## Bowtie Bash

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 64" x 73"
Finished Block Size 8" x 8"
Measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Menswear Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4790-15)
$11 / 2$ yards ( 1.4 m ) brown houndstooth (C4792 Brown)
2 yards ( 1.85 m ) tan houndstooth (C4792 Tan)
Binding $3 / 4$ yard ( 70 cm )
Backing 4½ yards ( 4.15 m )

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting sashing pieces.

## Fat Quarter Stack

Cut squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

10-black main, 10-gray main, 8-tan main, 8-brown check, 8-gray check, 8-red check, 8-brown houndstooth, 8-gray houndstooth, 6-brown plaid, 8-gray plaid, 8-tan plaid, 8-brown zigzag, 4-gray zigzag, 10-red zigzag

Cut squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

10-black main, 10-gray main, 8-tan main, 8-brown check, 8-gray check, 8-red check, 8-brown houndstooth,
8-gray houndstooth, 6-brown plaid, 8-gray plaid,
8-tan plaid, 8-brown zigzag, 4-gray zigzag, 10-red zigzag

## Brown Houndstooth

Cut 5 strips $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 127 rectangles $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for sashing.

## Tan Houndstooth

Cut 14 strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 112 squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Cut 3 strips $1 \frac{1}{2^{\prime \prime}} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 72 squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ for posts.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

## Bowtie Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of an assorted print $2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place the assorted print $2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the corner of a tan houndstooth $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew on the drawn line. Leave a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance and trim excess. Press to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit As.


Sew the 2 Unit As and 2 assorted print $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares together to complete the Bowtie Block. Repeat to create 56 Bowtie Blocks.

## Posts and Sashing

Refer to quilt photo for fabric placement. Sew a tan houndstooth $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to a brown houndstooth $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 8 square posts and 7 sashing rectangles. Make 9 post and sashing rows.

## Sashing and Bowtie Block

Refer to quilt photo for block placement. Sew a brown houndstooth $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to a Bowtie Block. Repeat to make a row with 8 sashing rectangles and 7 Bowtie Blocks. Make 8 sashing and block rows.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to quilt photo for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Menswear Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
