FINISHED QUILT SIZE 68" x 76"

Finished Block Size 16" x 16"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Primavera Fat Quarter Bundle (FQ-5740-21)

1½ yards (1.4 m) white main (C5740 White)

3 yards (1.85 m) putty solid (C120 Putty)

Binding $\frac{3}{8}$ yard (60 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting sashing and border pieces.

Fat Quarter Bundle

Cut squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

- 8–tangerine main, 16–teal main, 16–green damask, 8–pink damask, 8–teal damask, 8–pink tile, 16–tangerine tile, 16–teal tile, 8–pink plaid, 8–tangerine plaid, 8–teal plaid, 8–tangerine paisley, 16–green buds, 8–pink buds, 8–tangerine buds, 16–green leafy, 16–pink leafy

Cut squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " in the corresponding number from the following assorted prints:

- 8–green damask, 8–pink damask, 8–teal damask, 8–pink paisley, 8–tangerine paisley, 16–teal paisley, 8–green buds, 8–tangerine buds, 8–green leafy, 8–pink leafy, 8–tangerine leafy

White Main

Cut 7 strips $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border.

Putty Solid

Cut 6 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 96 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Putty Solid (Continued)

Cut 6 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 6 strips $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 rectangles $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for sashing. Sew the strips together and cut into 4 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " for sashing.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for placement of fabrics as each block is different.

Bright Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Sew 4 print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to create a Four-Patch Unit.



Four-Patch Unit

Sew a putty solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to each side of the Four-Patch Unit to create Unit A.



Unit A

Sew a print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each side of a putty solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to create Unit B. Repeat to create 2 Unit Bs.



Unit B

Sew a Unit B to the top and bottom of Unit A to create the Center Unit.



Center Unit

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 print $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of a Riley white solid $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

BRIGHT STAR

Sew 2 print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 2 putty solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to create Four-Patch C. Repeat to make 2 Four-Patch Cs. Repeat with a different print to make 2 Four-Patch Ds.



Four-Patch C



Four-Patch D

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left and right sides of the Center Unit to create Unit E.



Unit E

Sew a Four-Patch C and a Four-Patch D to each side of a Flying Geese Unit to create Unit F. Repeat to make 2 Unit Fs.



Unit F

Sew a Unit F to the top and bottom of Unit D to create the Bright Star Block. Repeat to make 12 assorted Bright Star Blocks.



Bright Star Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for block placement. Sew 4 Bright Star Blocks together to create a column. Repeat to make 3 columns of Bright Star Blocks. Sew the Bright Star columns and the 4 putty solid $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing rectangles together to create the quilt center.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Side borders should be $64\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $68\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Primavera Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
