

## ROCKY MOUNTAIN UTAH

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 7112"

Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

3 Rocky Mountain Wild 5" Stackers (5-10290-42)
13/4 yards Cloud Solid Confetti Cottons (C120 Cloud)
5/8 yard Binding

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.
WOF - width of fabric.

## Rocky Mountain Wild 5" Stackers

Select 115-5" squares.

## Cloud Solid

Cut 1 strip 14" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strip:
1-14" x 23" rectangle
Cut 6 strips 7" x WOF for Border.

## Binding

Cut 7 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of prints.

## Quilt Center

Sew 5 Stacker squares together into a strip ( $5^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ ) as shown in the Quilt Layout. Repeat to make 3 strips. Press seams in opposite directions.

Sew the strips together into a set (14" x 23 "). Press seams in one direction.

Sew the strip set to the left edge of the Cloud Solid 14" x 23" rectangle to make the Top Section (14" x 45½"). Press seam towards the Cloud Solid.

Sew the remaining 5" squares together into 10 rows of 10 squares. Press seams in opposite directions.

Sew the Rows together to make the Bottom Section ( $451 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ). Press the seams in one direction.

Sew the Top and Bottom Sections together to complete the Quilt Center (45½" x 59").

## Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders to the Quilt Center first. Press seams towards borders.

Side borders should be 59". Top and bottom borders should be 5812".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Rocky Mountain Wild print. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
