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FINISHED QUILT SIZE 70 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 82 $\frac{1}{8}$ "

Finished Block Size 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Fancy and Fabulous Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4840-18)

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (1.4 m) cream main (C4840 Cream)

3 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards (3 m) cream daisy (C750-01 Cream)

Binding $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm)

Backing 5 yards (4.6 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut squares 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

3–coral loving life, 3–mint loving life

2–yellow loving life, 1–coral pattern, 2–coral Y

3–mint Y, 3–yellow Y, 1–coral breath, 2–yellow breath

Cut squares 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

15–coral main, 10–mint main, 10–coral confetti

15–cream confetti, 10–mint confetti

10–coral loving life, 10–yellow loving life

10–coral pattern, 10–mint pattern, 15–yellow Y

10–coral breath, 10–mint breath, 15–yellow breath

Cream Main

Cut 8 strips 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border.

Cream Daisy

Cut 6 strips 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 40 squares 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ ". Cut each square once diagonally to create 80 triangles labeled A.

Cream Daisy (continued)

Cut 5 strips 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 30 squares 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut each square twice diagonally to create 120 triangles labeled B.

Cut 5 strips 3" x WOF. Cut the strips into 60 squares 3" x 3". Cut each square once diagonally to create 120 triangles labeled C.


Cut 3 strips 14" x WOF. Cut the strips into 5 squares 14" x 14" and 2 squares 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut the 14" squares twice diagonally to create 20 setting triangles (2 will not be used). Cut the 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares once diagonally to create 4 corner triangles.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

Granny Square Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Sew a cream daisy triangle B to each side of an assorted print 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit A's.




Unit A

Sew 3 assorted print 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to create Unit B.




Unit B

Sew a Unit A to each side of Unit B to create Unit C.



Unit C

Sew a cream daisy triangle C on each corner to create the Granny Square Block. Repeat to create 30 Granny Square Blocks.




Granny Square Block

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Square in a Square Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Sew 2 cream daisy triangle As to 2 opposite sides of an assorted print $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Press. Sew 2 more cream daisy triangle As to the 2 remaining opposite sides to create the Square in a Square Block. Repeat to create 20 Square in a Square Blocks.



Square in a Square Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Granny Square Block, Square in a Square Block, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on all sides.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Side borders should be $72\frac{5}{8}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $70\frac{5}{8}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Fancy and Fabulous Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
