## CHERRIES JUBILEE "

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 54" $\times$ 56½"
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
Please check our website https://www.rileyblakede-signs.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Expressions Batiks Collection unless otherwise indicated.
1 Jubilee 10" Stacker (10-JBLI-42)
$1 / 8$ yard of each:
Elementals Shamrock (BTHH507-SHAMROCK) Elementals Emerald (BTHH527-EMERALD)
$1 / 4$ yard of Elementals Pumpkin (BTHH500-PUMPKIN) ½ yard Tjaps Lipstick (BTCB1001-LIPSTICK) - binding 1⁄ yard Tjaps Apple (BTPT1094-APPLE) 218s yards Hand-Dyes Cream (BTHH184-CREAM)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting instructions are based on a 42" WOF.
- Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics included in the kit.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.
- Accurate measuring techniques are key.
- Label pieces as they are cut.


## Jubilee 10" Stacker

Heart Blocks:
Select (12) 10" squares for Hearts; cut EACH square :
(1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as Cut $\mathbf{C}$.
(1) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as Cut B.
(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Label as Cut D.

Cherry Blocks:
Select (7) 10" squares for Cherries; cut EACH square into:
(4) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as $\mathbf{F}$.

Note: There will be a few leftover 10" squares.

## Hand-Dyes Cream

Cut (5) $411 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut:
(24) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as Cut A.
(26) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Label as Cut $\mathbf{H}$.

Cut (3) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut:
(48) $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Label as Cut $\mathbf{E}$.

Cut (4) 2" $\times$ WOF strips; subcut:
(26) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Label as Cut $\mathbf{M}$.
(26) 2" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Label as Cut J.

Cut (19) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips:
Set aside (10) strips for the inner border and sashing From the remaining (9) strips; subcut:
(20) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips
(104) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as Cut $\mathbf{G}$.

Cut (3) $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut:
(52) $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 13 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Label as Cut $\mathbf{L}$.


Tjaps Apple
Cut (5) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for outer border.


## Tjaps Lipstick

Cut (6) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding.


## Elementals Pumpkin

Cut (2) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut:
(26) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Label as Cut I.


## Elementals Shamrock

Cut (1) strip 3" $\times$ WOF; subcut:
(13) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " squares. Label as Cut K.


## Elementals Emerald

Cut (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut:
(13) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " squares. Label as Cut K.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Refer to the cutting requirements list, cover image and quilt layout diagram for the placement of prints.
- Except for the Heart sets, organize the pieces alphabetically. The instructions will call for pieces in alphabetical order.
- Follow pressing arrows for successful piecing.
- Orient the pieces according to their pertinent diagrams. Doing so is essential to following relational instructions such as top, bottom, left, right and so on.
- All angled seams are constructed using the Stitch and Flip method. The method is explained and referenced in the pattern.


## HEART BLOCKS - STITCH AND FLIP (SNF) METHOD

Note the block sizes and orientation of the drawn lines in the diagrams.

1. Select (1) B rectangle and (2) A squares.
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (2) $A$ squares.
3. Place (1) A square on the left side of the $B$ rectangle, RST and edges aligned.
4. Sew directly on the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric to a $1 / 4$ " seam. Press to the corner.
5. Repeat the SNF method to attach an A square to the right side of $B$ rectangle. Heart Bottom unit will measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

6. Select (1) D rectangle and (2) E rectangles.
7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (2) E rectangles as shown.

8. Place (1) E rectangle on the top left corner of the D rectangle, RST and edges aligned.
9. Sew directly on the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric to a $1 / 4 / 4$ seam. Press to the corner.
10. Repeat the SNF method to attach a E rectangle to the right side of the D rectangle. Heart Top unit will measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
11. Repeat to make (2) Heart Top units.

12. Take the (2) Heart Top units and piece together end-to-end. Unit will measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished

13. Lay out (1) Heart Bottom unit, (1) pieced Heart Top unit, and (1) C rectangle as shown.

14. Sew the pieced Heart Top to the C rectangle. Press seams towards C.
15. Sew the Heart Bottom to the $C$ rectangle. Press seams towards C. Heart Block will measure $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ x 9" unfinished.

16. Repeat the Heart Block instructions to make (12) blocks total.

## CHERRY BLOCKS

Note the block sizes and orientation of the drawn lines in the diagrams.

## Cherry Units

17. Select (1) F square and (4) G squares.
18. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (4) G squares.
19. Place (1) G square on the top left corner of the $F$ square, RST and edges aligned.
20. Sew directly on the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press to the corner.
21. Repeat the SNF method to attach a G square to each corner of the F square. Cherry Unit will measure $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

22. Repeat to make (26) Cherry Units.
23. Sew (2) Cherry Units together side-to-side to make the Cherry Row. Unit measures $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

24. Repeat to make (13) Cherry Rows.

## Stem Units

25. Select (1) H rectangle, (1) I square, and (1) J square.
26. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $I$ and J squares.
27. Place the I square on the left side of the H rectangle, RST and edges aligned.
28. Sew directly on the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press to the corner and press seams open.

29. Place the J square on the bottom left corner of the H/I rectangle, RST and edges aligned.
30. Sew directly on the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric to a $1 / 4 "$ seam. Press to the corner and press seams open.

31. Repeat to make (13) RIGHT stems.
32. Repeat to make (13) LEFT stems, ensuring that it is the mirror image of the right stem.

33. Sew a Left \& Right Stem Unit together side-to-side to make the Stem Row. Press seam open. Stem Row measures $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

## Leaf Units

34. Select (1) $K$ square and (2) $L$ squares.
35. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $L$ squares.
36. Place the $L$ square on the top left corner of the $K$ square, RST and edges aligned.
37. Sew directly on the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press to the corner.

38. Repeat placing the $L$ square on the bottom right corner of the K square. Leaf Unit will measure 3" $x$ 3" unfinished.

39. Repeat to make (26) Leaf Units
40. Sew (2) Leaf Units in different colorways together side-by-side as shown with the Elementals Shamrock fabric on the right. Unit measures 3" x 5½" unfinished.

41. Select (2) M Rectangles and sew one to each side to make a Leaf Row. Leaf Row measures 3" x 81⁄2" unfinished.

42. Repeat to make (13) Leaf Rows.
43. Lay out (1) Leaf Row, (1) Stem Row, and (1) Cherry Row as shown.

44. Sew the pieced Leaf Row to the Stem Row. Press seams towards the Leaf Row.
45. Sew the Cherry Row to the Stem Row. Press seams towards the Cherry. Cherry Block will measure 8½" $\times 9$ "unfinished.


## QUILT CENTER

Note: Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram and cover art for placement details.
46. Sew (3) Cherry Blocks and (2) Heart Blocks together side-to-side, alternating positions and adding (4) sashing strips in between to make an Odd Row. Odd Row measures $9 \times 441 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Repeat to make (3) Odd Rows.

47. Repeat Step 46 using (3) Heart Blocks and (2) Cherry Blocks with (4) sashing strips to make an Even Row. Even Row measures 9" x 44½" unfinished. Repeat to make 2 Even Rows.

48. Piece together (5) Hand-Dyes Cream $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips together, end-to-end. Cut 4 strips, each $441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in length, from the long strip to make Horizontal sashing strips.
49. Sew the Odd and Even Rows together top to bottom, alternating positions and adding Horizontal sashing strips in between to complete the quilt center. Quilt center measures $441 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 47$ " unfinished.


Note: Seam allowances vary. Measure through the center of your quilt rows to determine an average width before cutting both inner and outer border strips.

## INNER BORDER

50. Piece together (5) Hand-Dyes Cream 11/2" x WOF strips together, end-to-end. Cut (2) strips, 47" long, and sew (1) to each side of the quilt center.
51. Cut (2) more strips, $461 / 2$ " long, and sew (1) to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt center. Quilt center now measures $461 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 49$ " unfinished.


## OUTER BORDER

52. Sew the (5) Tjaps Apple strips together end-to-end. Cut (2) strips 49" in length and sew (1) to each side of the quilt.
53. Cut (2) strips $541 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in length and sew (1) to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt. Quilt now measures $541 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 57$ ".


## FINISHING

Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with (6) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Tjabs Lipstick. Have fun and enjoy the journey of making your quilt!
