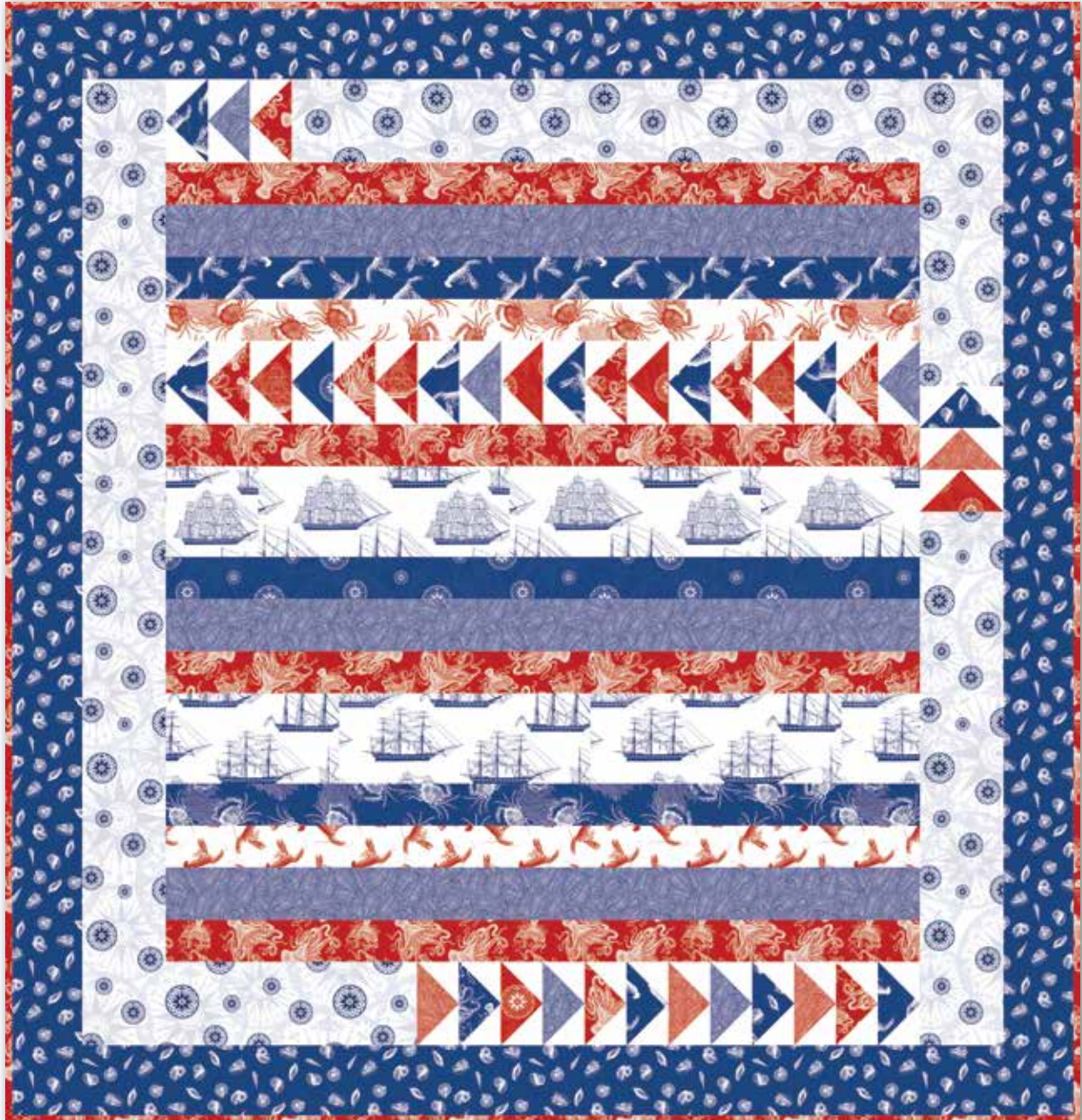

SHIPS GO SAILING

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 76" x 79¼"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

¼ Yard C8552 Blue Compass

⅞ Yard C8552 Red Compass

1⅞ Yards C8552 White Compass

⅞ Yard C8553 Blue Lucy

1⅞ Yards C8553 Red Lucy (Includes Binding)

¼ Yard C8554 Blue Crab

¼ Yard C8554 Red Crab

⅞ Yard C8555 Blue Lobster

¼ Yard C8555 Red Lobster

1⅞ Yards C8556 Blue Shells

⅞ Yard C8557 Blue Sea Leaf

⅞ Yard C8557 Red Sea Leaf

¾ Yard C120 Riley White Solid

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Red Main

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 3 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

White Main

Cut 3 strips 7" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 2 rectangles 7" x 54½".

Blue Compass

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½" and 1 rectangle 3½" x 6½".

Red Compass

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

White Compass

Cut 6 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 1.

Blue Lucy

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 rectangle 3½" x 6½".

Red Lucy

Cut 5 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 4 rectangles 3½" x 54½".

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF for binding.

Blue Crab

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½".

Red Crab

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½".

Blue Lobster

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 6 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½" and 2 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Red Lobster

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½".

Blue Shells

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 2 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Cut 8 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Sea Leaf

Cut 4 strips 4¼" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 3 rectangles 4¼" x 54½".

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 5 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Red Sea Leaf

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Riley White Solid

Cut 7 strips 3½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 72 squares 3½" x 3½".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and strips.

Flying Geese Row

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2 Riley White solid $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of an assorted print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 36 Flying Geese Units. Sew 18 Flying Geese Units together to create the Flying Geese Row.

Quilt Center Assembly

Referring to quilt photo for row placement, sew the assorted print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, the white compass 7" strips, the blue sea leaf $4\frac{1}{4}$ " strips, and the Flying Geese Row together to complete the quilt center.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $57\frac{3}{4}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $66\frac{1}{2}$ ". Border pieces will be subcut from the 6 white compass strips that were cut $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x the length of fabric.

Sew 3 Flying Geese Units together for the right side border. Sew a white compass $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top side of the Flying Geese Units and a white compass $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle to the bottom side of the Flying Geese Units to complete the right side border. Adjust the size of the white compass rectangles if necessary to fit your quilt center. Sew the border to the right side of the quilt.

Sew a white compass $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $57\frac{3}{4}$ " strip to the left side of the quilt center.

Sew 3 Flying Geese Units together for the top border. Sew a white compass $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the left side of the Flying Geese Units and a white compass $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $51\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the right side of the Flying Geese Units to complete the top border. Adjust the size of the white compass rectangles if necessary to fit your quilt center. Sew the border to the top of the quilt.

Sew 12 Flying Geese Units together for the bottom border. Sew a white compass $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the left side of the Flying Geese Units and a white compass $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the right side of the Flying Geese Units to complete the bottom border. Adjust the size of the white compass rectangles if necessary to fit your quilt center. Sew the border to the bottom of the quilt.

Border 2

Side borders should be $69\frac{3}{4}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $76\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with red Lucy from the Nautical Caskata Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
