HOCUS POCUS

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 72" x 80"

Finished Block Size 8" x 8"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Purple Haunted Panel (P7137 Purple)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard black main (C7130 Black)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard orange main (C7130 Orange)

2 yards purple witch (C7131 Purple)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard black broom (C7132 Black)

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard orange broom (C7132 Orange)

$\frac{7}{8}$ yard purple broom (C7132 Purple)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard gray hat (C7133 Gray)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard orange hat (C7133 Orange)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard black apothecary (C7134 Black)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard gray apothecary (C7134 Gray)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard black web (C7135 Black)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard orange web (C7135 Orange)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard black stripe (C7136 Black)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard purple stripe (C7136 Purple)

1 $\frac{2}{3}$ yards cloud solid (C120 Cloud)

Binding $\frac{2}{3}$ yard

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Quilt Center

Square up the purple panel to 24" x 32".

Border 1

Cut 4 strips 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF from black stripe.

Border 2

Cut 4 strips 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF from purple broom.

Border 3 Corner Star Block

Cut 32 squares 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from black web.

Cut 4 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from black web.

Cut 16 squares 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cloud solid.

Cut 16 rectangles 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cloud solid.

Cut 32 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from black broom.

Cut 16 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cloud solid.

Cut 16 rectangles 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cloud solid.

Border 3 Star Block

Cut 88 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cloud solid.

Cut 88 rectangles 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cloud solid.

Cut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in the corresponding number from the following prints:

8–black main, 8–orange main, 24–purple witch

24–orange broom, 16–gray hat, 16–orange hat

16–black apothecary, 16–gray apothecary

16–orange web, 24–black stripe, 8–purple stripe

Cut 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in the corresponding number from the following prints:

1–black main, 1–orange main, 3–purple witch

3–orange broom, 2–gray hat, 2–orange hat

2–black apothecary, 2–gray apothecary

2–orange web, 3–black stripe, 1–purple stripe

Border 4

Cut 7 strips 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF from purple witch.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of blocks.

Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the Star Block diagram for piece placement. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " assorted print square. Place the square in the corner of a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " cloud solid rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

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Sew a Flying Geese Unit to each side of a 4½" assorted print square to create Unit A.



Unit A

Sew a 2½" cloud solid square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units to create 2 Unit Bs.



Unit B

Sew a Unit B to the top and bottom of Unit A to create the Star Block. Repeat to make a total of 22 Star Blocks.



Star Block

Corner Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the Corner Star Block diagram for piece placement. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a 1½" black web square. Place the square in the corner of a 1½" x 2½" cloud solid rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Leave a ¼" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to each side of a 2½" black web square to create Unit C.




Unit C

Sew a 1½" cloud solid square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units to create 2 Unit Ds.



Unit D

Sew a Unit D to the top and bottom of Unit C to create the Corner Star Center. Repeat to make a total of 4 Corner Star Centers.




Corner Star Center

Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a 2½" black broom square. Place the square in the corner of a 2½" x 4½" cloud solid rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Leave a ¼" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the rectangle. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to each side of a Corner Star Center to create Unit E.



Unit E

Sew a 2½" cloud solid square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units to create 2 Unit Fs.



Unit F

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Sew a Unit F to the top and bottom of Unit E to create the Corner Star Block. Repeat to make a 4 Corner Star Blocks.



Corner Star Block

Quilt Center Assembly

See quilt photo for quilt center and border placement. Sew borders around the quilt center 24" x 32" rectangle. Sew the side borders first. Sew the top and bottom borders.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 32". Top and bottom borders should be 28½".

Border 2

Side borders should be 36½". Top and bottom borders should be 40½".

Border 3

Sew 2 rows with 6 Star Blocks together. Sew one row to each side of the quilt. Sew 2 rows with 5 Star Blocks. Sew a Corner Star Block to each end. Sew a row to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Border 4

Side borders should be 64½". Top and bottom borders should be 72½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Haunted House Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
