



Finished Quilt Size 68" x 80" Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1¾ yards cream main (C2710 Cream)

1/4 yard cream car (C2711 Cream)

1/4 yard green car (C2711 Green)

1/4 yard brown floral (C2712 Brown)

1¼ yard green floral (C2712 Green)

1/4 yard brown keys (C2713 Brown)

1/4 yard cream keys (C2713 Cream)

1/4 yard green keys (C2713 Green)

1/4 yard cream trellis (C2714 Cream)

1/4 yard green trellis (C2714 Green)

½ yard cream stripe (C2715 Cream)

11/4 yard brown gate (C2716 Brown)

21/4 yards cream shade (C200-02 Cream)

Binding % yard

Backing 5 yards

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Attic Keys Block

Cut 2 squares 41/2" x 41/2" from cream car (C2711 Cream)

Cut 4 squares 4½" x 4½" from green car (C2711 Green) Cut 3 squares 4½" x 4½" from brown floral (C2712 Brown)

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" from cream trellis (C2714 Cream)

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" from green trellis (C2714 Green)

Cut 3 squares 4½" x 4½" from brown keys (C2713 Brown) Cut 4 squares 4½" x 4½" from cream keys (C2713 Cream)

Cut 2 squares 4½" x 4½" from green keys (C2713 Green) Cut 20 squares 4 %" x 4 %" from green floral (C2712 Green). Cut each square once to make 40 triangles.

Cut 80 squares 21/2" x 21/2" from green floral (C2712 Green)

Cut 40 squares 3" x 3" from green floral (C2712 Green) Cut 20 squares 4 %" x 4 %" from brown gate (C2716 Brown). Cut each

square once to make 40 triangles.

Cut 80 squares 2½" x 2½" from brown gate (C2716 Brown)

Cut 40 squares 3" x 3" from brown gate (C2716 Brown) Cut 20 squares 5¼" x 5¼" from cream shade (C200-02 Cream). Cut each square twice diagonally to make 80 triangles.

Cut 80 rectangles 2½" x 4½" from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)

Cut 80 squares 2½" x 2½" from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)

Cut 80 squares 3" x 3" from cream shade (C200-02 Cream)

Border 1

Cut 6 strips 21/2" x WOF from cream stripe (C2715 Cream)

Cut 7 strips 81/2" x WOF from cream main (C2710 Cream)

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Attic Keys Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement as there are 10 green blocks and 10 brown blocks and the centers for each block vary.

Sew two cream shade triangles to opposite sides of a 41/2" assorted print square. Press. Sew two cream shade triangles to the remaining sides to create the Inside Block. Sew two brown gate or green trellis triangles to opposite sides of the Inside block. Press. Sew two brown gate or green trellis triangles to the two remaining sides to complete the Block Center.





Trace a pencil line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a 21/2" brown gate or green trellis square. Place the square in the corner of a 2½" x 4½" cream shade rectangle and sew on the pencil line. Leave a 14" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a 3" cream shade square. Place the square on top of a 3" brown gate or green trellis square with right sides together. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangle Blocks. Press. Repeat to make 8 Half Square Triangle Blocks. Square up the blocks to 21/2".



Half Square Triangle Block

Sew a Half Square Triangle Block to each side of a Flying Geese Unit to make Unit A. Repeat to make 4 Unit As. Sew a Unit A to each side of the Block Center. Sew a 21/2" cream shade square to each side of the 2 remaining Unit As. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Attic Keys Block, Repeat to make a total of 20 Attic Keys Block (10 brown and 10 green).



Quilt Center Assembly

Attic Keys Block

Refer to quilt photo for placement of blocks. Lay out blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Side borders should be 60%". Top and bottom borders should be 52%".

Border 2

Side borders should be 64½". Top and bottom borders should be 68½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Grandma's House Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
