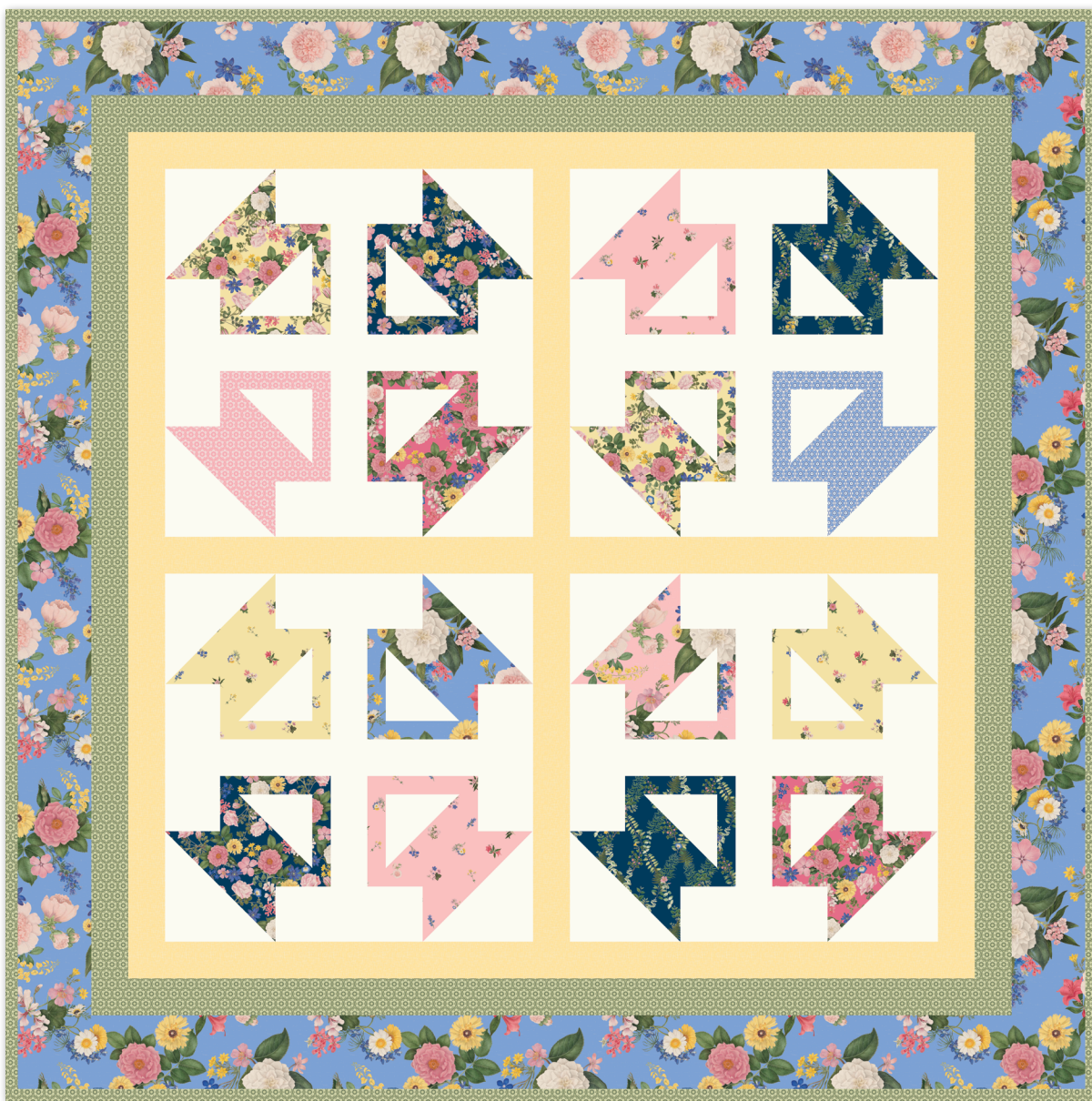

Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

HST = Half Square Triangle

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Everbloom collection unless stated otherwise.

10" Square of Each:

CD18050-PINK Main

C18054-BLUE Tiles

C18054-PINK Tiles

Fat 1/8 of Each:

CD18051-HOT PINK Flowers

CD18051-NAVY Flowers

CD18051-YELLOW Flowers

CD18052-NAVY Lattice

CD18053-PINK Flower Toss

CD18053-YELLOW Flower Toss

Additional Fabrics:

3/8 yard C610-BUTTERCREAM Texture

3/4 yard CD18050-BLUE Main

7/8 yard C120-CLOUD Confetti Cotton™ Solid

2/3 yard C18054-GREEN Tiles (includes binding)

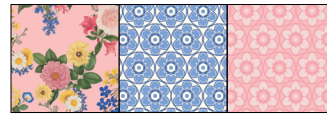
Basic Sewing Supplies

1 1/2 yards WB805-CREAM POParazzi (wide back backing)

Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Pink Main, Blue Tiles, and Pink Tiles

From each 10" square, cut:

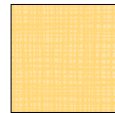
- (1) $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " square, cutting in half diagonally to make (2) total triangles. You will only use (1) triangle. Label as A.
- (1) $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " square. Label as B.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as C.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as D.



Hot Pink Flowers, Navy Flowers, Yellow Flowers, Navy Lattice, Pink Flower Toss, Yellow Flower Toss

From each Fat 1/8, cut:

- (1) $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " square, cutting in half diagonally to make (2) total triangles. Label as A.
- (2) $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Label as B.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as C.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as D.



Buttercream Texture

Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- (2) 2" x 35" rectangles. Label as E.
- (3) 2" x 32" rectangles. Label as F.
- (2) 2" x 15 1/2" rectangles. Label as G.



Blue Main

Cut (1) $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Subcut:

- (1) $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " square, cutting in half diagonally to make (2) total triangles. You will only use (1) triangle. Label as A.
- (1) $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " square. Label as B.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as C.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as D.

Cut (5) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Piece (3) together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 44" strips. Label as H.
- From remaining (2) strips, cut:
 - (2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 38" rectangles. Label as I.

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Cloud Confetti Cotton™ Solid

Cut (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Subcut:

(8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " x $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cutting each in half diagonally to make (16) total triangles. Label as J.

Cut (2) $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Subcut:

(16) $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Label as K.
(3) $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Label as L.

Cut (3) $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Subcut:

(45) $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Label as L.

Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

(4) 2" x $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as M.

(8) 2" x $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles. Label as N.



Green Tiles

Cut (5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

(2) 2" x 38" rectangles. Label as O.

(2) 2" x 35" rectangles. Label as P.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

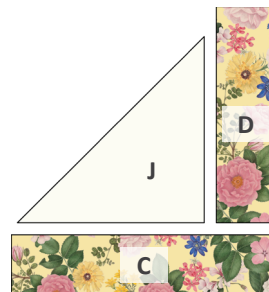
2-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (1) square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to the indicated size.

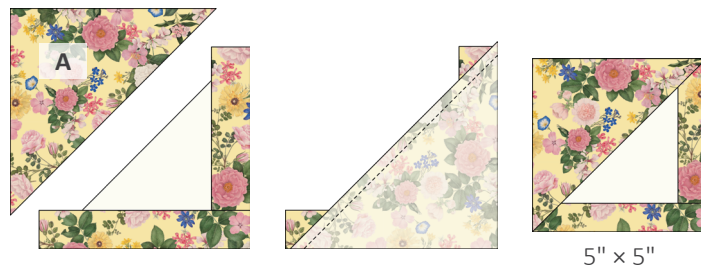


BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Gather a matching set of (1) **A**-triangle, (1) **B**-square, (1) **C**-rectangle, and (1) **D**-rectangle. Also, gather (1) **J**-triangle, (1) **K**-square, and (3) **L**-squares.
2. Sew (1) **D**-rectangle to the right side of (1) **J**-triangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **C**-rectangle to the bottom to make (1) Handle Unit.

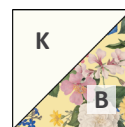


3. Sew (1) **A**-triangle to the diagonal edge of (1) Handle Unit as shown below, trimming any excess fabric outside the seam line, to make (1) Basket Top Unit. Trim the unit to measure 5" x 5".



4. Use the 2-at-a-time HST method with (1) **K**-square and (1) **B**-square to make (2) HST units as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation.

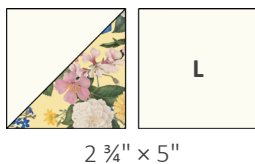

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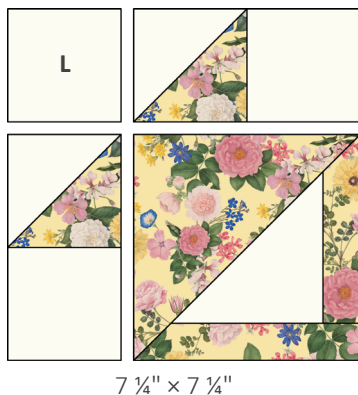
5. Sew (1) HST unit and (1) **L**-square together as shown below to make (1) Basket Side Unit.



6. Sew (1) HST unit and (1) **L**-square together as shown below to make (1) Basket Bottom Unit.

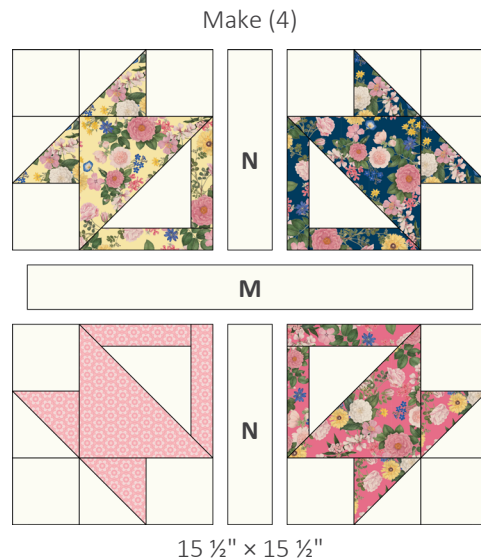


7. Arrange (1) **L**-square, (1) Basket Bottom Unit, (1) Basket Side Unit, and (1) Basket Top Unit as shown below. Sew the pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Basket Unit.



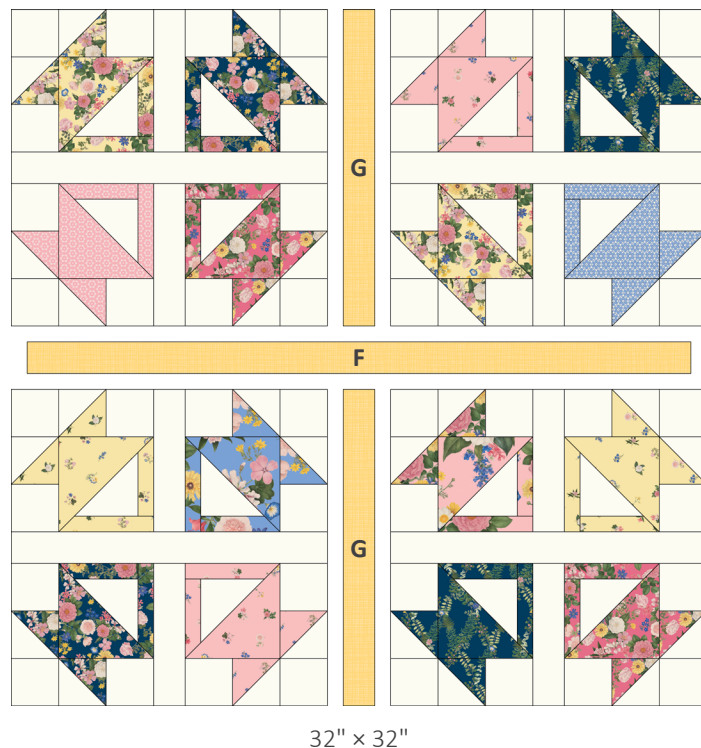
8. Repeat steps 1-7 to make (16) total Basket Units.

9. Arrange (4) Basket Units, (2) **N**-rectangles, and (1) **M**-rectangle as shown below. Sew the units and rectangles together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Basket Block. Repeat to make (4) total blocks.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

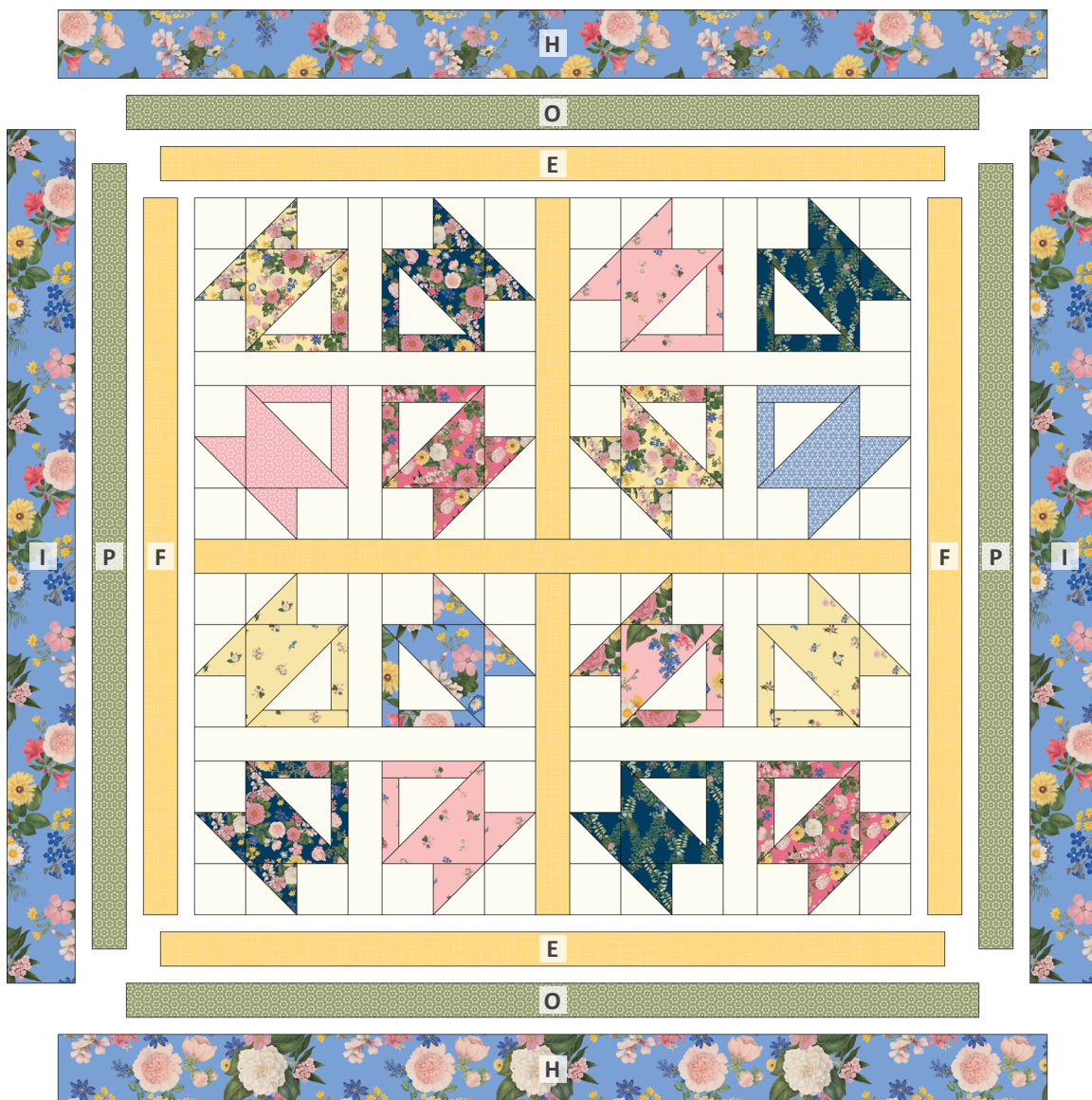
10. Arrange (4) Basket Blocks, (2) **G**-rectangles, and (1) **F**-rectangle as shown below. Sew the blocks and rectangles together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.



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11. Sew (1) **F**-rectangle to each side of the quilt center. Next, sew (1) **E**-rectangle to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **P**-rectangles to the sides and **O**-rectangles to the top and bottom. Next, sew **I**-rectangles to the sides and **H**-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

12. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Green Tiles binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
