

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics are from the Ink & Ivory collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) FQ-16910-18 Fat Quarter Bundle

Additional Fabrics:

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies 2 ⅓ yards WB805-CREAM POParazzi (wide back backing) Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Fat Quarter Bundle

From (18) fat quarters, cut a total of:

- (16) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.
- (32) 2 %" × 16 %" rectangles. Label as B.
- (32) 2 ½" × 12 ½" rectangles. Label as C.
- (32) 2 ½" × 8 ½" rectangles. Label as D.



Cream Blossom

Cut (23) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

- (32) 2 ½" × 12 ½" rectangles. Label as E.
- (32) 2 ½" × 8 ½" rectangles. Label as F.
- (32) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as G.



Ink Flower Trellis

Cut (7) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.


BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **G**-rectangle to the top and bottom of (1) **A**-square as shown below. Next, sew (1) **D**-rectangle to each side.





2. Sew (1) **F**-rectangle to the top and bottom of (1) Step 1 unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) **C**-rectangle to each side.



12 ½" × 12 ½"

3. Sew (1) **E**-rectangle to the top and bottom of (1) Step 2 unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) **B**-rectangle to each side to make (1) block.




16 ½" × 16 ½"

4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make (16) total blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Arrange (16) blocks as shown below. Sew the blocks together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

6. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Ink Flower Trellis binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
