# THE NORTH POLE PANEL QUILT

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 68" x 77"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project.  
Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

Pattern designed by The RBD Designers.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check [www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates) or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric  
RST = Right Sides Together

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric is from The North Pole collection.

- (1) F17755-PANEL The North Pole Panel
- (2) 5-17750-42 5" Stackers

### Additional Fabrics:

- ¾ yard F17752-WHITE Snowflakes
- 1 ½ yards F17752-AQUA Snowflakes
- ¾ yard F17752-TOMATO Snowflakes (includes binding)

## OTHER SUPPLIES

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- 4 ¾ yards backing fabric of your choice (standard yardage)
- Batting

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



### The North Pole Panel

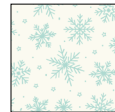
Fussy cut (1) 33" x 42" Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.\*

\*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.



### 5" Stackers

Set (83) 5" x 5" squares aside. Label as A.



### White Snowflakes

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
  - (2) 5" x 5" squares. Label as A.
- Cut (4) 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - (2) 2 ¼" x 42" rectangles. Label as B.
  - (2) 2 ¼" x 36 ½" rectangles. Label as C.
- Cut (6) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
  - (2) 1 ¾" x 63 ½" strips. Label as D.
  - (2) 1 ¾" x 57" strips. Label as E.



### Aqua Snowflakes

- Cut (7) 6" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
  - (2) 6" x 68" strips. Label as F.
  - (2) 6" x 66" strips. Label as G.



### Tomato Snowflakes

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
  - (3) 5" x 5" squares. Label as A.
- Cut (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding.

# THE NORTH POLE PANEL QUILT

## SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Arrange (24) **A**-squares into two rows as shown below. Sew the pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Top Pieced Border. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Pieced Border.

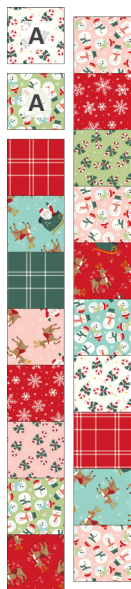

2. Arrange (20) **A**-squares into two columns as shown below. Sew the pieces together into columns. Next, sew the columns together to make (1) Side Pieced Border. Repeat to make a second Side Pieced Border.

3. Sew (1) **B**-rectangle to each side of the Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **C**-rectangle to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew Side Pieced Borders to the sides and Top/Bottom Pieced Borders to the top and bottom to make the quilt center.



54 ½" × 63 ½"

4. Sew (1) **D**-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown in the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4. Next, sew (1) **E**-strip to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **G**-strips to the sides and **F**-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

5. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Tomato Snowflakes binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
