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FINISHED QUILT SIZE 62" x 74"

Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Mid Mod Fat Quarter Bundle (FQ-6140-18)

1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards (1.15 m) teal bird (C6141 Teal)

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (1.4 m) dark gray lines (C6145 Dark Gray)

1 yard (95 cm) gray lines (C6145 Gray)

Binding $\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm)

Backing 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (4.15 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Bundle

Cut squares 5" x 5" in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

- 4—black main, 8—gray main, 4—teal main
- 4—black wave, 8—gray wave, 4—teal wave
- 4—cream bird, 4—red bird, 4—teal bird
- 4—green eye, 8—teal eye, 4—red eye
- 4—gray circles, 4—red circles, 4—teal circles
- 4—gray line, 4—red lines

Teal Bird

Cut 7 strips 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Dark Gray Lines

Cut 20 strips 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF.

Cut 3 strips 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 40 squares 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ ". Cut each square once diagonally to create 80 triangles.

Gray Lines

Cut 10 strips 1" x WOF.

Cut 6 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

Cut 2 strips 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 20 squares 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ ".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for placement of fabrics as each block uses different fabrics.

Mid Mod Block

Sew 2 dark gray lines triangles to opposite sides of a gray lines 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " square. Press. Sew 2 dark gray lines triangles to the remaining opposite sides to create the Center Unit. Repeat to create 20 Center Units.



Center Unit

Sew a dark gray lines 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " strip to each side of a gray lines 1" strip to create a dark/light/dark strip set. Repeat to create 10 dark/light/dark strip sets. Cut the strip sets into 5" segments to make 80 dark/light/dark segments (8 from each strip set). Label as Unit A.



Unit A

Sew 4 assorted print 5" squares, 4 Unit As, and a Center Unit together to complete the Mid Mod Block. Repeat to create 20 assorted print Mid Mod Blocks.



Mid Mod Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Lay out the Mid Mod Blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

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Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $60\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $52\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be $64\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $62\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Mid Mod Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
