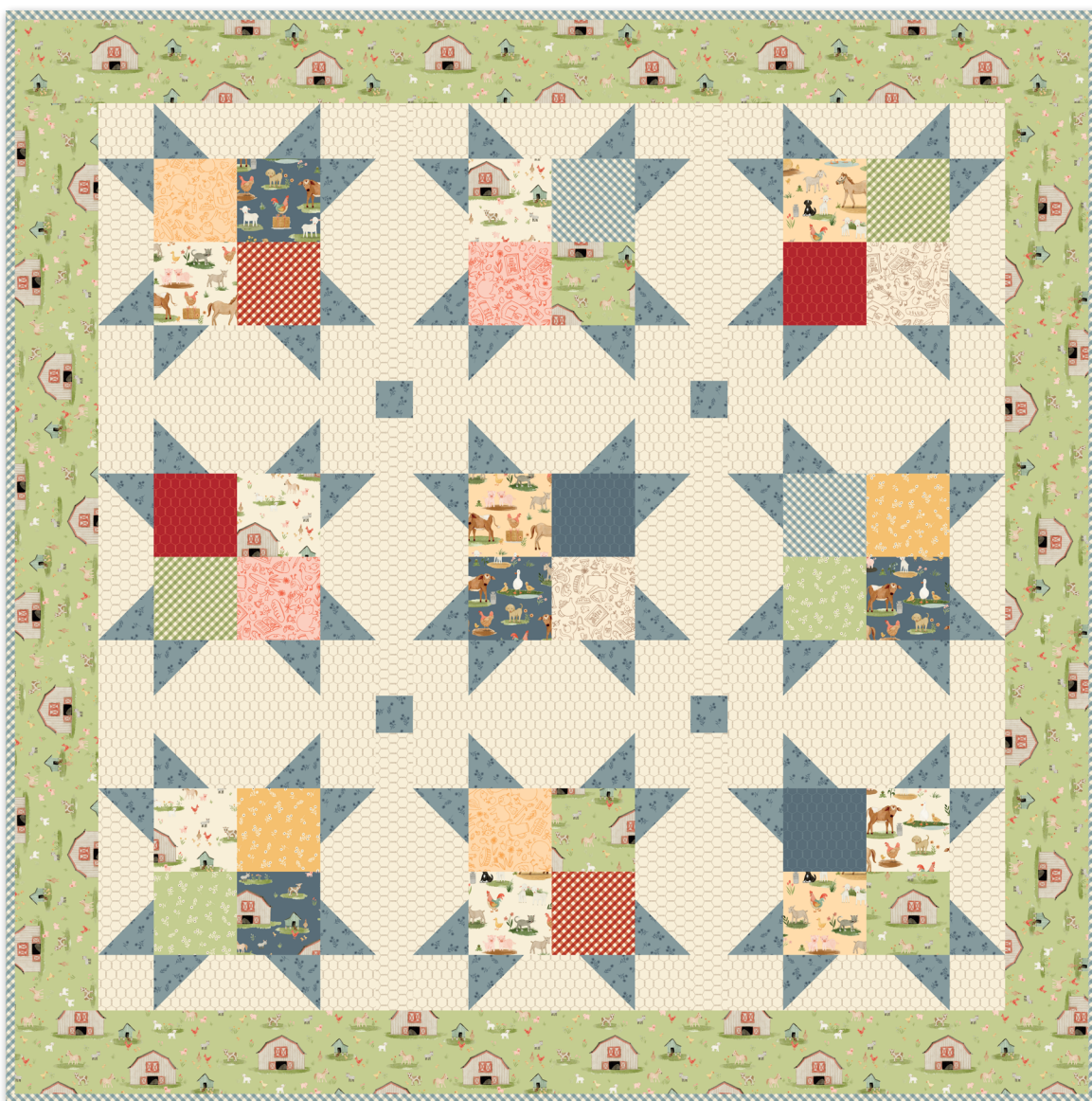

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
SNF = Stitch and Flip

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Lil' Farm Friends collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) 5-17940-42 5" Stacker

Additional Fabrics:

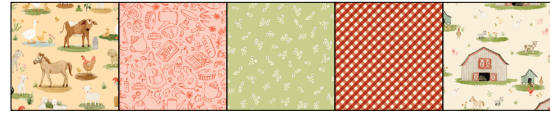
¾ yard C17943-STORM Posies
1 yard C17940-HONEYDEW Main
1 ¾ yards C17945-CREAM Chicken Wire
½ yard C17944-BLUE Gingham (binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
1 ⅞ yards WB645-BEACH Dapple Dot (wide back backing)
Batting

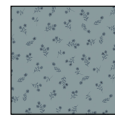
CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



5" Stacker

Set (36) 5" × 5" squares aside. Label as A.



Storm Posies

Cut (6) 3 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(72) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares. Label as B.
Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as C.



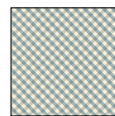
Honeydew Main

Cut (6) 5" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(2) 5" × 58 ½" strips. Label as D.
(2) 5" × 49 ½" strips. Label as E.



Cream Chicken Wire

Cut (12) 3 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(36) 3 ½" × 9 ½" rectangles. Label as F.
(36) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares. Label as G.
Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(12) 2 ½" × 15 ½" rectangles. Label as H.



Blue Gingham

Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

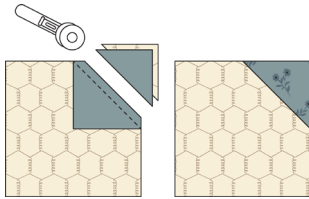
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SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

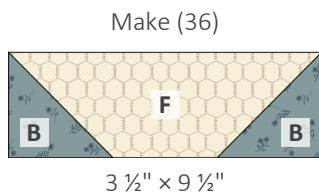
STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Use the SNF method to sew (1) **B**-square to each bottom corner of (1) **F**-rectangle as shown below to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (36) total units.



2. Arrange (4) **A**-squares as shown below. Sew the squares together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Center Unit. Repeat to make (9) total units.



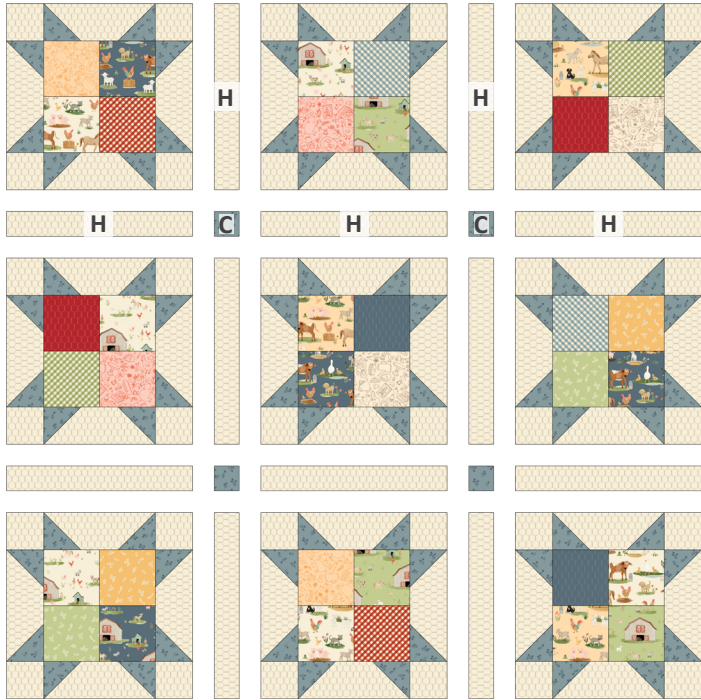
3. Arrange (4) **G**-squares, (4) Side Units, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Star Block. Repeat to make (9) total blocks.



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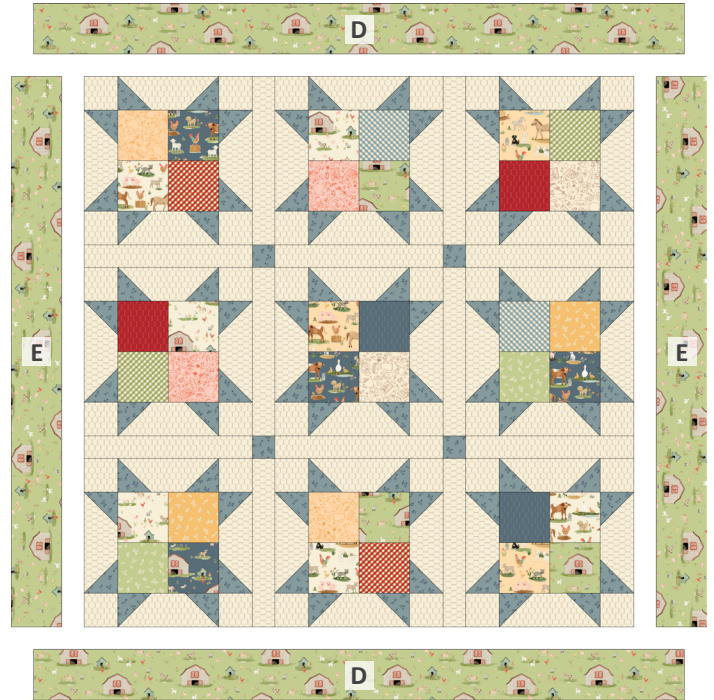
QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Arrange (9) Star Blocks, (12) **H**-rectangles, and (4) **C**-squares as shown below. Sew the blocks, rectangles, and squares together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.



- Sew (1) **E**-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown in the Quilt Layout Diagram. Next, sew (1) **D**-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

- Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Blue Gingham binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
