FINISHED QUILT SIZE 461/2" x 461/2"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 multi panel (P3961 Multi) 1 Halloween Parade Rolie Polie (RP-3960-21) ½ yard (50 cm) black star (C3966 Black) Binding ¾ yard (60 cm) Backing 3 yards (2.75 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Panel

Cut 1 rectangle 34" tall x 351/2" wide

Rolie Polie

From the green main $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8" and 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

From the green candy $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{4}$ " and 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

From the purple cobwebs 2½" strip cut 1 rectangle 2½" x 9¼" and 2 rectangles 2½" x 9"

From the green corn $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8" and 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

From the gray main $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8" and 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

From the black candy $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8" and 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

From the gray cobwebs 2½" strip cut 2 rectangles 2½" x 9¼" and 2 rectangles 2½" x 9"

From the multi stripe 2½" strip cut 1 rectangle 2½" x 9¼" and 2 rectangles 2½" x 9"

From the black dot 21/2" strip cut 8 squares 21/2" x 21/2"

From the black corn 21/2" strip cut 2 rectangles 21/2" x 9"

From the orange main $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{4}$ " and 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

From the white candy $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 2 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8", 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9¼", and 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

From the orange cobwebs 2½" strip cut 1 rectangle 2½" x 8 7/8" and 1 rectangle 2½" x 9"

From the orange corn $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{4}$ " and 1 rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9"

Black Star

Cut 2 strips 21/4" x WOF for Border 2 Cut 3 strips 3" x WOF for Border 2

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of assorted print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8" rectangles. Sew 4 assorted print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8" rectangles together for the right side border. Sew 4 assorted print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 7/8" rectangles together for the left side border. Sew the right and left side borders to the quilt center.

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of assorted print 2%" x 9%" rectangles. Sew 4 assorted print 2%" x 9%" rectangles together for the top border. Sew 4 assorted print 2%" x 9%" rectangles together for the bottom border. Sew a black dot 2%" square to each end of the top and bottom borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt center.

Border 2

Side borders should be $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 38". Top and bottom borders should be 3" x 43".

Border 3

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of assorted print 2%" x 9" rectangles. Sew 5 assorted print 2%" x 9" rectangles together for the right side border. Sew 5 assorted print 2%" x 9" rectangles together for the left side border. Sew the right and left side borders to the quilt center. Sew 5 assorted print 2%" x 9" rectangles together for the top border. Sew 5 assorted print 2%" x 9" rectangles together for the bottom border. Sew a black dot 2%" square to each end of the top and bottom borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt center.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Halloween Parade Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
