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THE LITTLE ENGINE PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 65"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 The Little Engine Panel (P9996 Panel)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm) Blue Argyle (C9994 Blue)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm) Green I Think I Can (C9993 Green)

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (1.05 m) Blue Main (C9990 Blue)

Binding $\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Little Engine Panel

Cut 1 rectangle 36" x 43".

Blue Argyle

Cut 4 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

Green I Think I Can

Cut 5 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Main

Cut 6 strips 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 3.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 43". Top and bottom borders should be 42".

Border 2

Side borders should be 49". Top and bottom borders should be 48".

Border 3

Side borders should be 55". Top and bottom borders should be 58".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
