CHRISTMASTIME IS HERE PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 57" x 64"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Jolly Old St. Nick Panel (P10745-Jolly)
1 $\frac{1}{4}$ Yards Multi Plaid (C8698-Multi)*
1 $\frac{1}{8}$ Yards Green Pinecone (C5574-Green)
 $\frac{5}{8}$ yard Gray Snow Flurry (C8696-Gray)
*Includes binding

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Jolly Old St. Nick Panel

Cut 1 rectangle 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Multi Plaid

Cut 4 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.
Cut 7 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Binding.

Gray Snow Flurry

Cut 5 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Green Pinecone

Cut 6 strips 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 3.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 3

Side borders should be 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the multi plaid strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
