



FINISHED QUILT SIZE 63½" x 76½" Finished Block Size 9" x 9"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Bloom and Bliss Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4580-21) 1½ yards (1.4 m) red diamond (C4586 Red) 3½ yards (3.25 m) linen shade (C200-01 Linen) Binding 5% yard (60 cm) Backing 4¾ yards (4.35 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 1 square 5" \times 5" and 8 squares $2\frac{3}{4}$ " \times $2\frac{3}{4}$ " from the following assorted prints:

blue wreath, green wreath, pink wreath, blue tulip, pink tulip, yellow tulip, blue stripe, yellow stripe

Cut 2 squares $5'' \times 5''$ and 16 squares $2^{3}4'' \times 2^{3}4''$ from the following assorted prints:

blue main, green main, pink main, blue floral, green floral, pink floral, blue check, pink check, yellow check, blue diamond, green diamond

Red Diamond

Cut 3 strips $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. From the strips cut 5 squares $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 squares 9" x 9". Cut the $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " squares twice diagonally to create 20 Setting Triangles (2 will not be used). Cut the 9" x 9" squares once diagonally to create 4 Corner Triangles.

Linen Shade

Cut 5 strips $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 20 squares $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " for Center Blocks.

Cut 9 strips 5" x WOF. Cut the strips into 120 rectangles $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5". Cut 9 strips $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 120 squares $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ ".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the guilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to quilt photo as each block is a different combination of fabrics. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 print 2¾" squares. Place a print 2¾" square on top of a linen shade 2¾" x 5" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a ¼" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of a print 5" square. Sew a linen shade 2¾" square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Star Block. Repeat to make 30 Star Blocks.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Center Block, Star Block, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally cut larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving 1/4" seam allowance on all sides, before adding the borders.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Bloom and Bliss Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
