GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Little Ladybug collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) 10-18030-42 10" Stacker

Additional Fabrics:

¾ yard C120-BRIGHTWHITE Confetti Cotton™ Solid
1 ¼ yards C18034-BLUE Ladybugs
1 ½ yards C18035-BLACK Dots (includes binding)

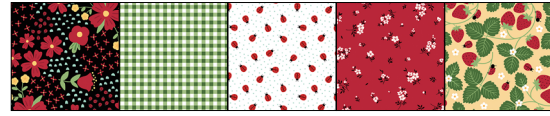


OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
1 ¾ yards WB660-RED On White Swiss Dot (wide back backing)
Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



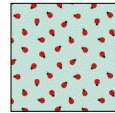
10" Stacker

Cut (48) 5" × 5" squares. Label as A.



Bright White Confetti Cotton™ Solid

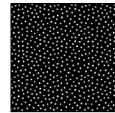
Cut (15) 1 ½" × WOF strips. Label as B.



Blue Ladybugs

Cut (6) 6 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(4) 6 ½" × 52 ½" strips. Label as C.



Black Dots

Cut (11) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Set (6) strips aside for binding. Piece (5) remaining strips together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 2 ½" × 48 ½" strips. Label as D.

(2) 2 ½" × 40 ½" strips. Label as E.

Cut (9) 1 ½" × WOF strips. Label as F.

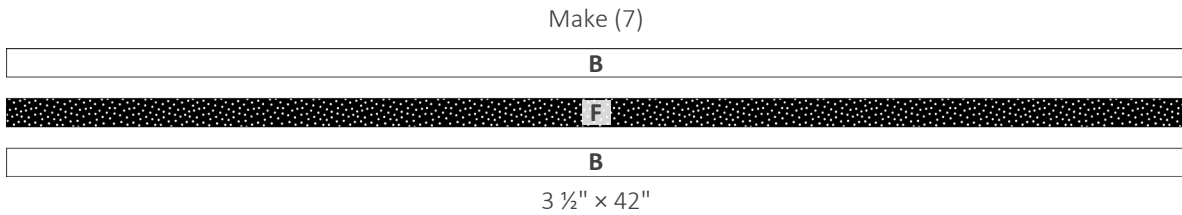
SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

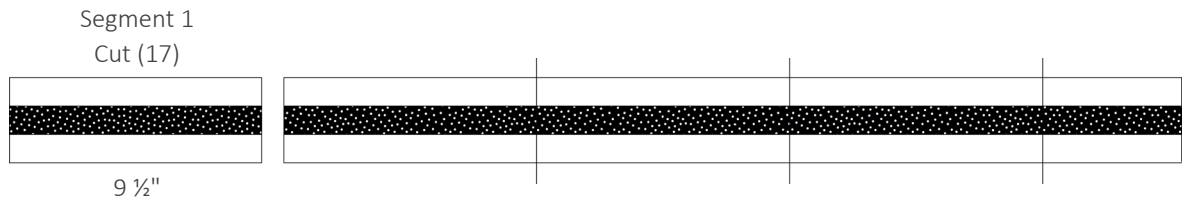
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BLOCK ASSEMBLY

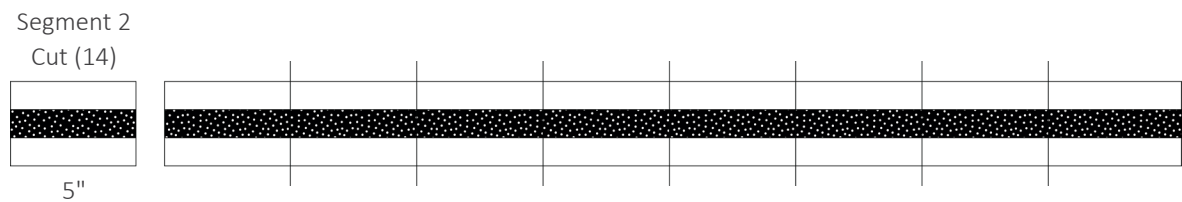
1. Sew (2) **B**-strips and (1) **F**-strip together as shown below to make (1) strip set. Repeat to make (7) total strip sets.



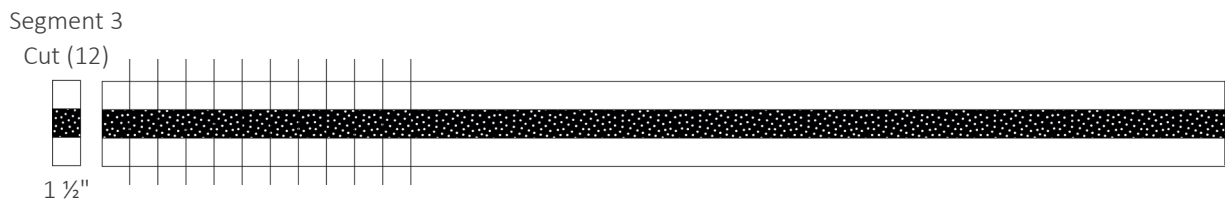
2. From (5) Step 1 strip sets, cut a total of (17) 9 1/2"-wide segments. Label as Segment 1. Set remainder of the longer strip set aside for Step 3.



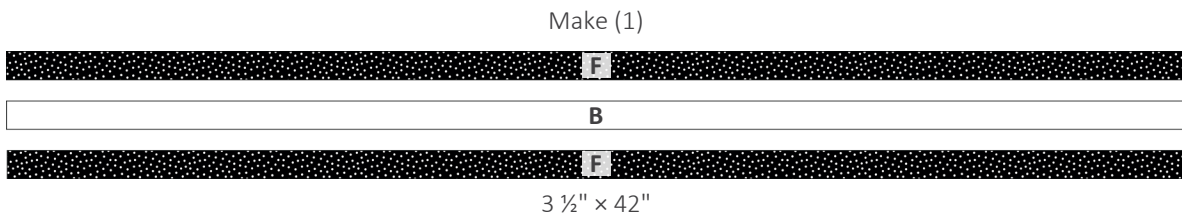
3. From remaining Step 2 strip set and (1) Step 1 strip set, cut a total of (14) 5"-wide segments. Label as Segment 2.



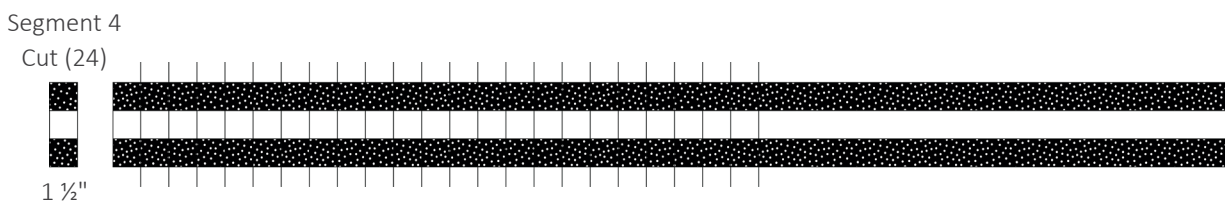
4. From (1) Step 1 strip set, cut a total of (12) 1 1/2"-wide segments. Label as Segment 3.



5. Sew (2) **F**-strips and (1) **B**-strip together as shown below to make (1) strip set.



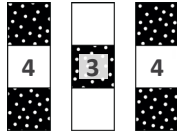
6. From (1) Step 5 strip set, cut a total of (24) 1 1/2"-wide segments. Label as Segment 4.



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7. Sew (2) Segment 4s and (1) Segment 3 together as shown below to make (1) Nine-Patch Block. Repeat to make (12) total blocks.

Make (12)



3 ½" x 3 ½"

8. Sew (2) **A**-squares together as shown below to make (1) Two-Patch Block. Repeat to make (10) total blocks.

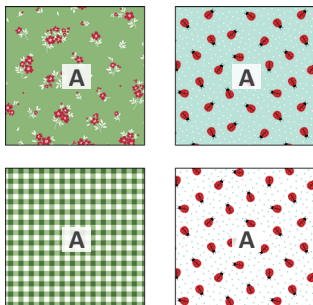
Make (10)



5" x 9 ½"

9. Arrange (4) **A**-squares as shown below. Sew the squares together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Four-Patch Block. Repeat to make (6) total blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

10. Sew (2) **A**-squares, (3) Segment 2s, and (2) Two-Patch Blocks together as shown below to make (1) Row 1. Repeat to make a second row.

5" x 36 ½"

11. Sew (2) Segment 2s, (3) Nine-Patch Blocks, and (2) Segment 1s together as shown below to make (1) Row 2. Repeat to make (4) total rows.

3 ½" x 36 ½"

12. Sew (2) Two-Patch Blocks, (3) Segment 1s, and (2) Four-Patch Blocks together as shown below to make (1) Row 3. Repeat to make (3) total rows.

9 ½" x 36 ½"

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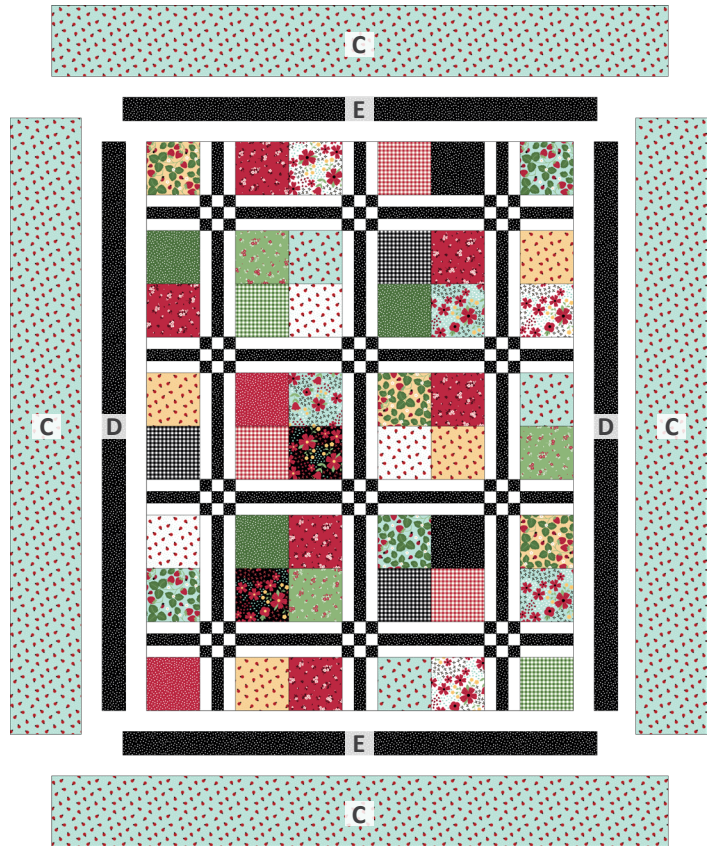
13. Sew (2) Row 1s, (4) Row 2s, and (3) Row 3s together as shown below to make the quilt center.

14. Sew (1) **D**-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown below. Next, sew (1) **E**-strip to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **C**-strips to the sides and **C**-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

15. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Black Dots binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.

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
