Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

HST = Half Square Triangle

SNF = Stitch and Flip

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Shades of Autumn collection unless otherwise indicated.

2 5-inch Stackers (5-1347042)

1 Fat Quarter Brown Text (SC13477-BROWN)

1 ⅞ yards Cream Text (SC13477-CREAM)

½ yard Brown Sprigs (C13474-BROWN)*

*Binding

OTHER SUPPLIES

1 ¾ yards WIDEBACK backing fabric of your choice

Basic Sewing Supplies

Batting (54" x 54")

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.


5-Inch Stackers

Select (51) 5" squares, label A.



Brown Sprigs

Cut (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding.



Cream Text

Cut (1) 14" x WOF strip; subcut:

(1) 14" x 14" square, label E.

(2) 12 ½" x 12 ½" squares, label C.

Cut (3) 5" x WOF strips, subcut:

(24) 5" x 5" squares, label B.

Cut (5) 3" x WOF strips for the border, label F.



Brown Text

Cut (1) 14" x WOF strip, subcut:

(1) 14" x 14" square, label D.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints. *Note: Cream and Brown Text are directional fabric. When laying out blocks, ensure proper placement of rotation as shown in the diagrams.*

1-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew directly on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance on one side of the sewn line to ¼". Open and press to the darker fabric to make (1) HST. Trim HST to desired size.



STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST matching the raw edges in one corner. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the top piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to ¼". Flip the top piece away from the bottom piece and press to the darker fabric, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.
