645-BARNRED)
$1 / 8$ yard Shabby Cinnamon (C605-CINNAMON)
$3 / 8$ yard Shabby Holly (C605-HOLLY)
*includes Binding

## OTHER SUPPLIES

$21 / 8$ yards WIDEBACK backing fabric of your choice
Basic Sewing Supplies
Batting (67" x 75")

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

## Shabby Cinnamon

Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip and subcut:
(4) $2 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label J.


## Shabby Holly

Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips and subcut:
(16) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label A.
(4) $2 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{} \times 6 \frac{112 "}{}$ " rectangles, label I.

Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip and subcut:
(4) $2 \frac{1}{2} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, label $E$.
(4) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label G.


Dapple Dot on White Barn Red
Cut (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip and subcut:
(8) $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, label J.
(8) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, label C.

Cut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips and subcut:
(16) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label B.
(8) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, label D.

Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip and subcut:
(8) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label F.
(8) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, label H.

Cut (3) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips and subcut:
(8) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label L.


Bee Plaids Cider Barn Red
Cut (4) 4" x WOF strips and put aside for borders, label M. Cut (7) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips and put aside for binding.


## Bee Plaids Clover Scarecrow

Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips and put aside for borders, label N.


Bee Plaids Cozy Cayenne
Cut (4) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips and put aside for borders, label 0 .

## Christmas Pines Panel

Trim panel to $36 \times 431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

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## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints. Press all seams open, unless directed otherwise.

## 2-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press seams. Trim HSTs to desired size.


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Using the HST method, pair (1) A square with (1) B square. Trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make (32) total HST Units.
2. Lay out (2) HSTs and (2) C rectangles as shown and sew them RST. Unit will measure $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (4) units.

3. Lay out (2) HSTs, (2) D rectangles, and (1) E square as shown and sew them RST. Unit will measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (4) units.

4. Lay out (2) HSTs, (2) F squares, and (1) G rectangle as shown and sew them RST. Unit will measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (4) units.

5. Lay out (2) HSTs, (2) H rectangles, and (1) I rectangle as shown and sew them RST. Unit will measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (4) units.

H

6. Lay out (2) J rectangles and (1) K square as shown and sew them RST. Unit will measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (4) units.

7. Lay out the units from Steps 2-6 as shown, then sew them RST. Unit will measure $10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (4) units.

8. Lay out (2) L rectangles and as shown as sew them RST to the top and the bottom of the unit to complete the Tree Block. Tree Block Unit will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (4) units.


## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.
9. Sew the (4) $4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF M strips end-to-end and subcut into (2) 36 " strips and (2) $431 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Repeat with the $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF N strips and the $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF O strips.
10. Lay out the $321 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips as shown and sew the lengths of the strips RST. Horizontal Border Unit will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (2) units.


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11. Sew (2) Tree Blocks RST to each side of one Horizontal Border Unit ensuring that strip $O$ is at the top. Unit will measure $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

12. Sew (2) Tree Blocks RST to each side of the other Horizontal Border Unit ensuring that strip O is at the bottom. Unit will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60$ " unfinished.

13. Lay out the $431 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips as shown and sew the lengths of the strips RST. Vertical Border Unit will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ 43 ½". Repeat to make (2) units.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

14. Sew a Vertical Border Unit to the left and right side of the panel, ensuring strip $O$ is the outside border. Panel with vertical borders will measure $60^{\prime \prime} \times 431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

15. Sew the Horizontal Border Unit with strip O on top RST to the top of the quilt.
16. Sew the Horizontal Border unit with strip O on bottom RST to the bottom of the quilt.

17. Your quilt top should measure 60" $\times 67 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the (7) Bee Plaids Cider Barn Red strips.
