Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Summer's in Town collection unless stated otherwise.

¼ Yard of Each:

C17531-YELLOW Cameo
C17532-AQUA Floral
C17533-BLUE Daisies
C17534-GREEN Circle Dots
C17534-ORANGE Circle Dots
C17536-BLUE Plaid
C17536-GREEN Plaid

Additional Fabrics:

⅝ yard C610-VANILLA Texture
1 ¼ yards C17532-CREAM Floral
¾ yard C17535-RED Stripes (includes binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES


Basic Sewing Supplies
1 ⅞ yards WB605-CHERRY Shabby (wide back backing)
Batting
Planted Seed Designs Triangle-in-a-Square Ruler Set (ST-12089) (optional)

TEMPLATE INSTRUCTIONS


1. Cut a strip of fabric according to the cutting instructions. Place the template or optional ruler on the strip, aligning the template along the top and bottom. Cut on both sides of the ruler. Next, rotate the ruler 180°, align the ruler edge with the cut edge, and cut again. Repeat to cut as many shapes as the cutting instructions indicates.

Note: To cut both Side and Reversed Side shapes at once, layer two strips of fabric with wrong sides together before cutting.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Summer's in Town Panel

Fussy cut (1) $35'' \times 42\frac{1}{2}''$ Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.*

**Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.*



Yellow Cameo

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.



Aqua Floral

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.



Blue Daisies

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.



Green Circle Dots

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.




Orange Circle Dots

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.



Blue Plaid

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.



Green Plaid

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(2) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.




Vanilla Texture

Cut (3) $4\frac{1}{4}'' \times$ WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(2) $4\frac{1}{4}'' \times 48\frac{1}{2}''$ strips. Label as B.
Cut (2) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
(2) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 35''$ rectangles. Label as C.



Cream Floral

Cut (4) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
(26) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as D.
(4) Triangles and (4) Reversed Triangles using the Side Template. Label as E.
(4) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ squares. Label as F.
Cut (6) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 62\frac{1}{2}''$ strips. Label as G.
(2) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 54\frac{1}{2}''$ strips. Label as H.



Red Stripes

Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
(4) Triangles using the Center Template.
Label as A.
Cut (7) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strips for binding or enough bias strips to make 260" of bias binding.


SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **C**-rectangle to the top and bottom of the Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **B**-strip to each side to make the quilt center.

2. Arrange (2) **F**-squares, (1) **E**-reversed triangle, (7) **A**-triangles, (6) **D**-triangles, and (1) **E**-triangle as shown below. Sew the **A**- and **D**-triangles together. (Note: Once pressed, the triangles should be aligned at the top and bottom. If the triangles are not aligned, remove seam and realign triangles for accuracy. See a closer detail of sewing triangles together in the diagrams, top right.) Next, sew the Side Triangles and **F**-squares to each side to make (1) Top Border Unit. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Border Unit.



3. Repeat Step 2 using (1) **E**-triangle, (8) **A**-triangles, (7) **D**-triangles, and (1) **E**-reversed triangle as shown below to make (1) Left Side Border Unit, referencing the diagram for placement. Repeat to make (1) Right Side Border Unit.

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4. Sew (1) Left Side Border Unit and (1) Right Side Border Unit to the sides of the quilt center as shown below. Next, sew (1) Top Border Unit to the top and (1) Bottom Border Unit to the bottom. In the same manner, sew **H**-strips to the top and bottom and **G**-strips to the sides to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

5. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Red Stripes binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
