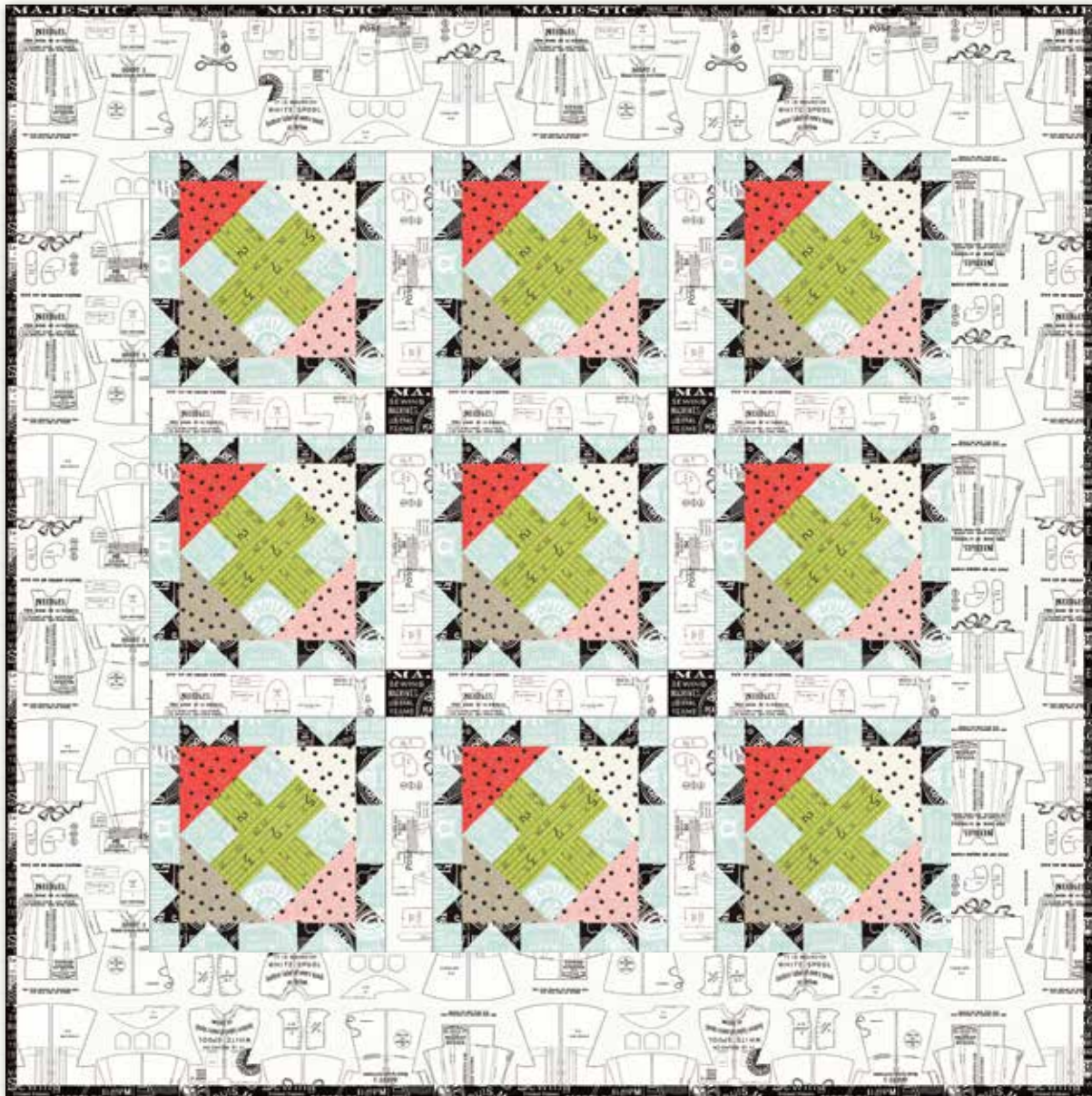

# PAPERDOLL POSIE PATCH

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 46" x 46"

### Finished Block Size 10" x 10"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website [www.rileyblakedesigns.com](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

¼ yard (23 cm) green tape (C7561 Green)  
¼ yard (23 cm) red pin top (C7565 Red)  
¼ yard (23 cm) off white pin top (C7565 Off White)  
¼ yard (23 cm) pink pin top (C7565 Pink)  
¼ yard (23 cm) gray pin top (C7565 Gray)  
¾ yard (69 cm) blue text (C7563 Blue)  
½ yard (50 cm) black text (C7563 Black)  
1¼ yards (1.14 m) off white clothes (C7568 Off White)  
Binding ½ yard (50 cm) black text (C7563 Black)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

### Green Tape

Cut 3 strips 2¼" x WOF. Cut the strips into 9 rectangles 2¼" x 5¾" and 18 squares 2¼" x 2¼".

### Red Pin Top, Off White Pin Top, Pink Pin Top, Gray Pin Top

Cut 1 strip 4⅝" x WOF. Cut the strip into 5 squares 4⅝" x 4⅝", then cut on one diagonal for 10 half square triangles from each print.

### Blue Text

Cut 3 strips 2¼" x WOF. Cut the strips into 36 squares 2¼" x 2¼".

Cut 11 strips 1¾" x WOF. Cut the strips into 36 squares 1¾" x 1¾" and 108 rectangles 1¾" x 3".

### Black Text

Cut 7 strips 1¾" x WOF. Cut the strips into 144 squares 1¾" x 1¾".

Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Off White Clothes

Cut 4 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 12 rectangles 2½" x 10½".

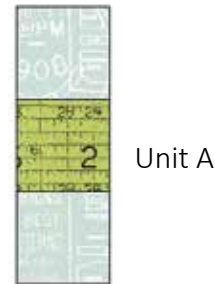
Cut 5 strips 6½" x WOF for Border.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

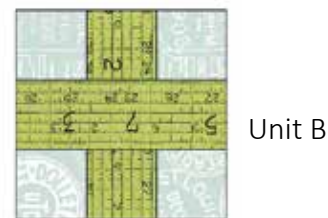
### Posie Block

These instructions are to make one block.

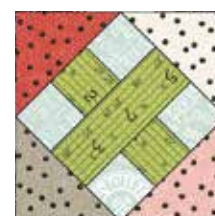
Sew a blue text 2¼" square to the top and bottom of a green tape 2¼" square to create Unit A. Repeat to make 2 Unit As.



Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of a green tape 2¼" x 5¾" rectangle to create Unit B.



Sew a red pin top and pink pin top half square triangle to opposite sides of Unit B. Then sew a gray pin top and off white pin top half square triangle to the remaining sides to complete the Block Center.



# PAPERDOLL POSIE PATCH

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2 black text  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Place a black text  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square on top of a blue text  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 8 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of a blue text  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" rectangle to create a Unit C. Repeat to make 4 Unit C.



Unit C

Sew a Unit C to the left and right side of the Block Center to create Unit D.



Unit D

Sew a blue text  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square to each side of a Unit C to create Unit E. Repeat to make 2 Unit E.



Unit E

Sew a Unit E to the top and bottom of Unit D to create the Posie Block. Repeat to make 9 Posie Blocks.

## Blocks and Sashing

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing a block placement. Sew a Posie Block to an off white clothes  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 3 blocks and 2 sashing rectangles. Make 3 block and sashing rows.

## Sashing and Posts

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and post placement. Sew an off white clothes  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to a black text  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make a row with 3 sashing rectangles and 2 posts. Make 3 post and sashing rows.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Posie Block placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Side borders should be  $34\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $46\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with black text fabric from the Paperdoll Collection for Riley Blake. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
