Finished Block Size 12" x 12 "
WOF $=$ Width of Fabric, LOF $=$ Length of Fabric
This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

1 fat eighth navy main (C5360 Navy)
1 fat eighth teal recipe (C5361 Teal)
1 fat eighth blue snowman (C5363 Blue)
1 fat eighth pink snowman (C5363 Pink)
1 fat eighth yellow snowman (C5363 Yellow)
1 fat eighth blue reindeer (C5364 Blue)
1 fat eighth pink reindeer (C5364 Pink)
1 fat eighth mint sparkle (C5365 Mint)
1 fat eighth red sparkle (C5365 Red)
1 fat eighth white sparkle (C5365 White)
1 fat eighth blue square (C5366 Blue)
1 fat eighth green square (C5366 Green)
1 fat eighth pink square (C5366 Pink)
1 fat eighth blue wrapping paper (C5367 Blue)

$5 / 8$ yard ( 60 cm ) peony solid (C120 Peony) - Applique Background
$1 / 2 / 2$ yard ( 50 cm ) white reindeer (C5364 White) - Inner Border
11⁄yards ( 1.15 m ) white sparkle (C5365 White) - Pieced Background
2 yards ( 1.85 m ) white mini ric-rac
Binding $3 / 4$ yard ( 70 cm )
Backing $3 ½$ yards ( 3.25 m )

## OTHER SUPPLIES

Cozy Christmas Sew Simple Shapes
Cute Little Buttons Jar
Clover $1 / 4$ " and $1 / 2$ " Bias Tape Makers
$61 / 2$ and $121 / 2$ " Square Rulers
Clover Press Perfect Point Turner
Pellon Sew-In Lightweight Interfacing
Matching 100\% Cotton Thread (Aurifil Happy Colors by
Bee in my Bonnet is recommended.)
Lori's Aurifloss (100\% Cotton Embroidery Floss by Aurifil)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Your seam allowances may vary so measure through the center of your quilt before cutting sashing and border pieces.

## Teal Main

Cut 4 strips $61 / 2$ " x LOF for Border 3. Use remaining fabric for Flying Geese and Half Square Triangles.

## Red Recipe

Cut 11 strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 16 rectangles $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ for vertical sashing and 5 rectangles $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for horizontal sashing.

## White Reindeer

Cut 5 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Border 2.

## White Sparkle

Cut 9 strips $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 144 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 212^{\prime \prime}$ for Flying Geese and Blocks.
Cut 4 strips 3 " $\times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 48 squares $3 " \times 3$ " for Half Square Triangles. You may want more if you want your Half Square Triangles to be scrappier.

## Peony Solid

Cut 3 strips 7" x WOF. Cut the strips into 12 squares $7 " \times 7$ " for Blocks. Use a piece of the remaining fabric for applique in Block 4.

## Binding

We used pink stripe (C5368 Pink) cut on the bias.

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS (continued)

Assorted Print, Nutmeg, and Snow Fat Eighths
Cut 6 rectangles $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 6 rectangles $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ from each of the white background bell prints (from the fat eighth panels) and the white sparkle.


Cutting Diagram
Prepare applique pieces from assorted prints. The nutmeg solid is used in Blocks 2, 3, 7, and 12. The snow shade is used in Blocks 5 and 8 .
Cut 48 rectangles $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from assorted prints for Flying Geese.
Cut 48 squares 3" x 3" from assorted prints for Half Square Triangles. You may want more if you want your Half Square Triangles to be scrappier.

## Cozy Christmas Block

The applique portion of the block is made using one of Lori's applique methods. The link below to Week 1 of the Bloom Sew Along shows her applique technique.

Applique the shapes onto a peony solid 7" square. Embroider as needed for each block. Don't add the buttons until after the quilting has been finished. After the applique and embroidery is complete, use the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ruler to square up the block to $61 / 2$ ".

Sew an assorted print $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the left and right side of the peony solid $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " appliqued square to create Unit A.


Unit A
Sew the matching assorted print $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit A to create the Center Unit.


Center Unit
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 white sparkle 3 " squares. With right sides together, place a white sparkle 3 " square on top of an assorted print $3^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 16 assorted print Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $2 \not 1 / 2$ ". Only 8 Half Square Triangles will be used in one block. Set the other 8 aside for different blocks.


Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 white sparkle $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place a white sparkle $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of an assorted print $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 assorted print Flying Geese Units.


Sew a Half Square Triangle to each side of a Flying Geese Unit to create Unit B. Repeat to create 4 assorted print Unit Bs.


Unit B

## QUILT ASSEMBLY (continued)

Sew a Unit B to each side of the Center Unit to create Unit C.


Unit C

Sew a white sparkle $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to each side of the 2 remaining Unit Bs to create 2 assorted print Unit Ds.


Unit D
Sew a Unit D to the top and bottom of Unit B to complete the Cozy Christmas Block. Use the $121 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ruler to square up the block to $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to create 12 Cozy Christmas Blocks.

## Sashing and Blocks

Refer to the Quilt Photo for sashing and block placement. Sew a red recipe $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to a Cozy Christmas Block. Repeat to make a row with 4 sashing rectangles and 3 blocks. Make 4 sashing and block rows.


Sashing and Block Row

Quilt Center Assembly
Refer to the Quilt Photo for sashing and row placement. Lay out the 5 red recipe $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing rectangles and the 4 sashing and block rows. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Borders

Your seam allowances may vary so measure through the center of your quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

## Inner Border

Side borders should be $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 531^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$. Top and bottom borders should be $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

## Outer Border

Side borders should be $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 57 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake Designs fabric from the Cozy Christmas Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt!
