Finished Quilt Size 40" x 40"

Finished Block Size 8" x 8"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 yard (95 cm) Surfin' Cats pink main (C4230 Pink)

$1\frac{1}{4}$ yards (1.15 m) clean white solid (C100-01 Clean White)

$\frac{1}{8}$ yard (15 cm) gray solid (C100-13 Gray)

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard (35 cm) hot pink solid (C100-31 Hot Pink)

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard (35 cm) pale pink solid (C100-80 Pale Pink)

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard (35 cm) rosette solid (C100-81 Rosette)

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard (35 cm) raspberry solid (C100-91 Raspberry)

6" Circle Template

Fusible Web

Binding $\frac{1}{2}$ yard (50 cm)

Backing $1\frac{1}{4}$ yards (1.15 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting sashing and border pieces.

Surfin' Cats Pink Main

Fussy cut 12 Surfin' Cats squares 7" x 7" (3 each of the 4 different cats).

Clean White Solid

Cut 3 strips $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 12 squares $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Gray Solid

Cut 4 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 52 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Hot Pink, Pale Pink, Rosette, and Raspberry Solids


Cut 1 strip $9\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF from each solid. From each strip cut 4 squares $9\frac{1}{4}$ " x $9\frac{1}{4}$ ". Cut each square twice diagonally to create 16 triangles from each solid (you will only use 13).

QUILT ASSEMBLY


Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Pieced Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Sew 4 triangles (hot pink, pale pink, rosette, and raspberry solid) together to create Unit A. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 4 gray $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " gray square on each corner of Unit A and sew on the line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat to create 13 Pieced Blocks.

Applique Block

Apply fusible web to the 12 Surfin' Cats 7" squares. Using the 6" circle template, cut out each cat. Center each circle atop a clean white solid $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Fuse into place. Machine applique using matching thread. Make 12 Applique Blocks.




Applique Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for Pieced and Applique Block placement. Lay out the blocks in 5 rows of 5 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake Surfin' Cats fabric. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
