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# GATHERED PRECUTS

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 45 ½" × 68"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project.  
Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric  
RST = Right Sides Together

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Claus & Co. collection.

(1) 10-17740-42 10" Stacker

### Additional Fabrics:

½ yard C17747-MULTI Candy Cane Stripes (binding)  
1 ⅝ yards WB17748-MULTI Claus & Co. Star Wide Back  
(includes backing)

## OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies  
Batting

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

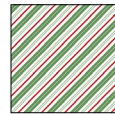
When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



### 10" Stacker

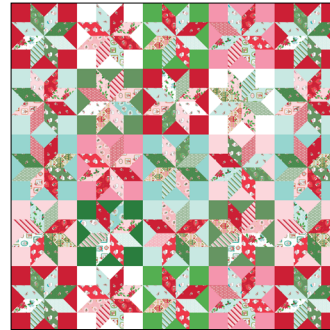
From your choice of fabrics, cut a total of:  
(55) 5" × 9 ½" rectangles\*. Label as A.

\*Note: Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 3 for the orientation of the rectangles and cut pieces so all directional fabrics are facing upright.



### Multi Candy Cane Stripes

Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.



### Multi Claus & Co. Star Wide Back

Cut (1) 53 ½" × 76" rectangle. Set aside for backing.

Note: This leaves a 4" overage on all sides of the quilt top for quilting. Cut a larger rectangle if you prefer a larger overage.

From remaining fabric, fussy cut:

(10) 9 ½" × 9 ½" squares, centered over a star motif.  
Label as B.

## SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

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## QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Arrange (55) **A**-rectangles and (10) **B**-squares into (5) columns as shown below, making sure each fabric is facing upright if desired. Each column will have (11) **A**-rectangles and (2) **B**-squares. Sew the rectangles and squares together into columns. Next, sew the columns together to complete the quilt top.



## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

2. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Multi Candy Cane Stripes binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
