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## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 38" $\times 42$ "

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Fly Aweigh 2.5-inch Rolie Polie (RP-3870-21)
$7 / 8$ yard ( 85 cm ) blue boat (C3870 Blue)
$3 / 4$ yard ( 70 cm ) snow white shade (C200-03 Snow White)
Binding $5 / 8$ yard $(60 \mathrm{~cm})$
Backing $11 / 3$ yards ( 1.25 m )

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border and sashing pieces.

## Rolie Polie

Cut 3 squares $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " and 1 rectangle $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ from each of the following assorted prints:
blue main, gray main, yellow main, blue boat, teal boat, red waves, yellow waves, blue flags, gray flags, yellow flags, white lobster, blue lures, red lures, yellow lures, red circles
Cut rectangles 2 " $\times 61 / 2$ " in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:
3-blue waves, 4-blue lobster, 4-aqua circles, 4-blue circles

## Snow White Shade

Cut 3 strips 2 " $\times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 30 rectangles 2 " $\times 31 / 2$ ".
Cut 3 strips $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 45 squares $2^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$.
Cut 4 strips $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 4 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$ for sashing.

## Blue Boat

Cut 4 strips $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF for border 1

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

## Sail Away Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 3 snow white shade $21 / 2$ " squares. Place the snow white shade $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares on top of 3 assorted print $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Sew $1 / 4 "$ on either side of the drawn line. Cut on line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Trim the half square triangles to 2" square. Repeat to make 6 Half Square Triangles.

Sew a 4 Half Square Triangles together to create Unit A.


Sew a snow white shade 2 " $\times 3^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle to the right and left sides of Unit A to create Unit B.


Unit B

Sew a 2 Half Square Triangles and the assorted print 2 " $\times 31 / 2$ " rectangle together to create Unit C.


Unit C
Sew Unit B, Unit C, and the assorted print 2" $\times 61 / 2$ " rectangle together to create the Sail Away Block. Repeat to create 15 Sail Away Blocks.


## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to quilt photo for block placement. Sew 5 Sail Away Blocks together to create a column. Repeat to make 3 columns of Sail Away Blocks. See quilt photo for column and sashing placement. Lay out the 3 columns of Sail Away Blocks and the 4 snow white shade $21 / 2$ " $\times 301 / 2 "$ sashing rectangles. Sew columns together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be $301 / 2 \prime$ ". Top and bottom borders should be 381/2".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Fly Aweigh Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
