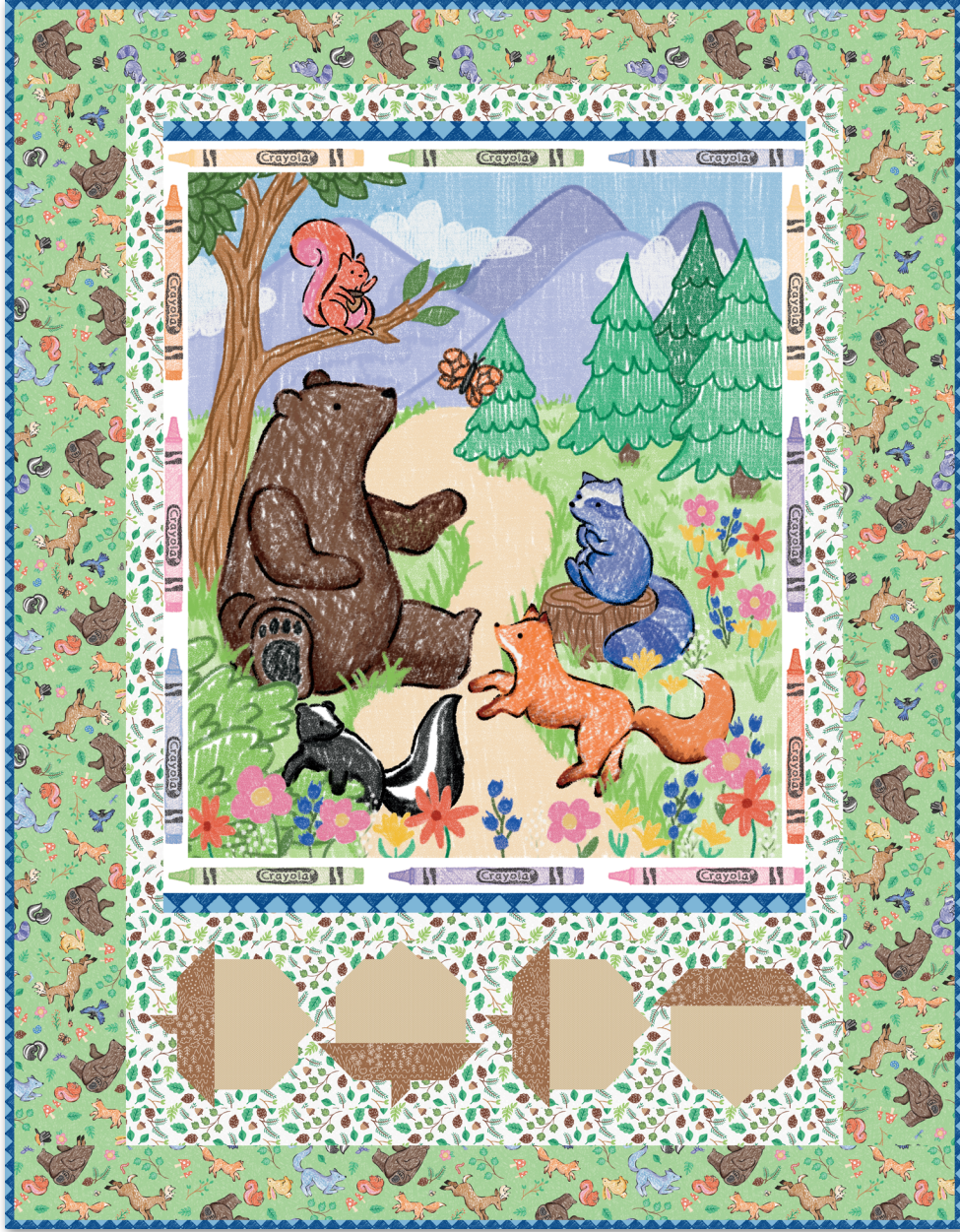

# COLORFUL CRITTERS PANEL QUILT

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE 51" × 65 ½"**

Please read all instructions before beginning this project.  
Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.  
Pattern designed by The RBD Designers.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check [www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates) or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric  
RST = Right Sides Together  
SNF = Stitch and Flip

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Colorful Critters collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) P17915-PANEL Colorful Critters Panel

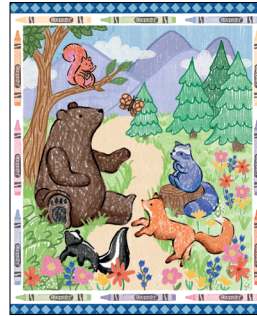

Fat ¼ C805-SAND POParazzi  
⅓ yard C17911-WHITE Botanical  
1 yard C17910-GREEN Main  
½ yard C17913-BLUE Check (binding)

## OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies  
1 ⅓ yards WB6422-BLUE Plaid Bee Backing (wide back backing)  
Batting

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

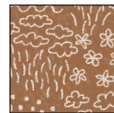
When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



### Colorful Critters Panel

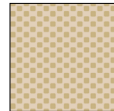
Fussy cut (1) 35" × 43" Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.\*

\*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.



### Brown Sketch

Cut (4) 2 ½" × 9 ½" rectangles. Label as A.  
Cut (4) 1 ½" × 2" rectangles. Label as B.



### Sand POParazzi

Cut (4) 5" × 7 ½" rectangles. Label as C.  
Cut (8) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares. Label as D.



### White Botanical

Cut (5) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Piece (3) together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 2 ½" × 43" strips. Label as E.

From remainder of all strips, cut:

(2) 2 ½" × 39" rectangles. Label as F.

(8) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as G.

Cut (3) 2" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(1) 2" × 39" rectangle. Label as H.

(8) 2" × 4 ½" rectangles. Label as I.

(8) 2" × 2" squares. Label as J.

(2) 1 ¾" × 9 ½" rectangles. Label as K.

(4) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares. Label as L.

Cut (2) 1 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(8) 1 ½" × 6" rectangles. Label as M.

(8) 1 ½" × 4" rectangles. Label as N.

## Green Main

Cut (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 6 1/2" x 57 1/2" strips. Label as O.

Cut (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 4 1/2" x 51" strips. Label as P.



## Blue Check

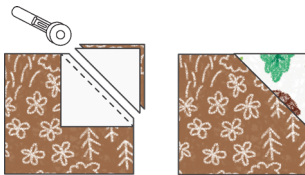
Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

## SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

### STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to 1/4". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- Gather the required pieces and use the SNF method to make the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.

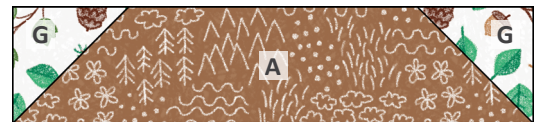

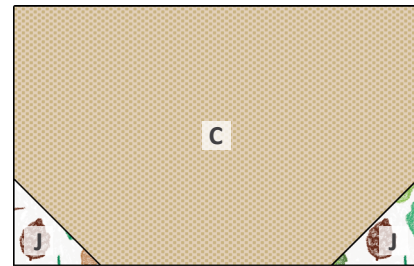

- Sew (2) I-rectangles and (1) B/L SNF unit together as shown below to make (1) Acorn Stem Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

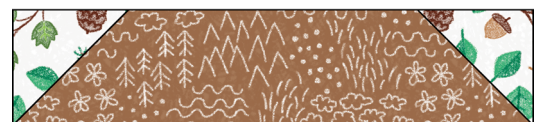

- Sew (1) Acorn Stem Unit and (1) A/G SNF unit together as shown below to make (1) Acorn Top Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

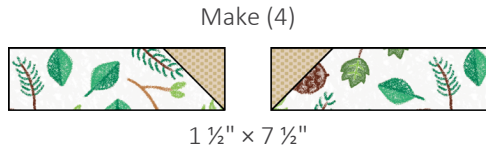

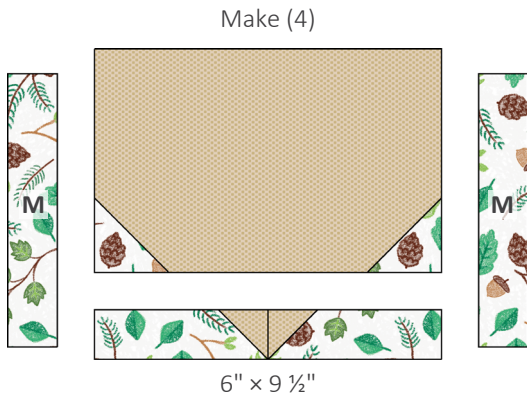

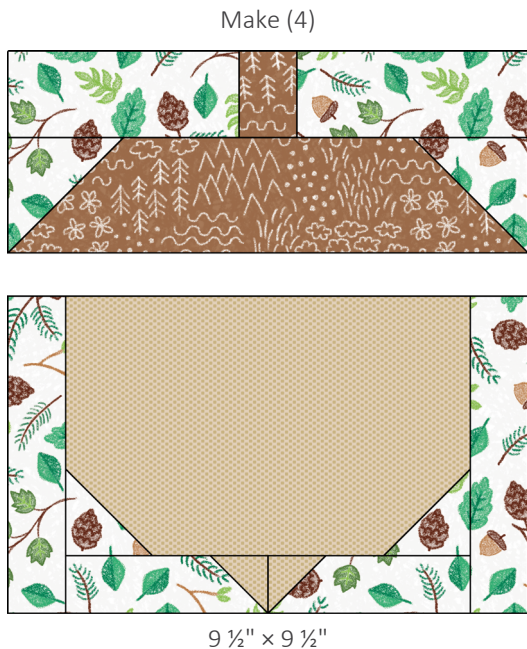
4. Sew (1) of each D/N SNF unit together as shown below to make (1) Acorn Tip Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



5. Sew (1) C/J SNF unit and (1) Acorn Tip Unit together as shown below. Next, sew (1) **M**-rectangle to each side to make (1) Acorn Bottom Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

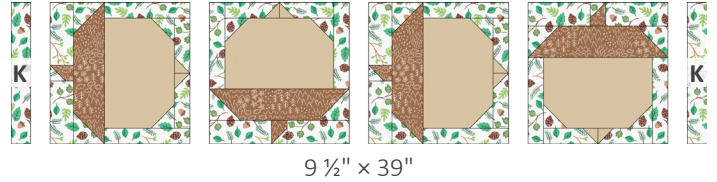


6. Sew (1) Acorn Top Unit and (1) Acorn Bottom Unit together as shown below to make (1) Acorn Block. Repeat to make (4) total blocks.

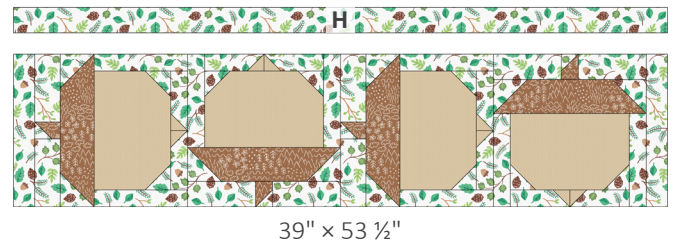


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

7. Sew (2) **K**-rectangles and (4) Acorn Blocks together as shown below to make (1) Acorn Row Unit.



8. Sew (1) **E**-strip to each side of (1) Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **H**-rectangle and (1) Acorn Row Unit to the bottom to make the quilt center.

9. Sew (1) **F**-rectangle to the top and bottom of the quilt center as shown below. Next, sew (1) **O**-strip to each side and (1) **P**-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

10. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Blue Check binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
