# LET IT SNOW PANEL QUILT

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE:** 71½" × 78½"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 FP11945 Let It Snow Panel

1 1/2 Yards F11940 Taupe Main

1 1/4 Yards F11942 Taupe Stripe

7/8 Yard F11943 Black Snowflakes

1 Yard F11944 Multi Dots

5/8 Yard F11944 Black Dots (Binding)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

### Let It Snow Panel

Cut 1- 35½" x 42½".

### Taupe Main

Cut 7 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 5.

### Taupe Stripe

Cut 5 strips 2½" x **LOF** for Border 2.

From one strip cut 2 rectangles 2½" x 10"

### Black Snowflakes

Cut 6 strips 4½" x WOF for Border 4.

### Multi Dots

Cut 10 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 1 and 3.

From one strip cut 4 rectangles 3½" x 8½"

From one strip cut 4 rectangles 3½" x 10"

### Black Dots

Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF for Binding.

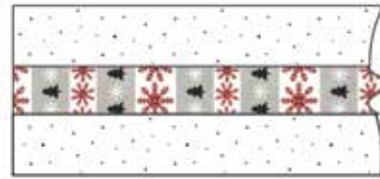
## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the cutting requirements list, quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints. Press seam allowances toward the outside edges of the quilt. Add borders to the sides first, then the top and bottom.

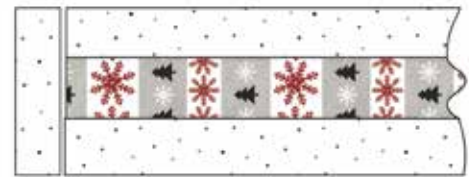
To construct this quilt you will be adding a series of borders to a central panel. The first inner border is a clever mix of 2 fabrics that together create a floating border effect.

### FIRST INNER BORDER

1. Sew a 3½" x WOF Multi Dots strip to each long side of a Taupe Stripe strip.



2. Repeat Step 1 again for a total of 2.
3. Trim the 2 strip sets to 42½" long. Sew 1 to each side of the panel.
4. Sew one 2½" x 10" Taupe Stripe rectangle to the end of each of the remaining two 2½" x WOF Taupe Stripe strips, and sew one 3½" x 10" Multi Dots rectangle to the end of each of the remaining four 3½" x WOF Multi Dots strips.
5. Sew a 3½" Multi Dots strip from step 4 to each long side of the Taupe Stripe strips from step 4. Trim strip sets to 45½" in length.
6. Sew a 3½" x 8½" rectangle to the short ends of both strip sets.



7. Sew 1 strip set to the top and 1 to the bottom of the panel.

Quilt now measures 51½" × 58½".

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## INNER AND OUTER BORDERS

1. Sew the 6 Black Snowflake WOF strips together end to end to make 1 long strip.
2. From this strip cut 2 borders 58½" long and sew 1 to each side.
3. Cut 2 more borders 59½" long and sew 1 to the top and one to the bottom.

Quilt now measures 59½" × 66½".

4. Repeat Steps 1-3 using the 7 Taupe Main WOF strips. Cut 2 side borders 66½" long each; the top and bottom borders 71½" long each.

Quilt now measures 71½" × 78½".

Layer your backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges with your favorite binding method using the with 2½" Blake Snowflake strips. Enjoy and share your quilt using the hashtags [#hellowinterfabric](#) [#rileyblakedesigns](#) [#iloverileyblake](#).
