

## MAPLE LEAF QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 46" x 46"
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle
SNF = Stitch and Flip

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Expressions Batiks collection unless otherwise indicated.
(1) 5-APPLORCH-42 Apple Orchard 5" Stacker
(1) 5-SHDOR-42 Shades of Orange 5" Stacker
$1 / 2$ Yard BTHH136 Hand-Dyes Dark Orange 1
1 3/8 Yards BTHH184 Hand-Dyes Cream
½ Yard BTHH196 Hand-Dyes Rust (binding)

## OTHER SUPPLIES

1 ½ Yards BTWB279 Wide Back Hand-Dyes Cinnamon Basic Sewing Supplies
Batting (54" x 54")

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.


5-Inch Stackers
Select (51) 5" squares, label A.


Hand-Dyes Dark Orange 1
Cut (1) 14 " x WOF strip; subcut:
(1) $14^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ square, label B.

## Hand-Dyes Cream

Cut (1) 14 " x WOF strip; subcut:
(1) $14^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ square, label C.
(2) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, label $D$.

Cut (3) 5" x WOF strips, subcut:
(24) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label E.

Cut (5) 3 " $\times$ WOF strips for the border, label $F$.


Hand-Dyes Rust
Cut (5) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)
Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew directly on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance on one side of the sewn line to $1 / 4$ ". Open and press to the darker fabric to make (1) HST. Trim HST to desired size.


## STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST matching the raw edges in one corner. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the top piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Flip the top piece away from the bottom piece and press to the darker fabric, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.


## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using the 1-at-a-Time HST method, pair (1) A square with (1) E square. Make (12) total HST Units. Trim to 5" square.


## STEM BLOCK

2. Using the SNF method, replace the bottom left and top right corners of the $B$ square with (2) D squares.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

## SECTION 1

3. Lay out (6) HSTs, (6) A squares, (6) E squares, and (1) $C$ square as shown. Sew the HSTs, A, and E squares into (3) rows of (6) blocks. Sew the C square to the left side to complete Section 1. This section should measure 14 " $\times 41^{\prime \prime}$.


## SECTION 2

4. Lay out (3) HSTs, (21) A squares, and (3) E squares as shown. Sew the HSTS, A, and E squares into (3) rows of (9) blocks, then sew rows together to complete Section 2. This section should measure $14^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$.


## SECTION 3

5. Lay out (3) HSTs, (12) A squares, (3) E squares, and the Stem Block as shown. Sew the HSTs, A, and E squares into (3) rows of (6) blocks. Sew the Stem Block to the right side to complete Section 3 . This section should measure $14^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$.


SECTION 3
6. Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4, sew together from top to bottom Sections 1, 2, and 3 as shown to complete the quilt center. The quilt center should measure 41" $\times 41^{\prime \prime}$.

Note: Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.
7. Trim (2) F strips to $3^{\prime \prime} \times 41$ " and sew to the left and right sides of the quilt center.
8. Sew together (3) F strips end-to-end and cut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 46$ " strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Your quilt top should measure $46^{\prime \prime} \times 46^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the Hand-Dyes Rust binding strips.
