FINISHED QUILT SIZE 62¾" x 79"

Finished Block Size 9½" x 9½"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 10-7690-42 So Ruby 10-inch Stacker

1¼ Yards C7690 Red Main

1¾ Yards C120 Riley White Solid

1 Yard C7696 Red-on-Red Pin Dot

⅝ Yard C7694 Red Stripe

⅝ Yard C7694 Red Stripe (Binding)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

10-inch Stacker

Choose 18 - 10" x 10" squares to use as Center Blocks.

Red Main

Cut 7 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 2.

Riley White Solid

Cut 2 strips 2½" x WOF. From the strips cut 31 squares 2½" x 2½" for Posts.

Cut 2 strips 18" x WOF. From the strips cut 3 squares 18" x 18" and 2 squares 11" x 11". Cut the 18" squares twice diagonally to create 12 Setting Triangles (2 will not be used). Cut the 11" squares once diagonally to create 4 Corner Triangles.

Red-on-Red Pin Dot

Cut 3 strips 10" x WOF. From the strips cut 48 rectangles 2½" x 10" for Sashing.

Red Stripe

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for Center Block, Post, Sashing, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally cut larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving ¼" seam allowance on all sides, before adding the borders.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 65½". Top and bottom borders should be 53¼".

Border 2

Side borders should be 69½". Top and bottom borders should be 63¼".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the So Ruby Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
