CRAYON BOX MINI

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 28½" x 39"

Finished Crayon Block Size 3½" x 17"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology and foundation piecing. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Crayola Fat Eighth Box (FEB-CR120-10)

½ yard (50 cm) Riley black solid (C120 Riley Black)

⅝ yard (60 cm) Riley white solid (C120 Riley White)

Binding ⅓ yard (35 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Eighth Box

Cut 1 rectangle 4" x 17½" and 1 Crayon Top Center (use template provided) from each fat eighth.

Riley Black Solid

Cut 20 Serpentine Tops and 20 Serpentine Bottoms (use templates provided). Reverse image or add ¼" seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

Riley White Solid

Cut 1 strip 4" x WOF. Cut the strip into 10 Crayon Top Sides and 10 Crayon Top Sides Reversed (use template provided).

Cut 1 strip 4½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 10 rectangles 4" x 4½". Label as Piece C.

Cut 4 strips 2½" x WOF for Border.

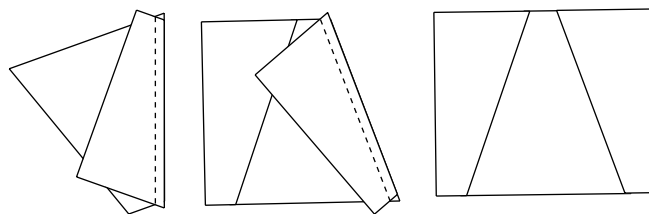
QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Crayon Block and Row

Using your preferred method of applique, sew 4 Riley black solid Serpentine (2 Tops and 2 Bottoms) to a Crayola solid 4" x 17½" rectangle to create a Crayon Base. Repeat to for all 10 colors. See Sewing Instruction #1.

With right sides together and referring to the diagram below, stitch 1 Crayon Top Side and 1 Crayon Top Side Reversed to the sides of a Crayola solid Crayon Top Center to create the Crayon Top. Repeat for all 10 colors.



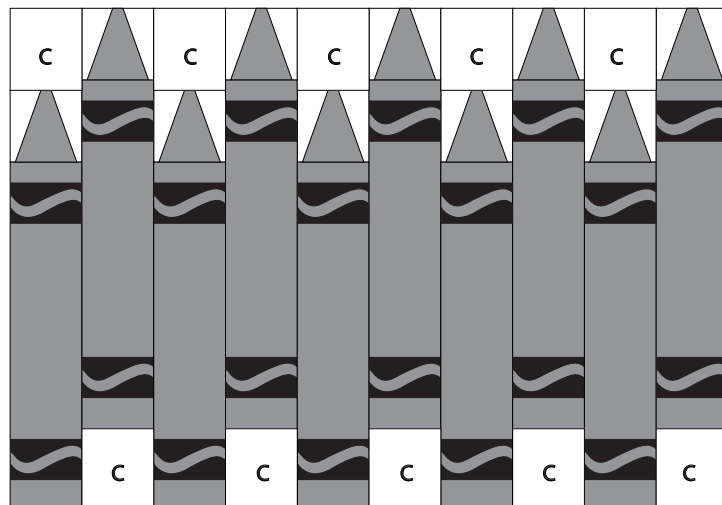
Stitch the Crayon Top to the Crayon Base to complete the Crayon Block. Repeat for all 10 colors.



Crayon Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Lay out the Crayon Blocks in desired order. Using the diagram below, sew Piece C to the top of the odd numbered crayons. Sew Piece C to the bottom of the even numbered crayons. Sew the units together to complete the quilt center.



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Border

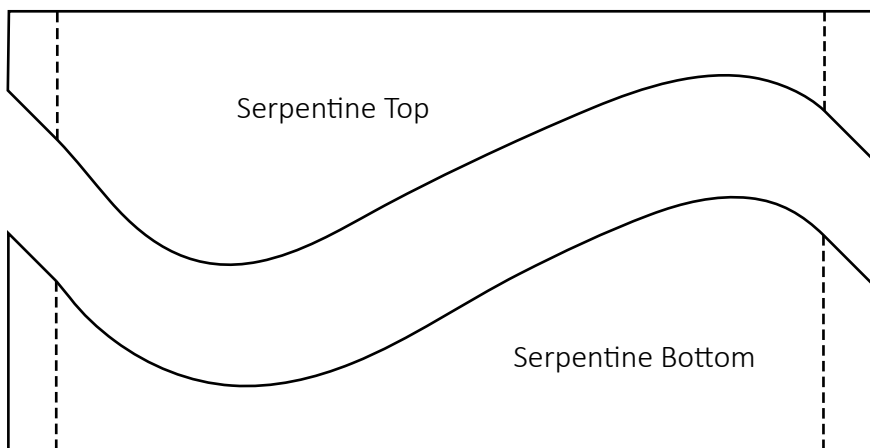
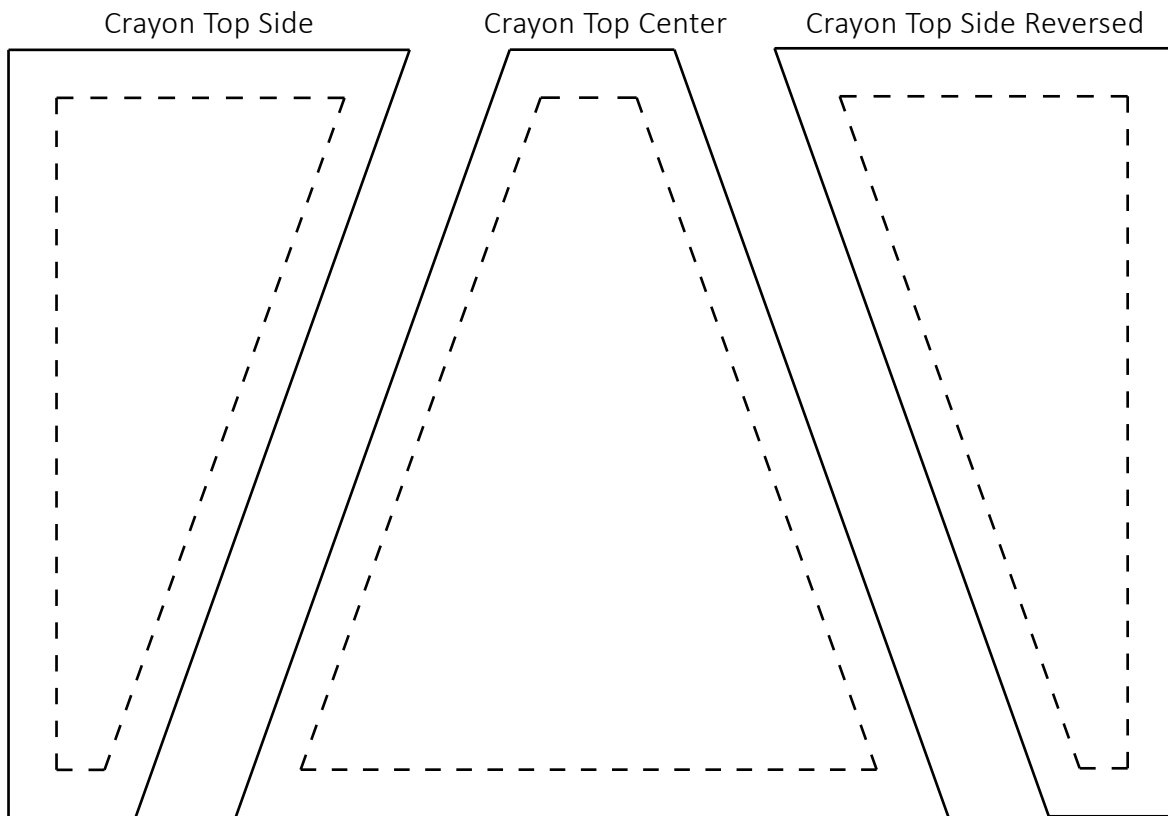
Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Side borders should be 25". Top and bottom borders should be 39½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Knock on Wood Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.

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Sewing Instruction #1



This should measure 1".

Dashed lines indicate seam allowance.
