GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions are intended to be used in conjunction with all twelve of the 2025 Tabletop Banner Patterns, a pattern series featuring twelve different seasonal blocks. Each pattern is a great standalone quilt block, or combine all twelve to create this quilt. Purchase the curated kit of fabrics to make this setting at your local quilt shop or online retailer.

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Basics collection unless stated otherwise.

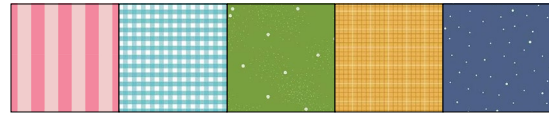
- (1) Banner Setting Kit Rolie Polie
- 1 yard C120-IVORY Confetti Cotton™
- ⅝ yard C665-IRON Dainty Daisy (includes binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
1 ¾ yards WB660-RED on White Swiss Dot (wide back backing)
Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



(1) Banner Setting Kit Rolie Polie or equivalent scraps reserved from all (12) Tabletop Banner Kits

Cut (236) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as A.



Ivory Confetti Cotton™

Cut (12) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Piece (6) together end-to-end; subcut:

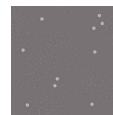
(2) 2 ½" × 62 ½" strips. Label as B.

(2) 2 ½" × 44 ½" strips. Label as C.

From remaining strips, subcut:

(8) 2 ½" × 14 ½" rectangles. Label as D.

(9) 2 ½" × 12 ½" rectangles. Label as E.



Iron Dainty Daisy

Cut (8) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Set (7) aside for binding.

From remaining strip, subcut:

(6) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as F.

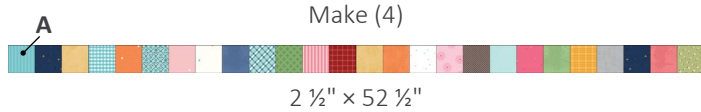
SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

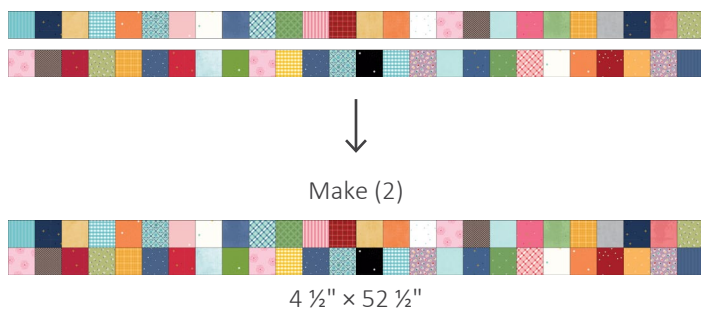
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QUILT ASSEMBLY

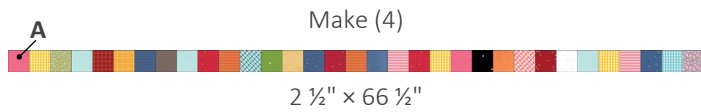
1. Sew (26) **A**-squares together in a row. Repeat to make (4) total rows.



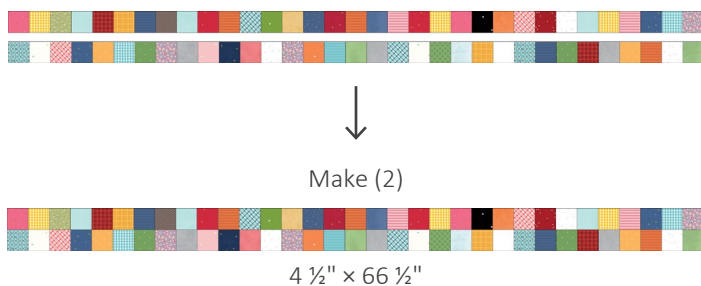
2. Sew (2) Step 1 rows together to make the Top Outer Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Outer Border.



3. Sew (33) **A**-squares together in a row. Repeat to make (4) total rows.



4. Sew (2) Step 3 rows together to make (1) Side Outer Border. Repeat to make (2) total Side Outer Borders.



5. Lay out (12) Tabletop Banner Blocks, (8) **D**-rectangles, (9) **E**-rectangles, and (6) **F**-squares as shown below. Sew the blocks and pieces together in rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.



6. Sew (1) **B**-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown in the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4. Next, add (1) **C**-strip to the top and the bottom.
7. Sew (1) Side Outer Border to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) Top/Bottom Outer Border to the top and the bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

8. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Iron Dainty Daisy binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
