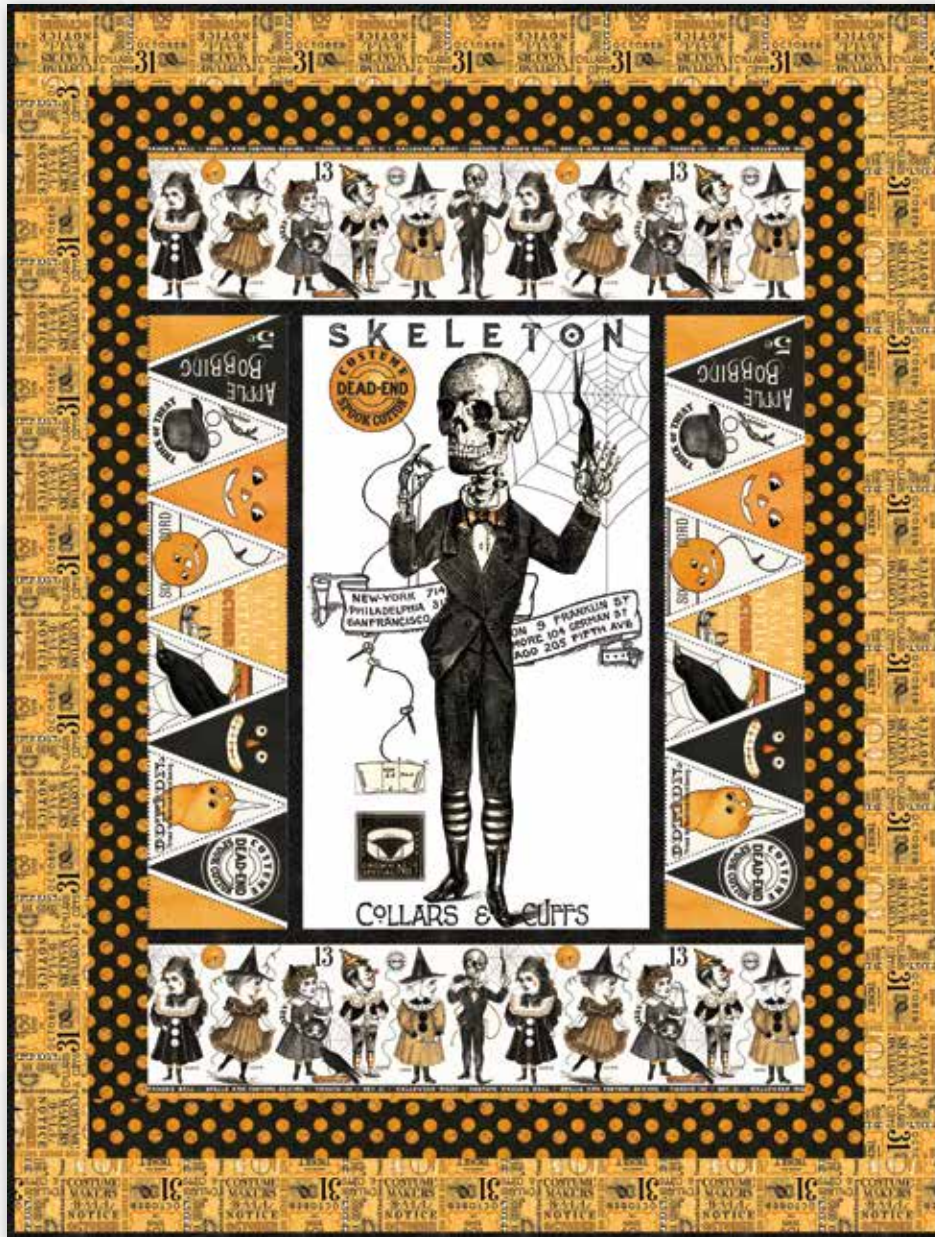

STEP RIGHT UP

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 63¼" x 83¼"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 white costume main panel (P8360 White)

1 orange costume bunting panel (P8362 Orange)

1 3/8 yard cream costume border stripe (C8363 Cream)

1 yard black costume jack-o-lantern balloons
(C8364 Black)

1¼ yards orange costume ticket text (C8368 Orange)

7/8 yard black costume webs (C8366 Black)*

* includes Binding

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

White Costume Main Panel

Fussy cut 1 Center Panel 23¾" x 41¾", centering over large design.

Orange Costume Bunting Panel

Fussy cut 2 Side Panels 10" x 41¾", centering over the flags.

Cream Costume Border Stripe

Fussy cut 2 Top/Bottom Panels 11" x 45¼", including the tape border on the bottom of one panel and the top of one panel.

Black Costume Jack-O-Lantern Balloons

Cut 7 strips 4½" x WOF for Inner Border.

Orange Costume Ticket Text

Cut 8 strips 5½" x WOF for Outer Border.

Black Costume Webs

Cut 5 strips 1¾" x WOF for Stop Border.

Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF for Binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of prints. Press the seam allowances towards the border strips.

Quilt Center

Sew one stop border strip to each side of the Center Panel.

Sew the 2 Side Bunting Panels to the sides of the Center Panel.

Sew the remaining 3 black costume web 1¾" strips together end to end. Cut 2 stop border strips 1¾" x 45¼".

Sew the 2 stop border strips to the top and bottom of the Center Panel.

Sew the 2 Top/Bottom Panels to the top and bottom of the Center Panel.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

Inner Border

Side borders should be 65¼". Top and bottom borders should be 53¼".

Outer Border

Side borders should be 73¼". Top and bottom borders should be 63¼".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Black Costume Web strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
