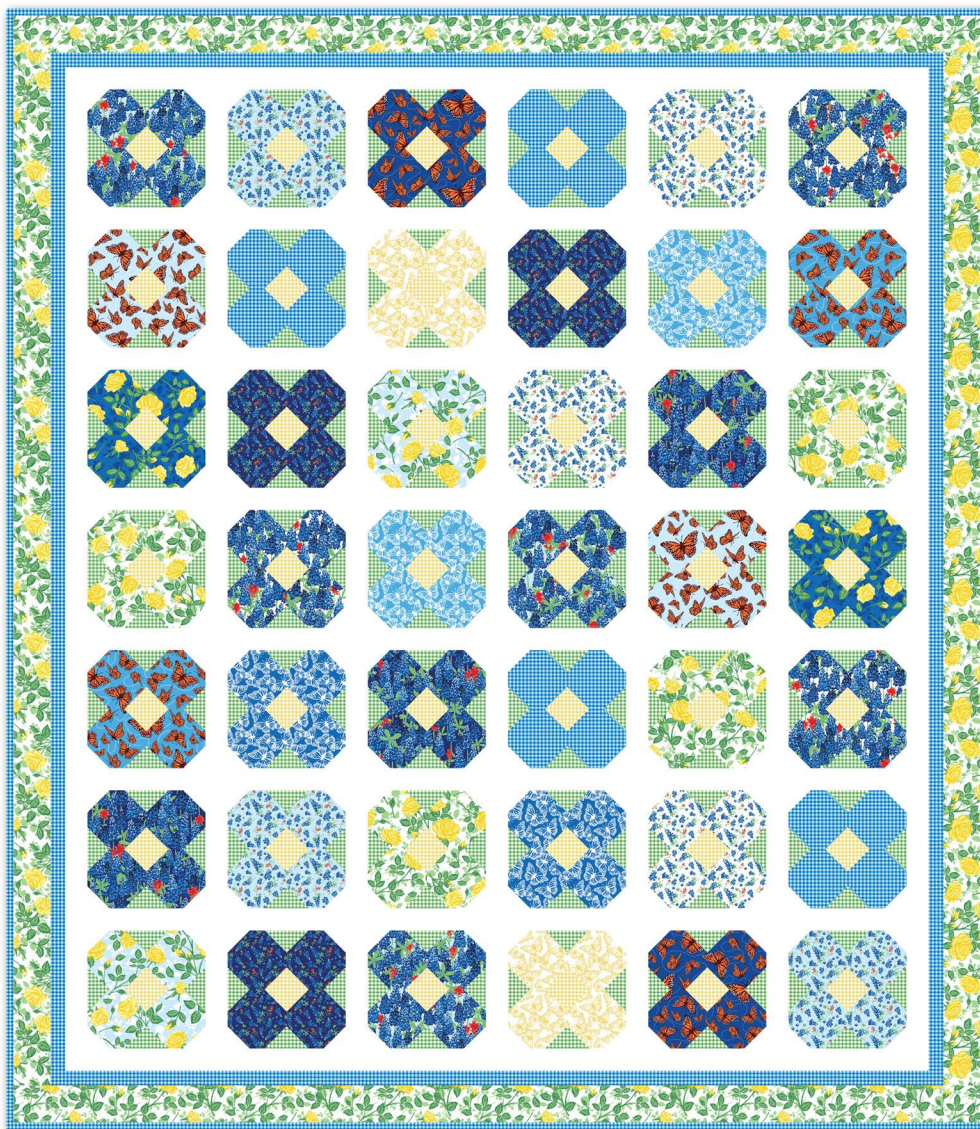

# FRIENDSHIP FLOWERS

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 66" x 75 ½"

Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.  
Pattern designed by The RBD Designers

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check [www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates) or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric  
RST = Right Sides Together  
SNF = Stitch and Flip

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Friendship Florals collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) 10-15840-42 10" Stacker

### Additional Fabrics:

½ yard C15845-YELLOW Gingham  
¾ yard C15841-WHITE Roses  
1 yard C15845-GREEN Gingham  
1 ⅞ yards C120-RILEYWHITE Confetti Cotton  
1 yard C15845-BLUE Gingham (includes binding)

## OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies  
2 ⅞ yards WB200-CHAMBRAY Shade Wide Back Backing  
Batting

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

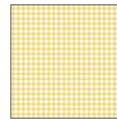
When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



### 10" Stacker

From each of (38) squares\*, cut:  
(4) 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares. Label as A.

\*Note: You will not use the Green Gingham and Yellow Gingham squares.



### Yellow Gingham

Cut (8) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
(168) 2" x 2" squares. Label as B.



### White Roses

Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
(8) 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares. Label as A.  
Cut (7) 3" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end, subcut:  
(2) 3" x 70 ½" strips. Label as C.  
(2) 3" x 66" strips. Label as D.



### Green Gingham

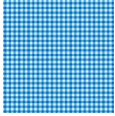
Cut (16) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
(336) 2" x 2" squares. Label as E.



### Riley White Confetti Cotton

Cut (32) 2" x WOF strips. Piece (12) together end-to-end; subcut:  
(8) 2" x 59" strips. Label as F.  
From remaining strips, subcut:  
(49) 2" x 8 ½" rectangles. Label as G.  
(168) 2" x 2" squares. Label as H.

# FRIENDSHIP FLOWERS



## Blue Gingham

Cut (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

(8) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares. Label as A.

Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

Cut (7) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end, subcut:

(2) 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips. Label as I.

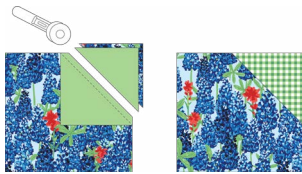
(2) 1 1/2" x 61" strips. Label as J.

## SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

### STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to 1/4". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.

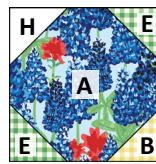


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Gather (4) matching **A**-squares, (4) **B**-squares, (8) **E**-squares, and (4) **H**-squares.

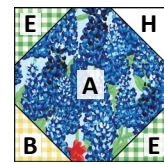
2. Use the SNF method to make the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation. If using directional prints, make sure each print is facing upright.

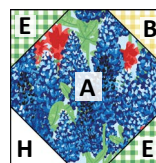

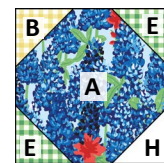

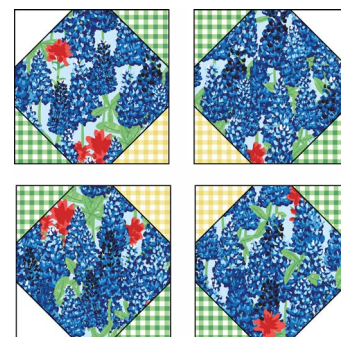

3. Arrange (4) matching SNF units as shown below. Sew the units together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Flower Block.

4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make (42) total Flower Blocks.

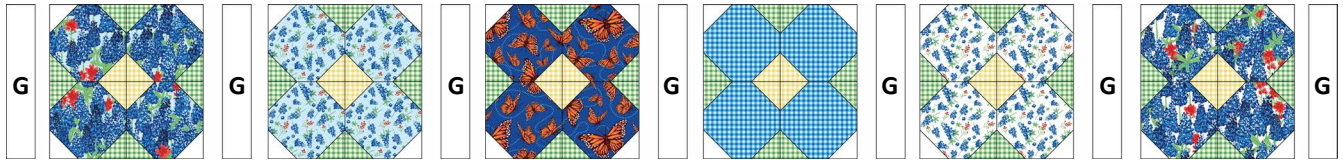

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

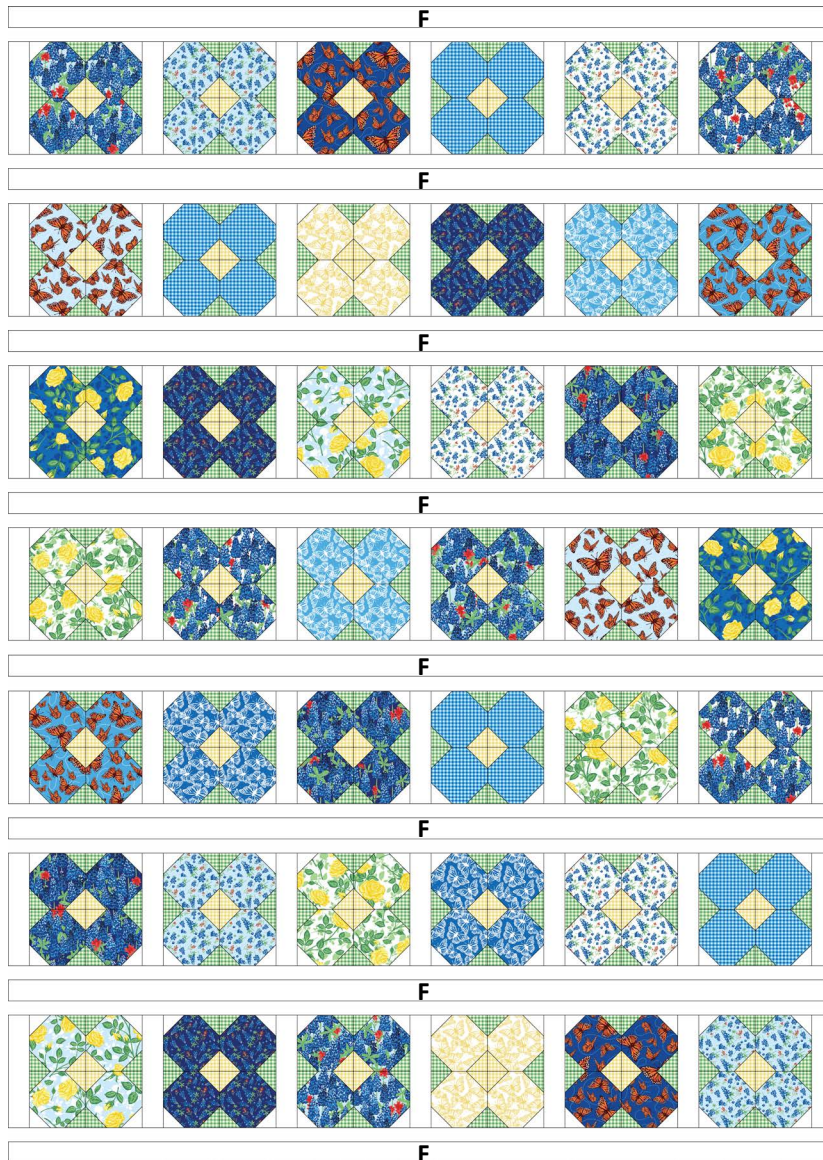
5. Arrange (7) **G**-rectangles and (6) Flower Blocks as shown below. Sew the pieces and blocks together into a row to make (1) Block Row. Repeat to make (7) total rows.

6. Arrange (8) **F**-strips and (7) Block Rows as shown below. Sew the rows together to make the quilt center.

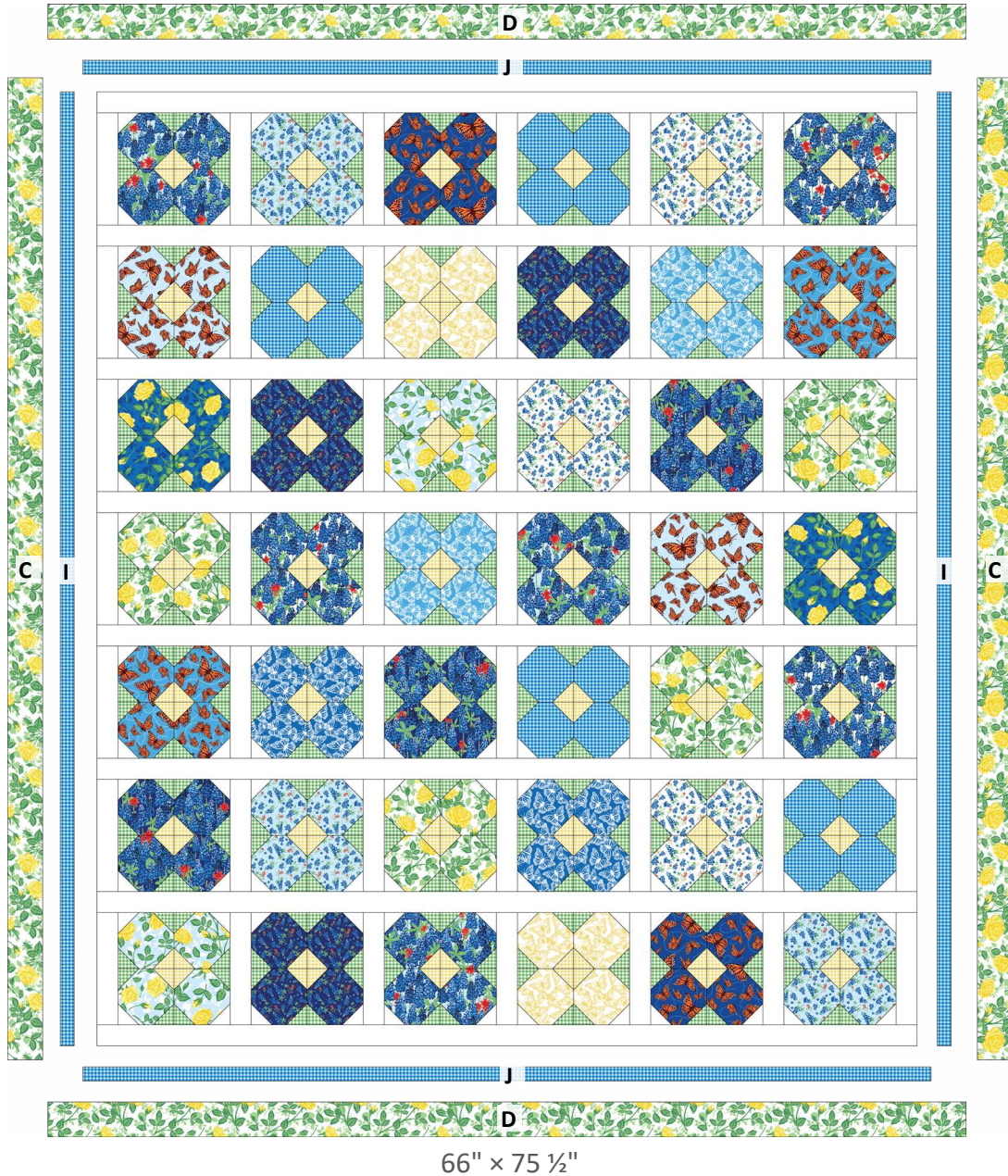

7. Sew (1) **I**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, sew (1) **J**-strip to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew the **C**-strips to the sides and the **D**-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

8. Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Blue Gingham binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
