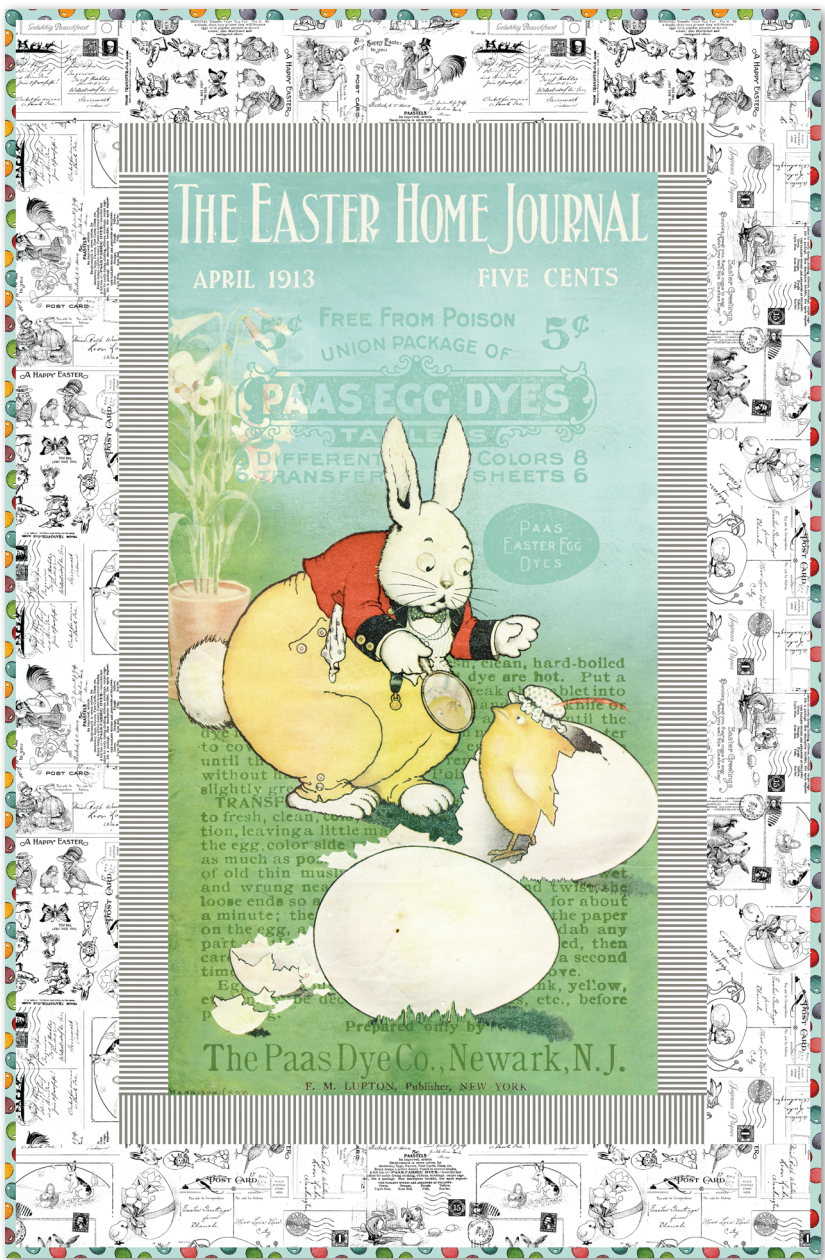

# THE EASTER HOME JOURNAL PANEL QUILT

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 37" x 57"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project.  
Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Egg Hunt collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) PD17140-PANEL The Easter Home Journal Main Panel

### Additional Fabrics:

$\frac{3}{8}$  yard C17149-GRAY Stripes

$\frac{7}{8}$  yard C17153-BLACK Easter Post

$\frac{1}{2}$  yard C17147-AQUA Jelly Beans (binding)

## OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

1  $\frac{1}{4}$  yards WB17154-AQUA Easter Post (wide back backing)

Batting

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

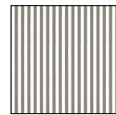
When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



### The Easter Home Journal Main Panel

Fussy cut (1) 23" x 43" Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.\*

*\*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.*



### Gray Stripes

Cut (4) 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 43" strips. Label as A.

(2) 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 27  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as B.

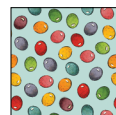


### Black Easter Post

Cut (5) 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 47  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as C.

(2) 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 37" strips. Label as D.



### Aqua Jelly Beans

Cut (5) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for binding.

## SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

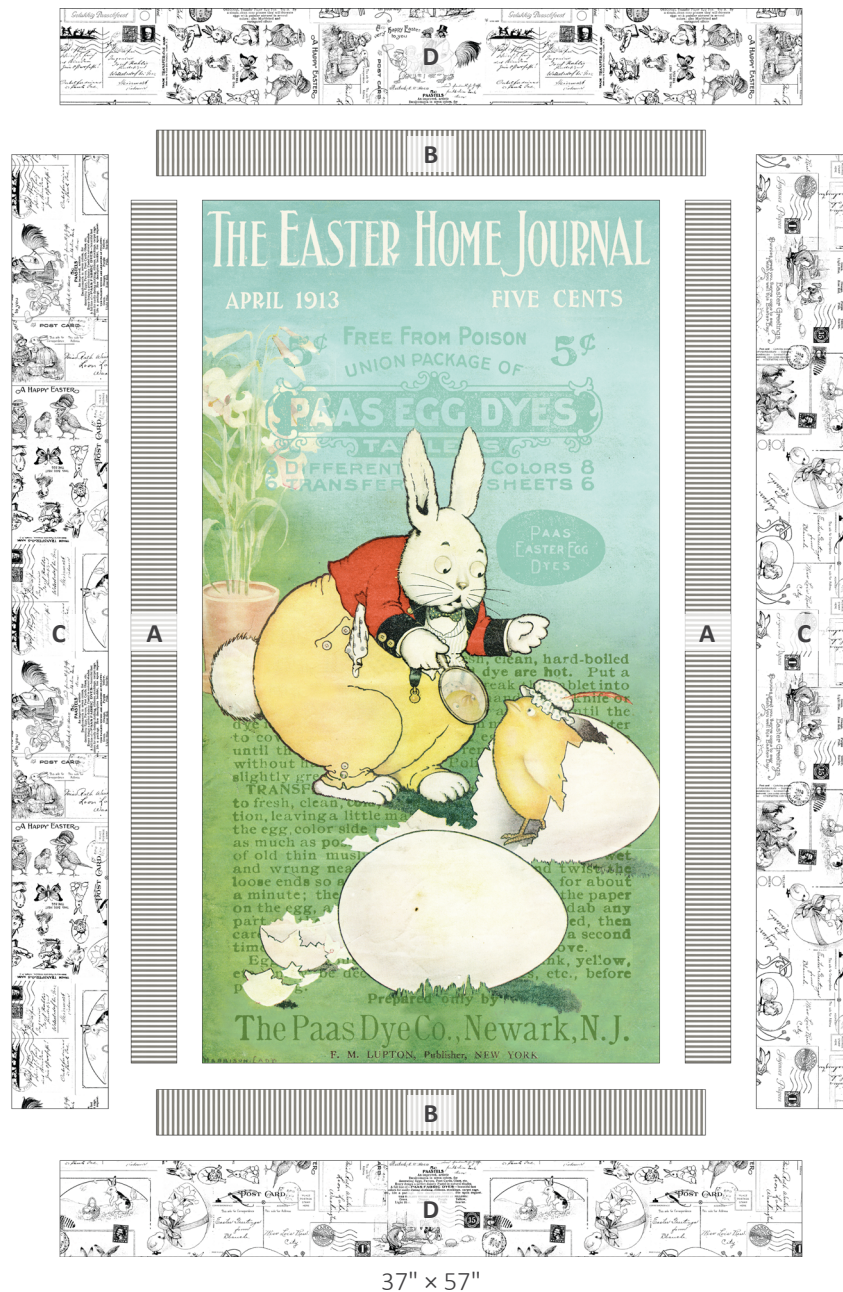


# THE EASTER HOME JOURNAL PANEL QUILT

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **A**-strip to each side of the Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **B**-strip to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **C**-strips to the sides and **D**-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

2. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Aqua Jelly Beans binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
