Finished Block Size 8" $\times 8$ "
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

3/4 yard multi main (C2620 Multi)
1 yard green animals (C2621 Green)
2 yard black flowers (C2622 Black)
$1 / 3$ yard brown flowers (C2622 Brown)
1/4 yard brown stars (C2623 Brown)
$1 / 4$ yard green stars (C2623 Green)
$1 / 4$ yard maroon stars (C2623 Maroon)
$1 / 4$ yard black checkers (C2624 Black)
$1 / 4$ yard maroon checkers (C2624 Maroon)
$1 / 4$ yard orange checkers (C2624 Orange)
$1 / 2$ yard green dots (C2625 Green)
$1 / 4$ yard orange dots (C2625 Orange)
$5 / 8$ yard gold dots (C2625 Gold)
$1 / 4$ yard green daisy (C2626 Green)
$1 / 4$ yard orange daisy (C2626 Orange)
$13 / 4$ yard cream shade (C200-02 Cream)
Binding $2 / 3$ yard
Backing $4^{1 / 2}$ yards

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

## Quilt Center

Cut 1 rectangle $24^{1 / 2 "} \times 32^{1 / 2}$ " from multi main (C2620 Multi)

## Border 1

Cut 4 strips 21/2" $\times$ WOF from gold dots (C2625 Gold)

## Border 2

Cut 4 strips $61 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF from green animals (C2621 Green)

## Border 3 Corner Star Block

Cut 32 squares $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from green dots (C2625 Green)
Cut 4 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2}$ " from green dots (C2625 Green)
Cut 16 squares $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 /{ }^{1 / 2}$ " from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)
Cut 32 rectangles $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)
Cut 32 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from green stars (C2623 Green)
Cut 16 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2}$ " from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)
Cut 32 rectangles $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2$ " from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)

## Border 3 Star Block

Cut 88 squares $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)
Cut 88 rectangles $2 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)
Cut $21 / 2 "$ squares in the corresponding number from the following prints:
24-C2622 Black, 24-C2622 Brown, 8-C2623 Brown
8-C2623 Maroon, 16-C2624 Maroon, 16-C2624 Black
16-C2624 Orange, 24-C2625 Gold, 8-C2625 Orange
16-C2626 Green, 16-C2626 Orange
Cut $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares in the corresponding number from the following prints:
3-C2622 Black, 3-C2622 Brown, 1-C2623 Brown
1-C2623 Maroon, 2-C2624 Maroon, 2-C2624 Black
2-C2624 Orange, 3-C2625 Gold, 1-C2625 Orange
2-C2626 Green, 2-C2626 Orange

## Border 4

Cut 7 strips 81/2" x WOF from black flowers (C2622 Black)

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of blocks.

## Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the Star Block diagram for piece placement. Trace a pencil line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ assorted print square. Place the square in the corner of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream shade rectangle and sew on the pencil line. Leave a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units. Sew a Flying Geese Unit to each side of a $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " assorted print square. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream shade square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Star Block. Repeat to make a total of 22 Star Blocks.

## Corner Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the Corner Star Block diagram for piece placement. Trace a pencil line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a $11 / 2$ " green dots square. Place the square in the corner of a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2 "$ cream shade rectangle and sew on the pencil line. Leave a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units. Sew a Flying Geese Unit to each side of a $21 / 2$ " green dots square. Sew a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream shade square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Corner Star Center. Repeat to make a total of 4 Corner Star Centers.



Corner Star Block

Finish the Corner Star Block by following the instructions for the Star Block above. Use the Corner Star Center in place of the $41 / 2$ " assorted print square.

## Quilt Center Assembly

See quilt photo for quilt center and border placement. Sew borders around the quilt center $24^{1 / 2 "} \times 32^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle. Sew the side borders first. Sew the top and bottom borders.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be $321 / 2$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $281 / 2$ ".

## Border 2

Side borders should be $361 / 2$ ". Top and bottom borders should be 40¹/2".

## Border 3

Sew 2 rows with 6 Star Blocks together. Sew one row to each side of the quilt. Sew 2 rows with 5 Star Blocks. Sew a Corner Star Block to each end. Sew a row to the top and bottom of the quilt.

## Border 4

Side borders should be 641/2". Top and bottom borders should be $721 / 2$ "'.
Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Country Harvest Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.

REVISIONS
Cutting Requirements for Border 3 Corner Star Block
Cut 32 rectangles $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from cream shade (C200-02) should be changed to Cut 16 rectangles $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from cream shade (C200-02)
Cut 32 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ from cream shade (C200-02) should be changed to Cut 16 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from cream shade (C200-02)

Depending on how many extra inches are required for machine quilting, the amount of yardage for the back may need to be increased from $41 / 2$ yards to 5 yards.
