#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of

quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics are from the Radiant Ruby collection unless stated otherwise.

#### ½ Yard of Each:

C17260-SCHOOLHOUSE Main C17262-SCHOOLHOUSE Floral

## ¾ Yard of Each:

C17261-SCHOOLHOUSE Moroccan C17265-SCHOOLHOUSE Herringbone

## Additional Fabrics:

1 ¼ yards C17263-CLOUD Leaves

2 1/4 yards C17266-CLOUD Dots

% yard C17264-SCHOOLHOUSE Stripe (binding)

#### OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
2 % yards WB14183-SCHOOL Bee Dot (wide back backing)
Batting

## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



#### Schoolhouse Main

Cut (3) 4 %" × WOF strips. Subcut: (21) 4 %" × 4 %" squares. Label as A.



#### **Schoolhouse Floral**

Cut (8) 2" × WOF strips. Label as B.



#### **Schoolhouse Moroccan**

Cut (7) 3 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-toend: subcut:

(2)  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 70  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as C.

(2)  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 66  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as D.



### **Schoolhouse Herringbone**

Cut (4) 6 ¼" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(21) 6 ¼" × 6 ¼" squares. Cut each in half twice diagonally to make (84) triangles. Label as E.



#### **Cloud Leaves**

Cut (6) 6" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(42) 6" × 6" squares. Cut each in half once diagonally to make (84) triangles. Label as F.



## **Cloud Dots**

Cut (4) 6 ¼" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(21) 6 ¼" × 6 ¼" squares. Cut each in half twice diagonally to make (84) triangles. Label as G.

Cut (10) 3 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(84)  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as H.

Cut (8) 2" × WOF strips. Label as I.



#### **Schoolhouse Stripe**


Cut (8) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

## **SEWING TECHNIQUES**

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

## **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

1. Sew (1) **B**-strip and (1) **I**-strip together as shown below to make (1) strip set. Repeat to make (8) total strip sets.




2. Cut the strip sets into (168) 2"-wide segments.




3. Sew (2) segments together as shown below to make (1) Four-Patch Unit. Repeat to make (84) total units.


Arrange (4) Four-Patch Units, (4) H-rectangles, and
 (1) A-square as shown, top right. Sew the units and pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make
 (1) Block 1. Repeat to make (21) total blocks.



5. Sew (1) **G**-triangle and (1) **E**-triangle together as shown below. Next, sew (1) **F**-triangle to the long edge to make (1) Pinwheel Unit. Trim unit to measure 5 ½" × 5 ½" if needed. Repeat to make (84) total units.




6. Arrange (4) Pinwheel Units as shown below. Sew the units together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Block 2. Repeat to make (21) total blocks.



# **QUILT ASSEMBLY**


7. Arrange (21) Block 1s and (21) Block 2s, alternating blocks as shown below. Sew the blocks together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.

8. Sew (1) **C**-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown, top right. Next, sew (1) **D**-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

9. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Schoolhouse Stripe binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
