GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from the Sunshine & Dandelions collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) RP-17920-40 Rolie Polie

Additional Fabrics:

3 ¼ yards C120-TWILIGHT Confetti Cotton™ Solid
⅔ yard C17920-BLUE Main (binding)



OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
2 ½ yards WB645-BEACH Dapple Dot on Off White
(wide back backing)
Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



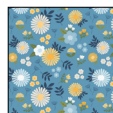
Rolie Polie

Set (25) 2 ½" x WOF strips aside. Label as A.
From remaining strips, cut a total of:
(34) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares. Label as B.



Twilight Confetti Cotton Solid

Cut (5) 10 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut:
(20) 10 ½" x 10 ½" squares. Label as C.
Cut (3) 10" x WOF strips. Subcut:
(9) 10" x 10" squares. Label as D.
Cut (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Piece (7) together end-to-end; subcut:
(4) 2 ½" x 67" strips. Label as E.
From remaining strips, subcut:
(32) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares. Label as F.



Blue Main

Cut (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

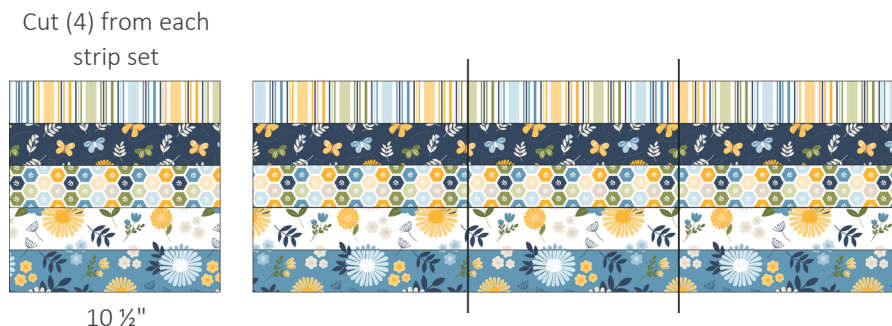

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

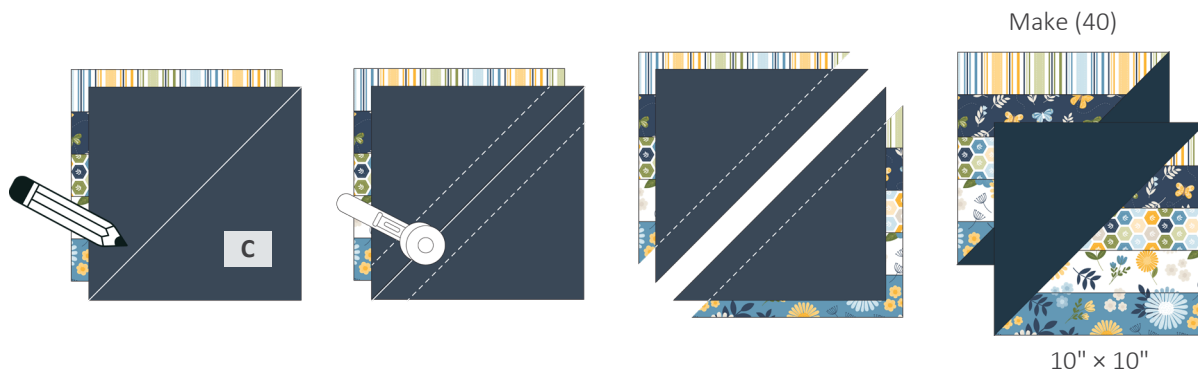
1. Sew (5) **A**-strips together as shown below to make (1) strip set. Repeat to make (5) total strip sets.



2. Cut each strip into (4) 10 1/2"-wide segments for a total of (20) segments.



3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (1) **C**-square. Layer (1) segment with strips running horizontally and (1) marked **C**-square RST as shown below (the marked line should go from the bottom-left corner to the top-right corner). Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) blocks. Press each block toward the **C**-fabric. Trim each block to measure 10" x 10".
4. Repeat Step 3 to make (40) total blocks.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Arrange (9) **D**-squares and (40) blocks as shown below. Pay careful attention to orientation of each block. Sew the squares and blocks together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.

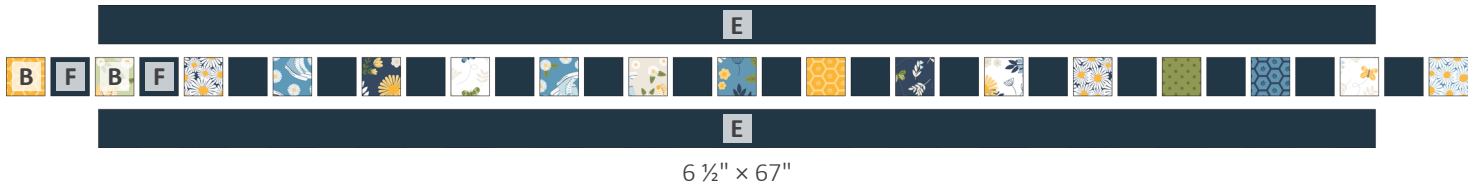

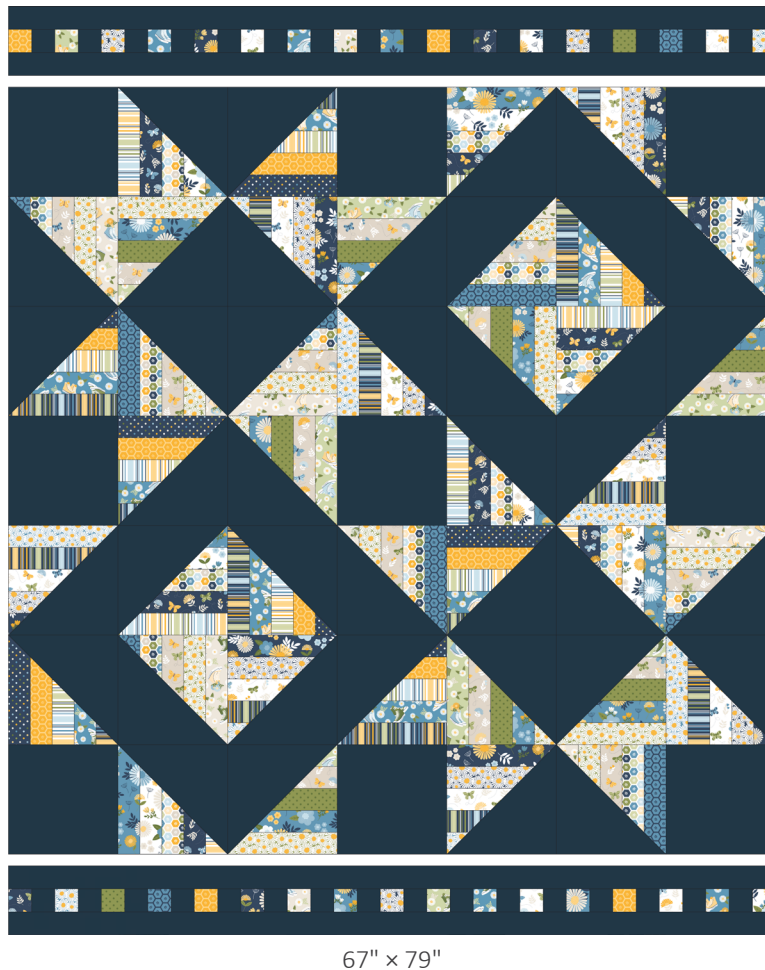
6. Sew (17) **B**-squares and (16) **F**-squares together using a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, alternating squares as shown below. Next, sew (1) **E**-strip to the top and bottom to make (1) Border Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.

7. Sew (1) Border Unit to the top and bottom of the quilt center as shown below to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

8. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Blue Main binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
