FINISHED QUILT SIZE 31" $\times 38^{\prime \prime}$
Finished Block Size 7" x 7"
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Forget Me Not 10-Inch Stacker (10-4680-21)
$5 / 8$ yard ( 60 cm ) blue birds (C4681 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard $(25 \mathrm{~cm})$ cream stripe (C4686 Cream)
1 yard ( 95 cm ) cream shade (C200-02 Cream Shade)
Binding $5 / 8$ yard ( 60 cm )
Backing $11 / 4$ yards ( 1.15 m )

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

## 10-Inch Stacker

Cut 6 flowers from blue petal. Add $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance if necessary for your favorite applique method.
Cut 6 flower centers from navy petal. Add $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance if necessary for your favorite applique method.
Cut 6 stems and 12 leaves from tan petal. Add $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance if necessary for your favorite applique method.
Cut 7 squares $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ from each of the following assorted prints:
blue lace, navy floral, tan floral, blue eris cross, navy fris cross, tan eris cross
Cut 6 squares $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from each of the following assorted prints:
blue main, navy main, navy lace, tan lace, cream floral, blue stripe

Cream Shade
Cut 2 strips 8 " $\times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 6 squares $8^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$.
Cut 2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 24 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Cut 3 strips $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 72 squares $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

## Flower Block

Use your favorite method of applique. Refer to quilt photo for fabric placement. Applique the pieces on a cream shade $8^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. When finished with the applique, square up the block to $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71_{2}^{\prime \prime}$. Make 6 Flower Blocks.

## Chain Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the Chain Block diagram for piece placement as each block is a different combination of fabrics. Sew 5 print $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares (3 of one print and 2 of a second print) and 4 cream shade $112^{\prime \prime}$ squares together to create a Nine-Patch Unit.


Nine-Patch Unit

Sew a cream shade $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{11 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ rectangle to each side of the Nine-Patch Unit to create the Center Unit.


Center Unit
Sew 2 print $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares and 2 cream shade $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares together to create a Four-Patch. Repeat to make a second Four-Patch from the same print. Repeat with a different print to create 2 more Four-Patches. There should be 4 FourPatches (2 from each print).

## Cream Stripe

Cut 4 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Border 1 .

Sew a Four-Patch to each side of a cream shade $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit As.


Unit A
Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of the Center Unit to create the Chain Block. Repeat to create 6 Chain Blocks.

## Quilt Center Assembly

See quilt photo for Flower Block and Chain Block placement. Lay out the blocks in 4 rows of 3 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be $281 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Top and bottom borders should be $231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## Border 2

Side borders should be 30½". Top and bottom borders should be $311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Forget Me Not Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
