Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology and foundation piecing. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Happy Halloween Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4610-18)

1½ yards (1.4 m) gray main (C4610 Gray)

½ yard (50 cm) orange stars (GC4614 Orange)

2 yards (1.85 m) snow white shade (C200-03 Snow White)

Binding ⅝ yard (60 cm)

Backing 3¾ yards (3.45 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 1 rectangle 2½" x 21" from each of the following fat quarters:

orange main, purple cupcakes

Cut 2 squares 4½" x 4½" and 2 rectangles 2½" x 21" from each of the following fat quarters:

black parade, gray parade, black web, purple web,

black stars, orange stars, black pumpkins

Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 3½" from purple web for A1.

Gray Main

Cut 7 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 1.

Orange Stars

Cut 1 strip 12½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 9" x 12½".

Snow White Shade

Cut 8 strips 4½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 64 squares 4½" x 4½".

Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 16 rectangles 2½" x 21".

Snow White Shade (continued)

Cut 1 strip 6" x WOF. Cut the strip into 8 rectangles 4" x 6".

Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 16 rectangles 2½" x 2½".

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3" x 3½" for A2.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Chain Block

Sew a snow white shade 2½" x 21" rectangle and an assorted print 2½" x 21" rectangle together. Press. Repeat with remaining snow white shade and assorted print 2½" x 21" rectangles. Cut the strips into 2½" segments. Sew the segments together to create 64 Four-Patch Units.



Four-Patch Unit

Referring to quilt photo for placement of fabrics, sew together 4 Four-Patch Units, 1 assorted print 4½" square, and 4 snow white shade 4½" squares to create the Chain Block. Repeat to create 16 Chain Blocks.



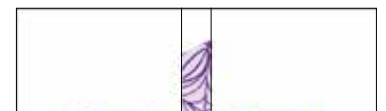
Chain Block

Pumpkin Block

Use a foundation piecing template and purple web piece A1 and snow white shade piece A2 to create the stem. Sew a snow white shade 4" x 6" rectangle to each side of the stem to create the Stem Unit. Repeat to create 4 Stem Units.

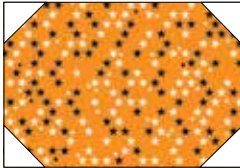


Stem Unit

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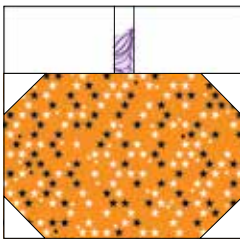
Pumpkin Block (continued)

Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 4 snow white shade $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place a snow white shade $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square on each corner of an orange stars $9" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle and sew on the lines. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance and trim excess to create the Pumpkin Unit. Press. Repeat to create 4 Pumpkin Units.



Pumpkin Unit

Sew a Stem Unit and a Pumpkin Unit together to create the Pumpkin Block. Repeat to create 4 Pumpkin Blocks.



Pumpkin Block

Quilt Center Assembly

See quilt photo for Chain Block and Pumpkin Block placement. Lay out the blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $60\frac{1}{2}"$. Top and bottom borders should be $60\frac{1}{2}"$.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Halloween Magic Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
